LAST TIME OUT...

NORMAN, Okla. - In the 1,096-game history of North Texas women's basketball, no squad had ever trumped a top-25 opponent. That is, until the Mean Green rolled into the Lloyd Noble Center on Monday night.

North Texas never trailed and seemed to have all the right answers for the No. 17 Oklahoma Sooners, as the team took a 61-57 win to earn the biggest upset victory in the program's history.

"It's hard to contain myself right here," an emotional Jalie Mitchell said moments after the win. "I'm so proud of our young ladies. They were extremely resilient tonight and gave me everything they had."

Defense, especially on the interior, was key in what turned out to be a low-scoring game from Norman, Oklahoma. From the onset, North Texas honed in on All-Big 12 Second Team selection Kaylon Williams. The 6-3 redshirt senior made only 20 percent of her shots on the night and her failed attempts early in the game allowed the Mean Green to get off to a seven-point lead before the Sooners put points on the board.

North Texas (1-1) kept its foot on the pedal throughout the game, but - as can happen with only nine bodies to play - Mean Green fouls started to take their toll.

Still holding onto a slim lead, North Texas found itself without each of its lengthy post players in the fourth quarter as Acheil Tac, Bria Frierson and Tosin Mabodu all took a seat on the bench with five fouls.

From there, it was up to a small North Texas lineup to close out the game against the height of a Big 12 opponent. Luckily for the Mean Green, junior Terra Ellison wasn't going anywhere. The Colony, Texas, native poured in 15 points on Monday night, leading the team and consistently responding to a Sooner offense that continued to creep its way back into the game.

But the defining moment of the contest came with only 30 seconds remaining in regulation, when junior Kelsey Criner shimmied her way through the lane to bank home a left-handed layup, breaking a 57-57 tie and giving the lead back to the Mean Green. She then added a quick steal and got herself to the free throw line, where she virtually sealed the upset by pushing the lead to four points with only three seconds to play.

"I couldn't have drawn up a better start or finish for our girls," Mitchell said of her group's fight. "It was a team effort, we needed all nine people and they gave us everything they had."

GAME NOTES

What A Way To Start

North Texas found a way to take down the No. 17 Oklahoma Sooners on Monday, and they did so from OU's home court. It was the first time that NT had ever beaten a ranked team. In addition, the victory served as head coach Jalie Mitchell's first head coaching victory. Before the loss, the Sooners had lost only one game on its home floor since the beginning of the 2013-14 season. All in all, it was a fitting way for the best player in program history to earn her first win as skipper for the Mean Green.

Hall-of-Fame Homecoming

Former Sun Belt Player of the Year and North Texas Hall-of-Fame inductee Jalie Mitchell takes over as the team's head coach in 2015-16. It is the first head coaching stint of Mitchell's career after spending time as an assistant at North Texas, UNC-Wilmington and Texas. While the team's progress remains to be seen, there's no reason not to think that Mitchell, an avid recruiter, can rebuild the Mean Green program.

Roster Re-do

A new coaching staff meant a retooled Mean Green roster for the 2015-16 season. In fact, only seven letterwinners remain from a year ago. Among the first moves made by Mitchell & Co. was the addition of four transfer student-athletes that must sit out for the year, due to NCAA

regulations: Tyara Warren from West Virginia, Terriell Bradley from Kansas, Nekia Jones from Texas and Stabresa McDaniel from Minnesota. Junior college transfers Tosin Mabodu and Kelsey Criner also made the move to Denton and started in Friday's first game of the season.

A Thinning Unit

As if the North Texas roster wasn't slim enough with four transfer students sitting out for the season, the Mean Green have also had to deal with injuries. Taylor Roof, one of the team's two freshmen, was ruled out for the year after suffering an injury in the leadup to the season. Likewise, junior Kiara Davis will not be competing for the Mean Green this season due to injury.

Defensive Mindset

Head coach Jalie Mitchell doesn't hide the fact that she plans on winning with defensive intensity, and it seems like the perfect fit considering the team's high-ranking defense from a year ago. The Mean Green allowed only 61.7 points per game in 2014-15, the second-best season mark ever recorded in North Texas women's basketball history.

Preseason Projections

The Conference USA preseason coaches poll wasn't friendly to the Mean Green following the team's dismal 5-24 record last season. North

Texas was picked to finish dead last in the C-USA poll. Middle Tennessee, Old Dominion, WKU, Southern Miss and UTEP were picked to round out the top five. Meanwhile, no North Texas players were picked on the C-USA pre-season all-conference team.

Close Call Conference

Despite the team's 5-24 record last season, North Texas was able to consistently compete in a tough C-USA slate. In fact, four of the Mean Green's wins came in conference games, and the team lost seven C-USA games by 10 or less points.

New Coaches On The Block

Coach Mitchell brought in a whole new staff when she was hired as the eighth head coach in the team's history. Associate head coach Bobby Brasel joins the team after most recently working with Arkansas-Little Rock and assistant coach Aisha Stewart joins the #MeanGreenFamily after time on the Arkansas State staff. Additionally, Mean Green alumni make up the other two spots on the North Texas coaching team, as assistant coach Kasondra Foreman and director of operations John Franklin both played college ball at North Texas.

HEAD COACH JALIE MITCHELL



FIRST SEASON AT NORTH TEXAS | @NT_COACHJ

For years, Jalie Mitchell has topped the record books at North Texas. Now, North Texas will be at the top of her resume.

On April 9, 2015, Mitchell returned to her alma mater to become the eighth head coach in Mean Green women's basketball program history. It is her first-career head coaching position and a dream job for the best player in school history.

"I feel incredibly blessed to have this opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at my alma mater," Mitchell said. "Since I left here as a player, it has always been my dream to come back and one day lead this program. I'm excited for the challenge of returning this program to the type of success it had when I played here."

Mitchell boasts numerous records as a four-year letterwinner on the North Texas women's basketball team from 1999-02. She finished as the Mean Green's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green, and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Hall of Fame.

"This is a great day for the program, the athletic department and the entire University of North Texas," Athletic Director Rick Villarreal said. "We were able to bring back one of our own who has played at the highest level, worked with and learned from some of the most talented coaches in the country and has proven herself as a premier recruiter across the nation."

Previously, Mitchell had been an assistant coach for four seasons under head coach Karen Aston, beginning with the 2011-12 campaign with North Texas. In that campaign, the team went 15-16, which is its best record of the last nine seasons.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the Longhorns in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

"In addition to her coaching and recruiting skills, Jalie will bring to us an emotion, a passion and a commitment to the university that she doesn't have to think about because it's embedded in her," Villarreal continued. "At the end of the day, this hire was about her ability to bring in quality players and push them to maximize their talents in order to build the kind of program we all want. She brings the added ability to connect to the Dallas market, not just with student-athletes, but also with alumni who share her memories and dreams."
