A Look at the Cardinals

Incarnate Word enters the Monday matchup with a 3-7 record on the year, having dropped their last six matchups in 2015. The Cardinals give up an average of 64.0 points per contest while scoring 55.0 points per game. On the offensive end, two players score in double figures for UIW: Brianna Williams with 12.9 ppg and Aricka Adams with 10.8 ppg.

The North Texas-Incarnate Word Series

The series will start fresh on Monday as this will be the first all-time meeting with Incarnate Word.

Last Time Out

Acheil Tac led the way with her third double-double of the year (21 pts/11 rbd) as three players finished in double figures on Wednesday. North Texas led for more than 34 minutes and put on its best offensive output of the year with 69 total points. The Mean Green's 30 points in the fourth quarter was a season best, as was the team's 50 total rebounds. Free throws were pivotal in the 69-63 win as NT shot 23-of-31 from the charity stripe, including a streak of 17 straight in the last 14 minutes of the game.

Defensive Mindset

Coach Mitchell came to Denton with a focus on defensive intensity and NT has found a way to improve an impressive D from a season ago. The Mean Green is giving up 59.4 points per game in 2015. That total would be the program's second-lowest average ever and is currently the fourth-best mark in C-USA. The Mean Green also lead the league in rebounding defense (32.9 rpg).

Full of Firsts

By the year's end, North Texas will have played four teams for the first time: Incarnate Word, Iona, IUPUI and Oklahoma Panhandle State.

A.-Tac'ing the Competition

Acheil Tac continues to be an all-around weapon for North Texas after a solid season last year. She already has three double-doubles on the year and is averaging 10.1 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. After dropping a season-high 21 points to go along with 11 rebounds versus La Salle, Tac ranks among the conference's best in a number of categories.

Transfer Triumph

Junior guard Kelsey Criner, a transfer from New Mexico Junior College, has taken over as the team's primary point guard in 2015, and she hasn't taken long to turn heads. In the team's last game against Iona, Criner dropped career highs with 19 points and nine rebounds while nearly orchestrating the team's second straight 20-point comeback against Iona. On the year, the Dallas native is third on the team in points (10.0 ppg), second in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and leads NT in steals (2.0 spg) and assists (3.9 apg).

TJ, The Versatile

Senior Teadra Jones is perhaps the team's most versatile player after having started at both guard and forward this season. She was especially crucial in Wednesday's win over La Salle, when she tied a career-high with 16 points and nine rebounds, falling a board short of a double-double.

Criner The Clutch

In each Mean Green win this season, Kelsey Criner has scored go-ahead baskets with less than a minute remaining. Against IUPUI, that shot was a corner three that put the Mean Green up, 68-67, with 43 seconds to play.

Added to the Mix

Coach Mitchell and staff added walk-on freshman Orianna Shillow to the roster on Nov. 21 against Texas State. Shillow was a first-team all-district pick for Stony Point High during her senior season while finishing second in team history for three-pointers made in a season (75). She saw her first action against Weber State, getting two minutes of playing time.

What A Way To Start

NT took down No.17 Oklahoma on Nov. 16, and they did so from OU's home court. It was the first time that NT had ever beaten a ranked team, and the victory served as Jalie Mitchell's first head coaching win. Before the loss, the Sooners had dropped only one game from its home floor since the beginning of the 2013-14 season.

Roster Re-do

A new coaching staff meant a retooled Mean Green roster for the 2015-16 season. In fact, only seven letterwinners remain from a year ago. Among the first moves made by Mitchell & Co. was the addition of four transfer student-athletes that must sit out for the year due to NCAA regulations: Tyara Warren from West Virginia, Terriell Bradley from Kansas and Stabresa McDaniel from Minnesota. North Texas has also lost two players to injury.

HEAD COACH JALIE MITCHELL

For years, Jalie Mitchell has topped the record books at North Texas. Now, North Texas will be at the top of her resume.

On April 9, 2015, Mitchell returned to her alma mater to become the eighth head coach in Mean Green women's basketball program history. It is her first-career head coaching position and a dream job for the best player in school history.

"I feel incredibly blessed to have this opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at my alma mater," Mitchell said. "Since I left here as a player, it has always been my dream to come back and one day lead this program. I'm excited for the challenge of returning this program to the type of success it had when I played here."

Mitchell boasts numerous records as a four-year letterwinner on the North Texas women's basketball team from 1999-02. She finished as the Mean Green's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green, and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Hall of Fame.

"This is a great day for the program, the athletic department and the entire University of North Texas," Athletic Director Rick Villarreal said. "We were able to bring back one of our own who has played at the highest level, worked with and learned from some of the most talented coaches in the country and has proven herself as a premier recruiter across the nation."

Previously, Mitchell had been an assistant coach for four seasons under head coach Karen Aston, beginning with the 2011-12 campaign with North Texas. In that campaign, the team went 15-16, which is its best record of the last nine seasons.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the Longhorns in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

"In addition to her coaching and recruiting skills, Jalie will bring to us an emotion, a passion and a commitment to the university that she doesn't have to think about because it's embedded in her," Villarreal continued. "At the end of the day, this hire was about her ability to bring in quality players and push them to maximize their talents in order to build the kind of program we all want. She brings the added ability to connect to the Dallas market, not just with student-athletes, but also with alumni who share her memories and dreams."

NORMAN, Okla. - In the 1,096-game history of North Texas women's basketball, no squad had ever trumped a top-25 opponent. That is, until the Mean Green rolled into the Lloyd Noble Center on Monday night.

North Texas never trailed and seemed to have all the right answers for the No. 17 Oklahoma Sooners, as the team took a 61-57 win to earn the biggest upset victory in the program's history.

"It's hard to contain myself right here," an emotional Jalie Mitchell said moments after the win. "I'm so proud of our young ladies. They were extremely resilient tonight and gave me everything they had."

Defense, especially on the interior, was key in what turned out to be a low-scoring game from Norman, Oklahoma. From the onset, North Texas honed in on All-Big 12 Second Team selection Kaylon Williams. The 6-3 redshirt senior made only 20 percent of her shots on the night and her failed attempts early in the game allowed the Mean Green to get off to a seven-point lead before the Sooners put points on the board.

North Texas (1-1) kept its foot on the pedal throughout the game, but - as can happen with only nine bodies to play - Mean Green fouls started to take their toll.

Still holding onto a slim lead, North Texas found itself without each of its lengthy post players in the fourth quarter as Acheil Tac, Bria Frierson and Tosin Mabodu all took a seat on the bench with five fouls.

From there, it was up to a small North Texas lineup to close out the game against the height of a Big 12 opponent. Luckily for the Mean Green, junior Terra Ellison wasn't going anywhere. The Colony, Texas, native poured in 15 points on Monday night, leading the team and consistently responding to a Sooner offense that continued to creep its way back into the game.

But the defining moment of the contest came with only 30 seconds remaining in regulation, when junior Kelsey Criner shimmed her way through the lane to bank home a left-handed layup, breaking a 57-57 tie and giving the lead back to the Mean Green. She then added a quick steal and got herself to the free throw line, where she virtually sealed the upset by pushing the lead to four points with only three seconds to play.

"I couldn't have drawn up a better start or finish for our girls," Mitchell said of her group's fight. "It was a team effort, we needed all nine people and they gave us everything they had."

SAN MARCOS, Texas — Senior forward Acheil Tac recorded her first double-double of the season and senior guard Teadra Jones added a career-high 16 points, but North Texas fell in the closing seconds at Texas State on Saturday afternoon, 64-62.

Texas State (2-1) put together a 62-58 lead on a three-point play with 2:11 left. North Texas (1-2) battled back to tie the game at 62-62 after a key four-point swing with just over a minute left to play, which included a lay-up by junior guard Kelsey Criner and then an offensive rebound and put-back by Jones off a missed free throw.

But the Bobcats had one final answer, a drive and lay-up by Texas State guard Taeler Deer, who led all scorers with 32 points, with 5.4 seconds left that proved to be the game-winner for the Bobcats.

"I'm very disappointed in the game as a whole," head coach Jalie Mitchell said. "You saw a totally different team Monday night, so I'm disappointed in the way that we showed up and played for most of the game. I told them that the game does not reward you for just a few good minutes of play."

Led by Tac and Jones, all five starters for North Texas scored eight or more points in the contest. As a team, the Mean Green shot 59.5 percent (25-of-42) from the floor and 9-of-11 from the free-throw line. The team also won the rebounding battle, 32-18, but it was unable to make enough plays down the stretch to overcome 25 turnovers.

North Texas made each of its first six shots of the game on the way to a 14-8 lead, which included a 7-2 run to start the contest. Texas State tied the game at 14-14 with 2:03 left in the first quarter and then, after a 12-0 run, grabbed a 28-20 lead with 6:13 left in the second quarter. The Mean Green pulled to within four at 30-26 with 2:26 left after a pair of free throws by Jones, but they went into halftime trailing 36-28.

Similar to the first half, North Texas started the second half strong, using a 10-2 run to tie the game at 38-38 with 5:26 left in the third quarter. Texas State pushed its lead back to 46-40 with 2:38 left, before Tac scored the last four points of the third quarter to help spur a late push for North Texas. Sparked by Tac's final four points of the third quarter, North Texas went on a 12-0 run to take a 56-49 lead with 6:51 left in the game and led as late as the 3:16 mark of the fourth quarter, but it was Texas State that made enough plays to close out the win.

DENTON — Three players scored in double figures, but North Texas was unable to close out what would have been the first home win of Jalie Mitchell's coaching career and the second win over a Power 5 opponent in as many opportunities this season.

Arizona held North Texas to a season-low scoring output and outlasted the Mean Green by a score of 49-44 on Friday afternoon at the Super Pit. Defensively, Arizona limited North Texas to 38 percent shooting and forced 26 North Texas turnovers, a season-high for the Mean Green. The Wildcats also turned that defense into offense, scoring 24 points off the North Texas miscues.

"A couple of things stand out, looking at the stat sheet," Mitchell said. "Our turnovers hurt us a lot today. It was the same story for us last game as well. We have to learn how to take care of the ball better because you miss out on some opportunities to score and put points on the board when you don't take care of the ball. And then free throws. We had 16 opportunities and only took advantage of seven. That's huge. You miss nine and lose by seven."

For North Texas (1-3), junior guard Candice Adams led the way with 12 points, followed by fellow junior guards Terra Ellison and Kelsey Criner who finished with 11 points and 10 points, respectively. Senior forward Acheil Tac also finished two points shy of her second double-double of the season, scoring eight points and grabbing 12 rebounds in the contest.

Sparked by back-to-back 3-pointers by Adams to start the game, North Texas took a 13-5 lead into the media timeout of the first quarter with 4:39 left. The Mean Green led for 27:17 of the game and did not trail until the 9:29 mark in the fourth quarter.

Arizona (4-1) chipped away at the North Texas lead in the second and third quarters, after trailing 18-11 heading to the second frame. In a third quarter that featured a combined 12 points, 5-of-18 shooting and 15 turnovers, Arizona battled back to tie the game at 28-28 with 6:55 left, and the teams went to the fourth quarter tied at 32-32.

The Wildcats then grabbed their first lead of the game, a 34-32 advantage, as part of a 10-0 run on a layup by junior forward Breanna Workman with 9:29 left in the game.

Arizona took its largest lead of the game, 43-35, with 3:38 left after a 5-0 run, all the points courtesy of Workman, who finished with 13 points. North Texas pulled to within four at 47-43 with 1:15 left on a banked-in 3-pointer by senior guard Kasiney Williams, but that was as close as the Mean Green would get the rest of the way.

DENTON - North Texas controlled 34 minutes of Tuesday night's game against Metroplex rival SMU at the Super Pit. But getting first-year head coach Jalie Mitchell her first home victory was not going to be that easy.

The Mean Green women, up by as many as 14 points in the second half, saw their lead wiped out by a frantic SMU rally that put the Mustangs on top, 55-53, with 3:16 to play, forcing a Mean Green timeout.

"I told them we were playing not to lose instead of playing to win," Mitchell said. "We had to do what got us that lead. I think they got themselves pumped up after that, and figured it out. This team has been working on overcoming adversity, on taking a punch and being able to punch right back."

Coming out of the timeout, North Texas stung the Mustangs with a flurry of blows that turned the momentum in the Mean Green's favor. A clutch 12-foot jumper by Candice Adams stopped the bleeding and tied the game, a dagger of a three-point field goal by Kelsey Criner at the end of the shot clock put North Texas back on top, and two free throws by Terra Ellison with 12.7 seconds left iced an emotional 60-57 North Texas win.

And throughout those final three minutes, the Mean Green defense, which had played so well in building the original lead, held the Mustangs scoreless until 1.3 seconds play and forced three turnovers. For the game, NT allowed SMU to make just 38.6 percent of its field-goal attempts and harried the Mustangs into 19 turnovers.

The victory lifts NT to 2-3 on the year and snaps a four-game losing streak against SMU (3-3).

"I love that," Mitchell said of besting the Mustangs. "I have to admit."

Criner, the junior guard from Dallas by way of New Mexico Junior College, led all scorers with 17 points and added a team-high eight rebounds.

"I like our team with the ball in Kelsey's hands," Mitchell said. "She makes really great decisions, and she's tough to guard."

Adams had 12 points, Bria Frierson had 10 and Ellison had nine. Frierson also had a big game defensively, limiting SMU's 6-5 post Stephanie Collins to 10 points, her second lowest output of the season.

DENTON - The North Texas women have been working on dealing with adversity this year, but they also need to work on handling success.

For the second time this year, the Mean Green followed up a big win with a disappointing loss. On the heels of Tuesday's victory over SMU, North Texas turned in its worst outing of the season Friday night in a 45-38 loss to Weber State in the first night of the Hospitality Hill Challenge at the Super Pit.

In a drought that would turn a rain forest into a desert, the North Texas offense plunged to season lows in scoring and field-goal percentage which, combined with 24 turnovers, turned a nine-point first quarter lead into a 15-point fourth-quarter deficit. The Mean Green made just 34.1 percent of its field-goal attempts and scored just 11 points combined in the second and third periods.

North Texas rallied in the fourth, getting big stops from its defense, including forcing three shot-clock violations, to close within three with 2:23 to play, but the offensive woes and turnovers continued and would not allow the Mean Green to complete the rally. The loss drops NT to 2-4 on the year.

"I'm extremely disappointed," North Texas coach Jalie Mitchell said. "We gave that team 10 minutes of North Texas basketball, all in the fourth quarter. That's not enough. I had one starter show up to play today."

That was Acheil Tac, who was limited by foul trouble Tuesday to two points and one rebound. She bounced back with a double-double Friday, topping her Tuesday totals by the first timeout Friday and finished with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

In a ragged, mistake-filled, low-scoring first half, Tac's nine points North Texas took a 13-4 lead in the first quarter. But that was the high-water mark for North Texas for the next two quarters. Despite scoring just four points in the second quarter, matching a season low, NT kept the lead to intermission, holding Weber State to 15.8 percent shooting, making three field goals in 19 attempts.

However, Weber State (5-1) heated up in the third quarter, opening the second half with a 12-0 run. From the end of the first quarter until the Wildcats opened their 14-point advantage at 39-24, Weber State out-scored North Texas 35-12.

DENTON -- North Texas trailed by as many as 20, but the Mean Green rode a second-half surge to a thrilling 68-67 win over IUPUI on Saturday afternoon at the Super Pit. North Texas (3-4) led for just 43 seconds, taking their only lead of the game on a corner 3-pointer by junior guard Kelsey Criner.

"We had a group that made a decision that the way we had been playing is not who we were going to be," head coach Jalie Mitchell said. "Offensively, we got extremely aggressive, which we hadn't been for the third quarters, and it changed the game. It also gave us some confidence in that we saw that they couldn't guard the things that we were running as long as we executed and stayed in attack mode."

Junior guard Candice Adams led the way with a game-high 18 points on 8-of-16 shooting, including a game-tying 3-pointer with 1:56 left in the game. Senior forward Acheil Tac added 12 points and eight rebounds, while Criner finished with 10 points, none bigger than her go-ahead 3-pointer, which proved to be the difference in the game.

North Texas shot 50 percent (30-of-60) from the floor and 6-of-11 from 3-point range. In the second half, when the Mean Green outscored IUPUI (6-2) by a score of 42-26, they shot 58.1 percent (18-of-31) from the floor and a perfect 5-of-5 from 3-point range. They also committed a season-low 11 turnovers for the game.

IUPUI led wire to wire in the first half, taking a 41-26 lead into halftime, tied for its largest lead of the half. The Jaguars shot 48 percent (16-of-33) from the floor, including 5-of-15 from 3-point range, and committed just three turnovers in the half. North Texas outscored IUPUI 18-16 in the third quarter to head to the fourth quarter trailing 57-44. The stretch included a 7-0 run late in the quarter that erased a 20-point IUPUI lead, their largest of the game.

The Mean Green carried that momentum into the fourth quarter, becoming more aggressive on offense and storming back to make it a 63-62 game with 2:42 left after an offensive rebound and put-back by junior guard Terra Ellison.

North Texas completed the comeback, first tying the game at 65-65 before taking a 68-67 lead in the final minutes of the contest, behind big scoring plays from Adams and Criner. Down by a point, IUPUI had two looks at the basket in the final minute, including a lay-up in the closing seconds that rimmed out, but North Texas held on for the win.

"To come back from down 20, you have to have something about you," Mitchell said. "There was a lot of excitement on the bench, so I thought that everybody played a part in that comeback victory."

NEW ROCHELLE, New York — Sunday afternoon's game against Iona was supposed to be the second win of a streak that North Texas women's basketball hoped would lead into conference play. Instead, a lackluster first half put the Mean Green in a hole it couldn't dig itself out of in a 62-51 loss to the Gaels.

North Texas made just four shots in the game's first 20 minutes to score a season-low 14 points. Sadly, that point total nearly matched the team's shooting percentage for the half - 14.8 percent. By halftime, the Mean Green found themselves down by 22 points - their largest deficit of the season - before a second half surge made things interesting.

As has been the case on many occasions early in the season, North Texas came out strong at both ends of the court in the third quarter, outscoring the Gaels 21-5 and forcing 11 turnovers to get the team back in it. That resurgence was due in large part to junior guard Kelsey Criner, who had 16 of her career- and team-high 19 points in the second half.

Early in the fourth, a Criner steal-turned-layup cut the Iona lead to only four points, 41-37, before an 8-0 run for the Gaels gave them the space they needed to get away with the win.

Rebounding played a large role in Iona's ability to develop and sustain a lead. Led by senior Joy Adams's 19 rebounds, the Gaels outnumbered the Mean Green 49-40 on the glass, including 20 offensive rebounds that contributed to 15 second-chance points.

North Texas was able to contain Iona's leading scorer, guard Marina Lizarazu, to only two points in the contest, but her limited output was compensated by a dominant 31-2 advantage on bench points. Most of those came from freshman Alexis Lewis who led the Gaels with 22 points, including a perfect 4-of-4 mark from three-point range.

In addition to Criner's strong play, North Texas got a solid effort out of senior guard Teadra Jones. She was perhaps the team's most consistent performer from start to finish, as she ended the day with 13 points and six boards. Additionally, sophomore Bria Frierson finished a point away from her first career double-double with nine points and 12 rebounds.

Still, head coach Jalie Mitchell knows that she needs more from her team, and she shared that message after Sunday's loss.

"Honestly, I told the team that we need to care more," the first-year playcaller said. "We've only got 10 players and we need everybody to show up, play and give effort. When we have one, two or three that aren't doing that, it affects us. That much is obvious."

PHILADELPHIA — After falling flat three days ago, the Mean Green women's basketball team needed a big output from its offense in a matchup against La Salle. That's exactly what North Texas head coach Jalie Mitchell got, as the team put together its best scoring output of the season en route to a 69-63 win on Wednesday evening.

Acheil Tac had 21 points and 11 rebounds to earn her third double-double of the year, leading a North Texas team that had three players in double digits. Tac's strong performance was especially crucial after failing to muster even a point in Sunday's loss at Iona.

"I thought [Acheil] was focused and ready to make a difference today," Mitchell said. "I don't think she was happy with her last outing at all. She had a point to prove and did that tonight."

Tac may have been the headline, but the Garland, Texas, native wasn't the only Mean Green player that came to play. Juniors Terra Ellison and Teadra Jones each closed in on double-doubles of their own; Ellison finished the game with 11 points and eight rebounds while Jones dropped 16 points to go along with nine boards.

North Texas shot only 37 percent on the day but gave itself plenty of opportunities for baskets thanks to a strong effort on the glass. The Mean Green dominated the game in the rebounding category, ultimately outnumbering the Explorers 50-27 on the boards.

Despite a dominant offensive display, the win wasn't decided until the final moments of Wednesday's matchup. North Texas went 17-of-17 from the charity stripe in the final 13:47 of play, ultimately deciding a game that was separated by only six points. Six of those free throws came in the last 1:05 of regulation, as a slim 63-61 lead for the Mean Green grew thanks to six made free throws in those final 65 seconds.

Like usual, starting juniors Kelsey Criner and Candice Adams found a way to make their mark on the game. Criner had a career-best 10 rebounds - all in the first half - and added six points, six assists and two steals on the day. Adams was hampered by foul trouble for the duration of Wednesday's game, but the guard still found a way to knock down pivotal three-pointers in what turned out to be a close game.

North Texas now revisits the idea of stringing wins together for the first time this year. With two contests to go until conference play begins on New Year's Day, the Mean Green skipper is looking forward to the chance that lies ahead.

"We still haven't gotten the back-to-back win thing down, but we've got another opportunity," Mitchell said. "We'll be on the road so we've got to bring the same hustle, energy and rebounding. We've got to bring it."

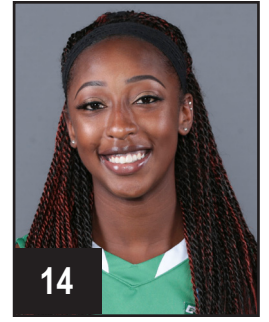

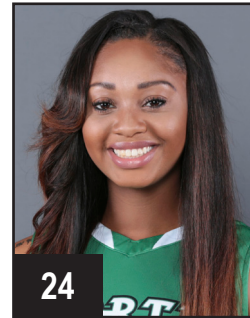
