• Picked last in the C-USA Preseason Coaches poll, North Texas has been one of the season's league surprises.

• The Mean Green have a 7-8 overall record and are 2-3 in C-USA action.

• North Texas pulled off one of C-USA's biggest non-conference wins with a 61-57 win at Oklahoma.

• North Texas is under the direction of first-year Head Coach Jalie Mitchell, a former Mean Green standout who is the all-time leading scorer (1,764 points) in program history.

• North Texas is 3-4 at home.

• North Texas has a balanced offensive attack with four players in double figures, led by Kelsey Criner's 12.5 ppg. Candice Adams (12.4), Terra Ellison (10.3) and Acheil Tac (10.0) also average double figures.

• North Texas allows just 63.4 ppg.

Youth Is Served

• MT has one of the younger rosters in C-USA.

• The Blue Raiders start one senior, one junior, two sophomores and one freshman.

• MT has proven to be one of the nation's winningest programs through the years. The Blue Raiders are 18th all-time in winning percentage with a .684 mark and their 825 all-time victories are 30th most among NCAA Division I basketball.

• During the last five years MT's .754 winning percentage is 16th best nationally, and its 135 wins are 19th most. The 135 wins are the most by any C-USA team during that stretch.

THE INSELL FILE

There has been no other coach in Middle Tennessee women's basketball history that produced the success that Rick Insell has in 10 seasons. Since his arrival to Middle Tennessee in 2005, he has led the Raiders to eight NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNITs, coached five All-Americans and grew four WNBA Draft picks.

In his 10 years, the five-time hall of fame inductee has established a track record unlike any other in the Blue Raiders' rich women's basketball history, while also creating lofty expectations. Entering his 11th season leading his alma mater's women's basketball program, Insell has also positioned Middle Tennessee as one of the winningest programs nationally.

Insell, the program's all-time winningest coach with 252 victories, is among the nation's leaders in his profession. Middle Tennessee's .770 winning percentage over the last five years is 15th nationally, and the program's .687 ledger is 17th best all-time.

Insell is listed ninth on the Division I all-time winningest coach list (by percentage) with a .766 ledger. His is listed seventh on the Division I winningest active coaches list.

Under Insell's watch, Middle Tennessee is the only program nationally to have the NCAA Division I scoring champion three consecutive years (Amber Holt, 2008, Alysha Clark, 2009, Alysha Clark, 2010). Clark's back-to-back reign made her just the third women's basketball player in NCAA history to accomplish the feat and the first in almost a decade

Middle Tennessee has also participated in a national postseason tournament in each of Insell's 10 previous seasons, playing in eight NCAA Regionals and two WNITs. The 2014-15 Blue Raiders won three postseason games and reached the quarterfinals of the WNIT.

Attendance has also spiked during Insell's tenure. Middle Tennessee has ranked among the Top 25 nationally in attendance in each of the last three seasons, and the Blue Raiders have been ranked in the Top 30 nationally in eight of Insell's 10 seasons. The top 26 crowds in program history all have occurred during Insell's tenure.

Insell enters his 11th season at Middle Kyle and Matt.

Tennessee with a remarkable 252-77 (.766) NOTEWORTHY ledger. He surpassed Lewis Bivens as the program's all-time winningest coach with a 60-39 win at South Alabama (1/5/13), which was his 183rd victory at that time. On March 5, 2014, Insell secured his 1,000th career win, which includes his 775 victories at nearby Shelbyville Central High School.

His 100th victory came in the 2009 Sun Belt Tournament Championship game, as the Blue Raiders clinched the title over UALR. Insell also amassed an impressive Sun Belt ledger, posting a 142-18 (.888) mark during his tenure, including the league's last undefeated marks of 16-0 in 2011-12 and an 18-0 mark during the 2006-07 campaign. In eight Sun Belt Tournament appearances, he has lost just three times in 22 tries.

During the regular season against conference opponents, Middle Tennessee has won the last 60 out of the last 64 inside the historic Murphy Center.

Insell has collected seven regular-season championships (six in the Sun Belt, one in Conference USA) and six tournament titles (five in the SBC, one in C-USA) to his mantle. The six tournament titles also carried automatic berths into the NCAA Regionals. Insell's teams have also warranted two atlarge NCAA Regional berths (2011, 2012). His 2008 and 2015 teams participated in the WNIT. Middle Tennessee has participated in the postseason in each of Insell's 10 seasons.

Middle Tennessee also has won at least 20 contests in each of Insell's 10 seasons, including a school-record 30 victories during the 2006-07 campaign. The Blue Raiders also owned the nation's longest winning streak at 27 games and didn't lose for more than 100 days during the season.

Middle Tennessee also had a 20-game win streak in 2011-12, which was the secondlongest in program history. The top four longest-win streaks in school history have occurred under Insell and each has been at least 16 games. In 2013-14 his team strung together a 17-game win streak and finished the year with 29 victories, ranking secondmost in program history.

All of Middle Tennessee's All-Americans have been developed under Insell, who has also been the coach for four WNBA selections during his 10 seasons, including Alysha Clark, who was chosen 17th overall by the San Antonio Silver Stars in the 2010 Draft. She joined Amber Holt, selected ninth overall by the Connecticut Sun in 2008; Chrissy Givens, picked 31st overall by the Phoenix Mercury in 2007; and Cheyenne Parker, selected fifth overall by the Chicago Sky in 2015.

Insell is married to the former Deborah Spry of Woodbury, Tenn. They have three sons - Tóm,


