The Buzz

After finishing as West Coast Conference tournament runners-up and earning their first postseason berth since 2002, USF opens the 2015-16 season on the road against North Texas.

#WeAreSF

USF wasted no time in showing its deeper, longer and stronger bench as the Dons wore down Stanislaus State in a 93-50 exhibition win.

The Dons enjoyed double-digit performances from four women, headlined by sharpshooter Anna Seilund. The sophomore from Copenhagen, Denmark, went 6-of-8 from 3-point range to finish with a game-high 20 points. Senior Taylor Proctor, a 2015-16 Preseason All-WCC selection, finished with a 12-point, 11-rebound double-double, and junior Rachel Howard added 13 points in the victorious effort.

Newcomer Raushan Gultekin, a junior transfer from Salt Lake Community College, finished with 10 points and a game-high four steals in her debut for the Green and Gold.

Sixth Season at USF (2010-present)
Career Record - 52-102 (22-60 WCC)

Now in her sixth season as head coach at USF, Azzi has transformed the women's basketball program into a bona fide postseason contender.

The 2014-15 season saw the Dons finish with a WCC Championship finals appearance, earning a bid to the Women's National Invitation Tournament, the program's first postseason appearance since the 2001-02 season. The Dons served notice they were a program on the rise by winning 10 of its first 12 games of the year and taking perennial power Gonzaga to quadruple overtime on the Zags' home court.

Junior Taylor Proctor earned first team All-WCC honors while junior Zhane Dikes earned honorable mention accolades. In addition, Paige Spietz (first team) along with Rachel Howard (honorable mention) and Alicia Scafidi (honorable mention) earned WCC All-Academic honors. Azzi's commitment to academics translated in the women's basketball program garnering a perfect 1,000 Academic Progress Rating in 2013-14.

After a lifetime associated as both a player and an ambassador for women's basketball, the assignment at USF serves as Azzi's first as a Division I head coach. The Bay Area Sports Hall-of-Famer (BASHOF) brings an impressive playing resume featuring successful tenures with the USA National Team, five seasons in the WNBA, a founding member of the American Basketball League (ABL), professional experi-

ence overseas and an All-American collegiate career at Stanford.

A four-year starter at Stanford from 1987-90, Azzi became the first Cardinal women's basketball player to earn the Wade Trophy, the James Naismith Player of the Year award, and the Honda-Broderick National Player of the Year honor. She was Stanford's first WBCA/Kodak All-American as a junior in 1989, and she earned the award a second time as a senior in 1990.

A three-time All-Pac-10 performer and the 1990 Pac-10 Player of the Year, Azzi led the Cardinal to a pair of conference titles (1989, 1990) while being a catalyst for Stanford's first national championship in 1990, leading her squad to a 32-1 record as the squad's captain. Upon her graduation from Stanford in 1990 with a B.A. in economics, Azzi embarked on a professional career abroad with stops in Italy (1990-91), France (1991-93), and Sweden (1994-95).

Azzi was one of the founding members of the American Basketball League. A three-time all-star, she played for the San Jose Lasers from 1996 to 1999. After the ABL folded in 1999, Azzi was drafted by the Detroit Shock in the first round, fifth overall pick, of the inaugural WNBA draft. During her four years in the league, she played for the Shock (1999), Utah Starzz (2000-03) and the San Antonio Silver Stars (2003). Internationally, Azzi was a key member of the United States gold medal-winning 1996 Olympic Team that concluded a perfect 60-0 season with an 8-0 record during the Olympic Games in Atlanta.

Preseason Prognostications

For the second straight year, USF senior forward Taylor Proctor, was named to the Preseason All-WCC Team.

During her junior year, Proctor became the 20th woman in program history to reach the 1,000 point plateau, and she also reached the 500-rebound milestone. She currently stands at 1,179 career points and needs 77 points to break into USF's top 10 scorers.

After a season which saw the San Francisco women's basketball team advance to the West Coast Conference championship game and earn a postseason berth for the first time since 2001-02, the league's coaches have voted the Dons to finish fifth in the preseason poll.

The Cougars - whom USF faced in the 2014-15 WCC Championship game - were tapped to finish second, with four first-place votes and 76 total points. Only two points separated BYU and the preseason favorites, Gonzaga, who have won at least a share of the last 11 WCC regular season championships.

2014-15 Year in Review

The Dons enjoyed one of their most successful seasons in this millennium, capped with a spot in the West Coast Conference championship final against BYU, a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament and multiple team and individual benchmarks finding their way into the USF record books.

WCC Championships QuickCap

USF entered the conference tournament as the No. 6 seed at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas. By the time they left the desert, the Dons had upended third-seeded Pacific and the No. 2 seed San Diego. In USF's victory over the Toreros, the Dons overcame a 17-point first-half deficit, their largest comeback win of the season.

USF advanced to the WCC title game for the first time since taking the crown in 1997 before falling to BYU, 76-75.

Taj Winston paced the team with averages of 20.7 points on 52.6 percent shooting, 7.3

rebounds and 2.0 steals a game through three contests. For her efforts, she was named to the All-Tournament squad, the first time a Don had graced the postseason team since 1997.

Dons in the Postseason

The 2015 WNIT marks the fifth time in program history USF has made the field of a postseason tournament since Division I women's basketball was sanctioned by the NCAA in 1981.

The Dons faced off against Fresno State in the first round of action, and nearly pulled off the road victory before wilting in the final minutes. USF led for a large chunk of the tightly-contested game, holding the advantage as late as 38 minutes into the contest.

But inopportune misses from field, coupled with turnovers and uncharacteristic miscues from the free throw line proved to be a deadly combination in the closing moments of the action, falling 79-73 to the Bulldogs.

WCC in the Postseason

For the second straight season and the third time in four years, the WCC sent two teams to the NCAA Tournament: BYU and Gonzaga. This marked the 10th time that two WCC teams have advanced to the NCAA postseason.

A record four West Coast Conference programs captured berths in the 2015 WNIT - Pacific, Saint Mary's, San Diego and San Francisco. A new conference record was established with six teams competing in the 2015 postseason (two NCAA, four WNIT).

Record-Setters & Award-Getters

The Dons set new school benchmarks in scoring, with 2,308 total points, and 548 free throws made also stands as a new program best. USF's 1,271 total rebounds marks the second-best tally in the record books.

Taylor Proctor was named a first-team All-WCC performer for the Dons after leading the team with 15.5 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Zhané Dikes earned honorable mention status for her efforts on the season, averaging 13.0 points, 5.1 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.2 steals per game.

By the Numbers

As a team, the Dons finished the year ranked in the top four in 11 WCC statistical categories. Offensively, USF finished third in scoring offense (69.9 ppg) while holding opponents to 64.8 points per game (3rd). Solid from the line, the Dons hit their free throws at a 75.7 percent clip (3rd), and USF connected on 42.5 percent of its attempts from the field.

Individually, Taylor Proctor landed in the top 10 in multiple categories, including scoring (15.5 ppg - 6th), rebounding (7.9 rpg - 6th) and field goal percentage (.473 - 6th). Anna Seilund's debut season for the Green and Gold saw her perched atop the WCC in 3-point field goal percentage, as she sunk 45.3 percent of her shots from distance. Taj Winston closed out her career with the second-best steals average in the WCC (2.4 spg).
