

A Look at Arizona

The Wildcats enter Friday's game with a 3-1 mark to start the year, defeating Toledo, Howard and Kansas while falling to San Diego. Redshirt freshman Taryn Griffey, daughter of baseball legend Ken Griffey Jr., leads Arizona with 11.8 points per game. As a team, the Wildcats hold a +12.5 scoring margin by holding opponents to 49.5 points per game.

The North Texas-Arizona Series

The Mean Green have matched up with the Wildcats on three seperate occassions, all coming as losses for North Texas:

- Dec. 21, 2010: North Texas 73, Arizona 88
- Nov. 28, 2011: North Texas 62, Arizona 69
- Nov. 28, 2012: North Texas 66, Arizona 71

Third-Quarter Force

North Texas tends to respond after halftime. In fact, the Mean Green hold a 50-34 scoring edge in the third quarter this season. It is the only quarter in which NT has outscored its collective opponents on the year. Overall, the team's scoring margin is -6.

Last Time Out

Acheil Tac recorded her first double-double of the season and Teadra Jones added a career-high 16 points, but NT fell in the closing seconds at Texas State on Saturday, 64-62. The Mean Green battled back to tie the game at 62-62 after a key four-point swing with just over a minute left to play but couldn't find a way to get the W. Tac shot 8-of-8 in the loss, making her just the third player dating back to the 2003-04 season to shoot 100 percent from the floor with at least six made field goals.

What A Way To Start

North Texas took down the No.17 Oklahoma Sooners on Nov. 16, and they did so from OU's home court. It was the first time that NT had ever beaten a ranked team. In addition, the victory served as head coach Jalie Mitchell's first head coaching victory. Before the loss, the Sooners had lost only one game on its home floor since the beginning of the 2013-14 season. All in all, it was a fitting way for the best player in program history to earn her first win as skipper for the Mean Green

Roster Re-do

A new coaching staff meant a retooled Mean Green roster for the 2015-16 season. In fact, only seven letterwinnners remain from a year ago. Among the first moves made by Mitchell & Co. was the addition of four transfer student-athletes that must sit out for the year, due to NCAA regulations: Tyara Warren from West Virginia, Terriell Bradley from Kansas, Nekia Jones from Texas and Stabresa McDaniel from Minnesota. North Texas has also lost two players to injury.

Defensive Mindset

Head coach Jalie Mitchell doesn't hide the fact that she plans on winning with defensive intensity, and it seems like the perfect fit considering the team's high-ranking defense from a year ago. The Mean Green allowed only 61.7 points per game in 2014-15, the second-best season mark ever recorded in North Texas women's basketball history. This year, the Mean Green is giving up 63.3 points per game.

Hall-of-Fame Homecoming

Former Sun Belt Player of the Year and North Texas Hall-of-Fame inductee Jalie Mitchell takes over as the team's head coach in 2015-16. It is the first head coaching stint of Mitchell's career after spending time as an assistant at North Texas, UNC-Wilmington and Texas. While the team's progress remains to be seen, there's no reason not to think that Mitchell, an avid recruiter, can rebuild the Mean Green program.

Preseason Projections

The Conference USA preseason coaches poll wasn't friendly to the Mean Green following the team's dismal 5-24 record last season. North Texas was picked to finish dead last in the C-USA poll. Middle Tennessee, Old Dominion, WKU, Southern Miss and UTEP were picked to round out the top five. Meanwhile, no North Texas players were picked on the C-USA preseason all-conference team.

Close Call Conference

Despite the team's 5-24 record last season, Norrht Texas was able to consistently compete in a tough C-USA slate. In fact, four of the Mean Green's wins came in conference games, and the team lost seven C-USA games by 10 or less points.

New Coaches On The Block

Coach Mitchell brought in a whole new staff when she was hired as the eighth head coach in the team's history. Associate head coach Bobby Brasel joins the team after most recently working with Arkansas-Little Rock and assistant coach Aisha Stewart joins the #MeanGreenFamily after time on the Arkansas State staff. Additionally, Mean Green alumni make up the other two spots on the North Texas coaching team, as assistant coach Kasondra Foreman and director of operations John Franklin both played college ball at North Texas.

HEAD COACH JALIE MITCHELL



FIRST SEASON AT NORTH TEXAS | @NT_COACHJ

For years, Jalie Mitchell has topped the record books at North Texas. Now, North Texas will be at the top of her resume.

On April 9, 2015, Mitchell returned to her alma mater to become the eighth head coach in Mean Green women's basketball program history. It is her first-career head coaching position and a dream job for the best player in school history.

"I feel incredibly blessed to have this opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at my alma mater," Mitchell said. "Since I left here as a player, it has always been my dream to come back and one day lead this program. I'm excited for the challenge of returning this program to the type of success it had when I played here."

Mitchell boasts numerous records as a four-year letterwinniner on the North Texas women's basketball team from 1999-02. She finished as the Mean Green's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green, and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Hall of Fame.

"This is a great day for the program, the athletic department and the entire University of North Texas," Athletic Director Rick Villarreal said. "We were able to bring back one of our own who has played at the highest level, worked with and learned from some of the most talented coaches in the country and has proven herself as a premier recruiter across the nation." Previously, Mitchell had been an assistant coach for four seasons under head coach Karen Aston, beginning with the 2011-12 campaign with North Texas. In that campaign, the team went 15-16, which is its best record of the last nine seasons.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the Longhorns in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

"In addition to her coaching and recruiting skills, Jalie will bring to us an emotion, a passion and a commitment to the university that she doesn't have to think about because it's embedded in her," Villarreal continued. "At the end of the day, this hire was about her ability to bring in quality players and push them to maximize their talents in order to build the kind of program we all want. She brings the added ability to connect to the Dallas market, not just with student-athletes, but also with alumni who share her memories and dreams."
