TIP OFF

- » UAB (9-7, 2-3) is coming off a 2-0 weekend that saw the Blazers extend their regular season home winning streak to 14, which began last January when UAB defeated Southern Miss 62-49.
- » UAB defeated conference foes Old Dominion and Charlotte, 58-55 and 75-57, respectively in its latest outings. In the pair of games last week, freshman guard Deanna Kuzmanic paced the Blazers, pouring in 18.5 points per contest in that span. Senior forward Brittany Winborne earned her eighth career double-double against Charlotte, on her way to averaging 14.5 points and 9.0 boards in the victories.
- » Senior guard Chelsee Black, who was honored for becoming UAB's 27th 1,000-point scorer, averaged 11.0 points per game over last week and is the Blazers' leading scorer this season. Kuzmanic has been hot from the floor, especially in conference play. She is averaging 2.6 treys per game, the third-most by any freshman in the nation. Against Old Dominion and Charlotte, she shot 7-of-13 from beyond the arc. Meanwhile, Winborne is shooting 57.7 percent (60-of-104) from the floor this season, a Conference USA-high.
- » The Blazers will look for the trio of Kuzmanic, Black and Winborne on the road. In its contests away from Bartow Arena, Kuzmanic and Black lead UAB with 11.7 and 11.0 points, respectively. Winborne dominates the glass, securing 10.4 rebounds a night.
- » Meanwhile, Rice (3-13, 2-3) is looking to bounce back after a tough road weekend, dropping back-to-back contests at Western Kentucky and Marshall. Prior to the road trip, the Owls defended their home court in two-straight overtime games, including their 100-97 win in triple overtime over North Texas. In the game prior, Rice edged UTSA, 49-48, at Tudor Fieldhouse.
- » Rice had a rough start to the season, as it began 0-7 with losses at powerhouses Kentucky, Texas, Harvard, Baylor, Houston, Stephen F. Austin, and others. Shani Rainey, who tallies 11.3 points per game, leads the Owls. Maya Hawkins is also a threat on offense, chipping in 10.7 points per contest. On the glass, Rainey secures 6.1 boards a night.
- » The Blazers hold a 6-5 advantage over the Owls in program history. In its latest meeting, UAB defeated Rice 75-59 at Bartow Arena. The Blazers have secured three wins out of their last five meetings with the Owls

BLAZER BITES

- UAB is in its 38th season of basketball. The Blazers are led by third year head coach Randy Norton. The Blazers own a 580-530 (.532) overall record. UAB has been a member of Conference USA for 21 years, beginning in 1995-96, and currently has a post a 147-175 mark in league
- UAB returns three starters from last season's squad which posted a top-four finish in C-USA. The Blazers return senior Chelsee Black, who leads the squad with 13.5 points per game, Kayla Anderson, who broke UAB's all-time blocks record this season, as well as Janeka Williams,
- . The squad also returns seven letterwinners: guards Bianca Dufelmeier, Whytney Singleton, T'erra Lewis, and Maya Garland, and forwards, Brittany Winborne and Dy'man Webb.
- · Joining the team this season are Keonna Farmer, a transfer from Auburn, Deanna Kuzmanic, the team's No. 2 leading scorer, Kara Rawls and
- Freshman guard Deanna Kuzmanic ranks second amongst all NCAA freshmen, averaging 2.7 treys per contest. She ranks 11th in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting 39 percent (46-of-118) from long range.
- Senior forward Brittany Winborne ranks fourth in Conference USA in field goal percentage and second in the league in rebounds per contest. She is shooting 56.6 percent (64-of-113) from the floor, and is reeling in a team-high 9.5 boards per game; The Maryland native notched her eighth career double-double against Charlotte.
- The Blazers are in the midst of a 14 home win streak at Bartow, dating back to January 17, 2015, when the Blazers took down Southern Miss for the first time in program history. In games since then, the Blazers have out-scored their opponents by 27.6 points per contest. UAB is averaging 73.7 points per game, while holding its foes to 46.1.

RANDY NORTON

Head Coach • Iowa, 1986

- Enters his third season as UAB's head basketball coach. Norton, a 30-year coaching veteran, was named the sixth head coach in UAB history on April 22, 2013 after serving as the associate head coach at the University of Missouri.
- UAB saw one of its best seasons in recent years during the 2014-15 campaign. The Blazers finished 18-13, marking the fifth consecutive winning season for the program. UAB finished with an 11-7 record in Conference USA play, which was the best since the 2006-07 season and just the second time since 1993-94 the Blazers have won 11 or more conference games.
- After being picked to finish eight in the C-USA preseason poll, UAB finished tied for fourth as the team closed out the season 11-5 in the last 16 games.
- Norton has coached at multiple levels throughout his career, including 13 seasons in NCAA Division I. With stops at Missouri and Illinois State, his teams have garnered two NCAA Tournament appearances, four WNIT berths, three Missouri Valley Conference Championships and two MVC tournament titles
- In three years at Missouri -- two as the lead assistant and one as the associate head coach --Norton helped revive the Tigers' women's basketball program with a WNIT bid in 2013 -- the school's first postseason berth in six years.
- Norton played both basketball and baseball for the Hawkeyes.

ON THE BENCH



TAREN MARTIN

Associate Head Coach • Illinois State, 2004

- Martin, a former player under Norton, coach Norton after three years as the head coach at Eureka College (DIII) from 2010-13. During her time in Eureka, Ill., Martin turned the Red Devils into one of the top programs in the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.
- Martin guided Eureka to 21 wins in 2011-12, marking just the fourth time in program history that the Red Devils have posted 20-plus victories. She garnered SLIAC Coach of the Year honors, while mentoring 2012 SLIAC Player of the Year Caty Eeten. In addition to her coaching duties, Martin was



ASHLEEN BRACEY Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coord. • Illinois State, 2010

- · Played for Norton at Illinois State and comes to the Blazers from Ball State, where she was the assistant coach on a team that went 18-15 overall and made it to the WNIT Final 16 in 2012-13. Previous to her stop in Muncie, Ind., Bracey was a graduate assistant at Missouri during the 2011-12 season and was an assistant coach for Eureka College in 2011.
- Played professional basketball in Athens, Greece in 2010.



EMILY HANLEY

Assistant Coach • Illinois State, 2011

- Joined Norton's staff in 2014 after serving as the JV girls head coach and varsity assistant coach for two years at Bloomington High School.
- During her time with Bloomington, the team had an overall record of 34-14. Last season, she helped lead them to a 21-3 finish to improve from a 13-11 record in 2012-13.
- Hanley played for Norton from 2008-11, after transferring from Eastern Michigan after one season. She was a three-time letterwinner with ISU and was named team captain as a senior. Hanley earned WNIT All-Tournament Team honors in 2011 and was also named to the Missouri Valley All-Conference First Team that year.

BARTOW ARENA



- Bartow Arena is in its 28th season as the home court for the women's basketball, men's basketball and volleyball teams.
- Bartow Arena has afforded the Blazers a solid home court advantage, as UAB posts a 249-139 (.637) record in the building.
- The arena was dedicated on December 3, 1988. The first win for the Blazers came on December 6, 1988, against Southern University, 66-64. The facility was renamed Bartow Arena on January 25, 1997.
- Bartow is a spacious 18,000-square feet floor space with lower level seats retracted, enough room for three full courts (basketball or volleyball).
- With a maximum capacity of 9,000, Bartow Arena has 6,500 permanent seats, and 2,000 retractable.
- Over the years, improvements have been made, such as a state-of-the-art video boards, administrative towers annex, a new locker room for football, a new paint scheme for both the permanent and portable floors, and major renovations to the Green and Gold room.
- Bartow Arena was the site of the 1991 Sun Belt Women's Tournament and the 1996 Conference USA Women's Championship. The Conference USA Tournament will return to Birmingham this year, as UAB will host the Conference USA Tournament at Bartow.

January 21, 2016 UAB's Fiery First Half Staves off Rice Comeback Blazers earn C-USA road win

HOUSTON, Texas - First-half magic enabled the UAB women's basketball team to earn a 64-55 road win at Rice on Thursday night. The Blazers' top-scoring duo of senior guard Chelsee Black and freshman guard Deanna Kuzmanic led UAB in the attack pouring in 17 points apiece.

Kuzmanic and Black combined for a 9-of-17 (53 percent) showing from long range, pushing the Blazers past the Owls. Kuzmanic, who earned her third-straight game with 17 or more points, ranks third in the nation in triples per game (2.6) and it showed, as she went 4-of-8 from long range. Black became UAB's 20th all-time leading scorer as she totals 1,181 points in her career.

UAB (10-7, 3-3) spurted out to an early lead, thanks to a 15-2 run to close out the first quarter, enabling it to take a 21-11 lead. The Blazers extended their lead as they went on a 9-2 run to open the second quarter and more than doubled the Owls' total, owning a 30-13 lead. UAB was on fire as it was 12-of-22 from the field, including 5-of-7 from beyond the arc, with just 4:16 remaining in the second quarter.

However, Rice hit some key buckets as it closed out the first half on an 11-2 run, but the Blazers held a distinctive advantage, leading 32-21.

The third quarter put pressure on UAB as Rice cut into the Blazer lead, in part to a 19-9 Owl-run, to give UAB a one point lead, 41-40, with 3:19 to play. The Owls were shooting 64 percent as they were 6-of-8 from the floor, including 3-of-4 from beyond the arc.

The Blazers would not go down without a fight as they never relinquished their lead. Heading into the fourth and final quarter, UAB held on to its lead, 46-42.

After Rice cut the lead back down to four on the opening possession, the Blazers bounced back on a 9-0 run to give some cushion to their lead, 55-44, at the 6:30 mark. The Owls would not go quietly as their press allowed them to respond with a 9-0 run of their own, holding the Blazers scoreless for four minutes, to make it a two-point game, 55-53, with 4:32 on the clock.

Kuzmanic would not allow it. She halted the run with a triple to make it a two-possession game. From there, Kuzmanic and Black went into cruise control as they scored the remaining six points to earn the road victory.

In the game, UAB shot an even 50 percent (25-of-50) from the floor and an impressive 47.4 percent (9-of-19) from 3-point range. Conference USA's top-ranked defense held the Owls to just 55 points as they shot 4-of-14 (28.6 percent) from deep and 50 percent overall.

Brittany Winborne reeled in a game-high eight boards and chipped in eight points on the night. Kuzmanic dished out a game-best four assists.

Rice was led by a trio of owls as Jasmine Goodwine (16), Wendy Knight (12) and Maya Hawkins (11) scored in double figures. Goodwine reeled in a team-high seven boards.

February 12, 2015 // **UAB's Balanced Attack Tops North Texas, 74-40** // Blazers had 11 players score in the win BIRMINGHAM, Ala. - A balanced scoring night along with another strong defensive effort propelled the UAB women's basketball team past North Texas, 74-40, on Thursday night. The Blazers held their second-straight opponent to under 45 points.

"This was a real good win for us," head coach Randy Norton said. "One thing that sticks out right now is that we had 24 assists. I felt like we were really unselfish and we moved the basketball. We really took advantage of them trapping our posts, Janae (Smith) and Kayla (Anderson) and all of our posts did a great job of finding people and we made them pay. We challenged them at halftime to step up defensively and we held them to 17 points in the second half. I felt like we played much better on the defensive end."

It was a true team effort as all 13 players eligible to play appeared in the game for UAB (13-10, 7-5 C-USA). The team shot 50.9 percent from the field and dished out a season-high 24 assists on 28 field goals. The Blazers also continued to play solid on the defensive end, holding North Texas (3-19, 2-9 C-USA) to just 29.5 percent shooting.

Of the 13 players, 11 of those scored on the night. Seniors Janae Smith and Miranda Burroughs led the charge with 18 and 12 points, respectively. Smith recorded her sixth double-double of the season with 11 rebounds and junior Kayla Anderson added eight as the Blazers outrebounded North Texas 46-36. All put one player picked up a rebound. Anderson along with sophomore Janeka Williams led the Blazers with six assists each.

UAB took control of the game early with a 7-0 lead, holding North Texas scoreless until the 17:38 mark. The Mean Green used a 7-0 run to take its first lead of the game, 11-9. The Blazers responded with five-straight points after layups from Smith and junior Lauren McGraw to retake the lead, 14-11 with 9:16 to play in the first half.

The teams traded points back-and-forth until an 11-0 run for the Blazers, which included three 3-pointers, put UAB out front, 25-16, with 4:49 on the clock. UAB then closed out the half with a 10-2 run to head into halftime up, 35-23. Burroughs had three of her four 3-pointers in the opening period.

UAB burst out of the gates in the second half with a 10-0 run to take its largest lead of the game at the time, 42-23. Tough defense by the Blazers held North Texas with just one basket in the first six minutes of the second half.

The team also found its rhythm from beyond the arc with three of its first six baskets coming from 3-point range as Black, Burroughs and freshman Whytney Singleton netted a three. Anderson put in a layup to stretch the lead out to 52-29, with 11:32 remaining in the game.

Anderson used one of her assists to find Smith down low as the senior converted the layup to continue to hold UAB's lead to 23 points, 58-35, with 7:43 left in the game. Shortly after, junior Bianca Dufelmeier hit her second 3-pointer of the night as the Blazers led North Texas, 61-35.

Once again UAB proved its defensive power, holding the Mean Green scoreless for five minutes until a layup with a minute remaining. With a 70-40 lead, freshman Maya Garland came off the bench to hit a 3-pointer for her first career-points as a Blazer as UAB closed out the 74-40 win.

UAB VS. NORTH TEXAS

- » UAB and North Texas are meeting for the fifth time in program history.
- » Last time the Blazer and Mean Green faced off, UAB took home its first win over North Texas in convincing fashion with a 74-40 victory at
- » Chelsee Black led all returners in the win, pouring in nine points. The Bessemer, Ala., native shot 75 percent (3-of-4) from beyond the arc in the win. Brittany Winborne reeled in eight boards to lead the Blazers' returners.

WINBORNE IS WINNING.

- » Senior forward Brittany Winborne is at the top of her game, and its shows in the Conference USA.
- » She currently ranks second in rebounding in the league, reeling in 9.5 per contest, while shooting the fourth-best percentage from the floor, 56.6 percent (64-of-113).
- » Winborne also ranks second in the conference, averaging 1.7 blocks per contest. Breaking down the rebounding stats - she ranks third in offensive (3.8) and is also third in defensive (5.9) boards per game.
- Against Charlotte, Winborne recorded a career-high 21 points while reeling in 12 boards, earning her eighth career double-double. The Baltimore, Md., native shot 7-of-11 from the floor, and 7-of-9 from the charity stripe.

RUNNIN' IT AT HOME.

- » UAB has started the 2015-16 home schedule off the same way it finished last season's. The Blazers are 7-0 at home after decisive victories over South Carolina State, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Mississippi Valley State, Troy, Samford, Old Dominion and Charlotte.
- » The Blazers are 26-10 at Bartow Arena under head coach Randy Norton.
- » The 2014-15 season was the most home wins since the 2000-01 season and just the fourth time UAB has had 12 or more wins since it began playing inside Bartow Arena.
- » The Blazers' home win streak was extended this past weekend with their 58-55 win over Old Dominion for the Blazers' first league win of the season, followed by the 75-57 win over Charlotte. The streak was jump started by a win over Southern Miss, the first in program history, last season, 371 days ago.


