#### SMU AT NORTH TEXAS TUESDAY IN FIRST ROAD TEST

The SMU women's basketball team plays its first road game of the season Tuesday at North Texas. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. The contests marks the start of a stretch of six of the next seven games played away from Moody Coliseum, including a road game at No. 9 Texas A&M Monday at 11 a.m.

#### SCOUTING SMU

The Mustangs are 3-2 this season, and are averaging 71.4 points per game. Alicia Froling is averaging a double-double with 16.2 points and 10.8 rebounds per game, and sophomore transfer McKenzie Adams is scoring 13.2 points per game. SMU has five players averaging at least nine points per game. As a team, the Mustangs are shooting 41.3 percent from the field, led by Stephanie Collins' 55.8 shooting percentage.

#### LAST TIME OUT

The SMU women's basketball team claimed the SMU-hosted Thanksgiving Classic title, sweeping the field, first defeating Cal State Fullerton, 74-53, before taking down Kansas, 73-64, the following day.

#### Cal State Fullerton

Alicia Froling recorded her third double-double of the season, and four Mustangs scored at least 10 points as SMU beat Cal State Fullerton, 74-53, at Moody Coliseum.

#### Kansas

McKenzie Adams finished with a career-high 24 points, and the SMU defense forced 25 turnovers, as the Mustangs knocked off Kansas, 73-64.

#### SCOUTING NORTH TEXAS

The Mean Green hold a 1-3 record four games into the season, falling to Arizona, 51-44, in their last game. North Texas finished 5-24 last season, with four wins at home. This season, the Mean Green are being out-scored by opponents 241-228 and averaging 57 points per game. North Texas has three players averaging double figures in points, led by junior guard Terra Ellison, who is scoring 13.0 per game.

**Series History:** This will be the 47th meeting between the two teams. SMU holds a 30-16 all-time advantage over the Mean Green. The Mustangs beat North Texas last season, 62-55, and have a three-game win streak over North Texas.

#### UP NEXT

SMU returns to Moody Coliseum Saturday to host New Mexico at 5 p.m. The Lobos are 4-2 on the season, and play at UTEP before heading to Dallas to square off against the Mustangs.

**Series History:** The two teams are knotted 2-2 all-time. The last time the two teams met was in 2010 at the WNIT in Albuquerque, New Mexico, where the Lobos ousted the Mustangs, 66-51.

### OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION

The Mustangs are averaging 71.4 points per game and have a +10.2 scoring margin over opponents. SMU has eclipsed 70 points in four of its five games this season after reaching 70 points just twice last season with a season-high 77 points against Florida A&M. Five Mustangs are scoring at least nine points per game, with three averaging double figures, led by Alicia Froling's 16.2 points per game. Transfer McKenzie Adams is scoring 13.2 points per game, while Stephanie Collins is scoring 10.4 points per game, shooting a team high 55.8 percent from the field.

### FINISHING STRONG

The Mustangs have outscored opponents 182-159 in the second half this season. In the fourth quarter alone, SMU is out-scoring opponents, 105-79 and averaging 21 points. Alicia Froling and Stephanie Collins are each averaging 4.2 points in the final 10 minutes.

### SMU THANKSGIVING CLASSIC MVP

McKenzie Adams earned the SMU Thanksgiving Classic MVP award, finishing the tournament with 39 points, 12 assists and seven rebounds. The newcomer also finished the weekend, shooting 46.4 percent (13-of-28) from the field and 88.9 percent (8-of-9) from the free throw line. The sophomore transfer from Arkansas scored a career-high 24 points against Kansas, making four 3-pointers and six free throws. Adams was named to the American Athletic Conference weekly honor roll.

### FROLING'S EARLY SEASON DOMINANCE

Sophomore forward Alicia Froling has scored at least 10 points in each of the last seven games, dating back to March 2 of last season. The Queensland, Australia, native has eight career double-doubles, including three this season. She scored 26 points with 14 rebounds against TCU, one shy of matching her career high in both categories. Froling is averaging 16.2 points and 10.8 rebounds through five games this year, both team highs.

### STEPHANIE COLLINS

Stephanie Collins joined the Mustangs after the first semester last season and played in 20 games, starting eight. She reached double digits twice, scoring a season-high 13 points at East Carolina. The 6-5 center had 25 blocks, recording four in a game three times. Collins tied the SMU single-game blocks record with six against Arizona State, matching Sarah Davis and Kendall Shead, who each had six blocks March 3, 2006, against Tulane. It was the first time an SMU player had at least five blocks since Alice Severin had five against UCF March 7, 2009. Collins is averaging 10.4 points per game shooting 55.8 percent and grabs an average of 4.8 rebounds per game.

### LONE SENIOR

Gabrielle Wilkins, the lone senior on the SMU roster, is scoring 9.4 points per game with a 48.6 field goal percentage. The 5-9 guard scored 19 points with nine rebounds during the SMU Thanksgiving Classic, while shooting 50 percent from the field. The Garland, Texas, native has recorded a season-high 11 points twice this season, scoring 11 points with four steals against TCU, before posting 11 points with three assists against Kansas.

### STANDOUT NEWCOMERS

Junior guard Ashley Gibson and freshman Dai'ja Thomas are making names for themselves among first year players. Gibson, a transfer from Butler CC, is averaging 9.5 points per game and shooting 41.9 percent from the field and 38.9 percent from behind the arc. Thomas, The American Freshman of the Week in week one, is averaging 4.6 points per game, shooting 47.1 percent from the field, and averaging 3.8 rebounds.

### BLOCKS RECORD

With Alicia Froling setting a single-season record with 54 blocks and Stephanie Collins recording 25 in 20 games, the Mustangs went on to set a program record with 160 blocks as a team. The Mustangs had six blocks in the opener this season, and recorded five blocks against TCU. Collins tied the SMU single-game record with six blocks against Arizona State, and has 14 this season.

## INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Alicia Froling represented Australia at the 2015 FIBA U19 Women's World Championships in Russia, winning a Bronze medal with the team, her second career medal at the World Championships. A native of Queensland, Australia, Froling averaged 8.1 points per game, reaching double figures twice, including a tournament-high 19 points during group play. She also averaged 6.9 rebounds per game, and shot just under 70 percent from the free throw line. Stephanie Collins also represented Australia at the 2015 World University Games.

## MORGAN BOLTON

Morgan Bolton led the team with 73 assists in her first season on the floor with the Mustangs. The junior guard averaged 5.9 points per game and shot 71 percent from the free throw line. Bolton was the top scorer in three games, including a season-high 13 points against Tulane and again at Memphis. The transfer from Arkansas-Little Rock also had a season-high seven assists twice, against UTEP and Florida A&M. She scored at least 10 points in two of the last three games.

## A MISSING PIECE

SMU will be without Kiara Perry this season as the junior sits out with a redshirt due to a back injury. As a sophomore, Perry led the team with 39 steals and averaged 7.9 points per game. The guard shot 33 percent from the field and 64 percent from the free throw line.

## 25TH SEASON

Rhonda Rompola is in her 25th season as head coach of the Mustangs. The former player who spent eight years as an assistant at SMU before being named head coach, has amassed over 400 wins in 24 seasons. SMU has competed in the postseason 13 times during her tenure, including seven NCAA Tournament berths. SMU has won at least 20 games in nine seasons, with three regular-season conference championships and two conference tournament championships.

# RHONDA ROMPOLA

**HEAD COACH  
SMU, '83  
25TH SEASON**

Rhonda Rompola is entering her 25th season as head coach of the Mustangs and has an overall record of 426-300 (.587). During her tenure as head coach, Rompola has led the Mustangs to the postseason 13 times, including seven NCAA Tournament berths (1994, 1995, 1996, 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2008), five conference championships, winning the WAC tournament in 1999 and the Conference USA tournament in 2008. Her teams also won the WAC regular-season championship in 2000 and the C-USA regular-season championship in 2009 and 2013.

She has guided her teams to 20 wins in a season nine times, including a program-record 24 wins in 2007-08. Rompola has coached 17 different players to 34 different all-conference selections, one All-America award winner, three conference Players of the Year, two conference Defensive Players of the Year, and earned Coach of the Year accolades after four seasons.

Rompola has been a part of the SMU women's basketball program since the 1981-82 season when she led the Mustangs to 18-15 record as a player. She scored 683 points during her lone season, which stood as the single-season record until Keena Mays scored 691 in 2013-14. She ranks tied for second in rebounds in a season with 278, and still holds the record for most free throws made in a season with 163. She played just one season after transferring from Old Dominion, leading the Monarchs to AIAW national championships in 1979 and 1980. She graduated from SMU in 1983, and then spent eight seasons as an assistant coach for the Mustangs before taking over the program in 1991.

After a 17-12 record in her first season, which included a vote in the Associated Press Top 25 poll, Rompola directed her squad to a 20-11 mark, the first 20-win season for the Mustangs, and a trip to the WNIT final in the 1992-93 season, the program's first postseason appearance. SMU earned invitations to the NCAA Tournament each of the next three

seasons, and upset No. 7-seed Southern Mississippi 96-95 in overtime in the first round of the 1995 tournament. The win was the 21st of the season, another new high for the program.

SMU went 19-11 during the 1996-97 campaign, missing the postseason, but returned to the postseason stage each of the next three seasons, advancing to the second round of the NCAA tournament in the 1999 and 2000 tournaments after losing in the first round of the 1998 tournament. SMU captured its first conference championship in 1999, defeating No. 4 Colorado State 65-49 in the Western Athletic Conference championship game, the highest ranked opponent SMU has beaten in program history. The Mustangs then beat Toledo 91-76 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament for their 20th win of the season, marking the first back-to-back 20-win seasons in program history. A year later, SMU celebrated its first regular-season conference championship, going 12-2 in the WAC. SMU finished with a 22-9 record overall in 1999-2000, a new program high for wins. Karlin Kennedy was named WAC Co-Player of the Year, the first under Rompola's tutelage. She also coached D-dra Rucker to a Player of the Year award in 2001 and Keena Mays earned the honor in 2013.

The Mustangs returned to the postseason in 2005, advancing to the WNIT after going 19-11. Janelle Dodds led the squad as a freshman, earning WBCA All-America honorable mention. SMU won a school-record 24 games during the 2007-08 season, advancing to the NCAA Tournament after beating No. 18 UTEP, which went undefeated in conference play, 75-62 to win the Conference USA tournament championship, the program's second tournament title. Dodds became the school's first two-time All-America selection, earning AP All-America honorable mention. She finished her career as the all-time leading scorer at SMU and still holds the record with 1,861 points.

The 2007-08 season sparked a string of three straight 20-win seasons, the second time the Mustangs won at least 20 games in back-to-back-to-back season, and SMU went to the WNIT in 2009 and 2010, marking the third time SMU advanced to the postseason in three straight seasons. SMU also went 12-4 in conference games in 2008-09, winning the C-USA regular-season title. The Mustangs added a third regular-season conference championship to the trophy case in 2013, going 12-4 in C-USA during the 2012-13 season. The run also saw Rompola earn her 400th career win, a 69-60 victory at home against Tulsa on Feb. 21, 2013.

## SMU PONY PROMISE

The Mission of SMU Athletics is to "prepare students for life." To that end, SMU is reinforcing its long-standing commitment to student-athlete development, well-being and experience with the Pony Promise. The Pony Promise consists of several initiatives that provide for an outstanding student-athlete experience from enrollment through graduation.

### 1. Student-Athlete Academic Services

Recognizing that varsity athletes commit to representing the University, and thus face the unique challenge of balancing academic and athletic objectives, SMU's Student-Athlete Academic Services team is tasked with providing mentoring and core skills support; help them respond effectively to specific academic challenges; better articulate their educational goals; and succeed in their undergraduate pursuits.

Student-athletes work through either the Altshuler Learning Enhancement Center (A-LEC) or the Center For The Academic Development of Student-Athletes (ADSA) for support.

The mission of the A-LEC is to help student-athletes respond effectively to specific academic challenges, articulate and achieve educational goals, and successfully complete the undergraduate curriculum. Specialists help student-athletes build success from the beginning, through both developmental and accelerated programs designed to maximize learning potential, personal adjustment, and academic performance.

ADSA staff provides services such as academic counseling, mentoring, tutoring and reading/writing assistance. ADSA has six Academic Counselors, three Reading/Writing Specialists, an Administrative Assistant and two interns. Additionally, ADSA works in collaboration with the A-LEC to provide disability services and other various programs.

### 2. Full Cost of Attendance

SMU provides scholarships up to the full cost-of-attendance for all student-athletes. Each school's financial-aid office, not its athletics department, uses a federal formula to set the cost-of-attendance figure for the school year. Using those guidelines, SMU's Financial Aid Office has set the figure at \$2,676 annually for full-scholarship student-athletes. That figure represents the gap between last year's full scholarship amount and full cost of attendance at SMU. Students may qualify for additional support based upon individual needs. For example, students with significant demonstrated need are eligible for a Pell grant in the amount of \$5,775 per academic year.

These figures do not include or take into account other distributions that SMU student-athletes may receive, such as off-campus stipends, which are provided to upperclassmen who, as the term would indicate, live off-campus after two years of on-campus residency. Those stipends are currently valued at \$15,650 per academic year (fall and spring semesters).

### 3. Student-Athlete Development & Welfare

#### Strength & Conditioning

Vic & Gladie Jo Salvino Strength & Conditioning Centers are located in the Paul B. Loyd, Jr. All-Sports Center and the Crum Basketball Center. Both of the state-of-the-art training facilities include functional drill space and Olympic platforms and weights. The Salvino Strength & Conditioning Centers also include aerobic equipment, weight stations and free weights.

#### Equipment & Apparel

SMU is a proud partner of Nike, who provides SMU gear and apparel. The SMU equipment staff handles all of the ordering and inventory of athletic gear for the SMU Athletic Department and its teams, custom fitting all Mustang student-athletes with all needed equipment.

#### Sports Medicine

The SMU Sports Medicine Program is housed in the Lindsay & Bobbie Embrey Sports Medicine Complex inside the Loyd All-Sports Center, and offers the outstanding services of leading sports medicine and health care professionals. The SMU Sports Medicine staff works with physicians to design rehabilitation programs for injured student-athletes to minimize the loss of fitness during recuperative time.

#### Mental Health & Sports Psychology

While intercollegiate athletics has a large focus on the physical demands for the student-athlete, SMU Athletics also understands the importance of providing resources to address the emotional and mental demands associated with being a student-athlete. Because of this, we have developed a two-tiered mental health program. One tier has a focus on the emotional and mental well-being of a student-athlete, while the other tier focuses on finding ways to address mental aspects of sport performance.

#### Tier 1: Mental Health and Well-Being

Mental Health Resources for Student-Athletes are designed to provide counseling services to meet the student-athletes' needs for achieving emotional well-being necessary for success in college. The life of a student-athlete often comes with pressures, high expectations, and many obligations that can potentially feel stressful or overwhelming. Counseling provides a confidential, supportive, and accepting environment to address issues that may be interfering with a student-athlete's ability to enjoy a fully satisfying life or reach his/her full potential.

#### Tier 2: Sport Psychology/Peak Performance

There have been a wide variety of written materials about the physical component of the game, yet the emotional and mental side often makes the difference in performance and outcome. One thing the student-athlete has complete control over is his/her thoughts, emotions, and behaviors that make up the main components of the mental skills process. Being keyed into these three areas will influence one's competitive edge. SMU Athletics strives for each student-athlete to take charge of his/her process of the game.

## Concussion Protocol

The SMU Sports Medicine Department has established a detailed protocol to manage the risks and concerns of concussions for SMU student-athletes. This management plan follows the guidelines and recommendations set forth by the NATA, NCAA, American Athletic Conference, United Educators and the practicing physicians involved in SMU Athletics. This policy is a living document that is reviewed annually by SMU Risk Management and team physicians. The purpose of this plan is to ensure that standards of care are being met and that overall healthcare and specifically the management of concussions is done in a manner that protects and treats the student-athlete with the highest regard to safety.

The concussion management plan is broken into three major components. The first component is education of concussions. The second is based upon the management and treatment of concussions. The third is the student-athlete's return to activity.

The SMU Concussion Policy has a management plan to help guide student-athletes safely through a return-to-play protocol, as well as a return-to-learn plan. Awareness and communication are key components to the management of our policy, and because of this, we involve key individuals ranging from administrators, coaches, academic advisors, neurologist, psychologist, team physicians and athletic trainers. Our policy also allows us to work within the University and the academic community in a manner in which accommodations can be made to help support the student academically through the recovery phase.

Mike Morton, SMU's Director of Sports Medicine, was hired this year by the NFL to serve as an injury spotter for games held at AT&T Stadium. To obtain this position, Morton completed an NFL training program to review and understand protocols in place to help identify NFL players that may be demonstrating symptoms associated with head and neck injuries.

#### Sports Dietician

The goal of a sports nutrition program is to ensure student-athletes are well nourished, optimally refueled after exercise to speed up complete recovery and prepared for overall lifelong health. By providing team talks, one-on-one meal plan counseling, grocery store tours, cooking classes and education at the on-campus fueling stations, the sports dietician engages with student-athletes on a daily basis. Other responsibilities include managing the ordering and inventory of the fueling stations, identifying optimal products to stock the fueling stations, developing relationships with vendors to support SMU student-athletes and creating custom educational materials.

#### Supplemental Meals & Snacks

SMU student-athletes have access to supplemental meals in conjunction with participation in athletic activities.

SMU Athletics has partnered with SMU Dining Services to provide SMU student-athletes with the best in nutritional and dining options. SMU student-athletes are able to access the Arnold Dining Commons to receive supplemental meals and snacks.

SMU student-athletes can also fuel up at the fueling stations located in the Salvino Strength & Conditioning Centers, where pre- and post-workout nutrition is available for student-athletes along with snacks for between classes.

#### 4. Life Skills Programming

SMU is committed to the holistic development of our student-athletes. Life Skills programming cultivates skills that prepare student-athletes for the ultimate competitive challenge - Life. Our S.T.A.N.G.S. (Student-Athletes Together Achieving the Necessary Goals for Success) program is based on:

#### Personal Development

SMU supports the development of a well-balanced lifestyle for student-athletes, encouraging emotional well-being, personal growth and decision-making skills.

#### Community Service

SMU facilitates community outreach opportunities for student-athletes, providing them with an appreciation for the value of service and a chance to show their gratitude to the DFW communities that support them.

#### Career Development

SMU places a priority on preparing students for life after college. Our program helps give student-athletes a career direction and provides networking opportunities.

#### Financial Literacy

SMU equips student-athletes with the tools needed to efficiently and effectively manage their resources and build a positive credit history, working to ensure that student-athletes will be prepared to handle post-graduate financial responsibilities.

#### 5. The Student-Athlete Advisory Council

The Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) is a partnership of the student-athletes representing all 17 sports at SMU. SAAC provides insight on the student-athlete experience. The SAAC also offers input on the rules, regulations and policies that affect student-athletes' lives on NCAA member institution campuses.

#### 6. Facility Enhancements

Providing championship-caliber facilities gives our student-athletes the best possible environment for success.

SMU opened a renovated and expanded Moody Coliseum and the new Miller Event Center in 2014. In 2015, SMU opened the new SMU Tennis Complex, completed Phase II of the DAC golf practice facility and updated the Salvino Strength and Conditioning Center and the football offices and meeting rooms. SMU is in the process of building other facilities, including a new home for golf and a track and field throws area, while a new aquatic center is close to breaking ground. An athletics facilities master plan is being developed to identify and address future investments in the student-athlete and fan experiences.
