News and Notes from the Big Sky

*Idaho received votes in both the AP and USA Today Coaches' Polls this week.

*Portland State guard Cici West opened the week with a career performance against cross-town rival the University of Portland. She scored a career-high 16 points, going 5-for-9 from the floor and 6-for-8 at the free-throw line against the

*Southern Utah's Ashleigh Munns put up 38 points in the University of New Mexico Thanksqiving tournament with 11 three-pointers.

*Montana State forward Peyton Ferris averaged 15.7 points, 9.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists, while shooting an impressive 67 (16-24) percent from the field and 88 (14-16) from the free throw line.

*Idaho State forward Anna Policicchio led the team in rebounding with 5.3 per game and was second on the team in scoring with 15.7 ppg, in the Bengals' three games last week.

*Weber State's Regina Okoye had a marquee performance against Portland last week. Okoye put up 21 points, a new season high and tied her career high. She also pulled down a game high of eight rebounds.

*Sacramento State guard Ashlyn Crenshaw scored a career-high 20 points with a career-high seven steals in Sacramento States lone game last week vs. San Francisco. She was a perfect 4-of-4 from 3-point range and 8-of-11 overall from the field, scoring 15 points in the second half.

*Northern Colorado's Savannah Scott had herself a coming out party over the weekend averaging 18.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 2.0 steals in the two games, helping UNC go 2-0. In both games against Akron and Valparaiso she led the team with 16 and 21 points, respectively.

*Eastern Washington guard Tisha Phillips scored 15 points, four rebounds, four assists and three steals in the Eagles' narrow fourpoint loss to No. 19 Northwestern.

*Montana forward Kayleigh Valley averaged 20 points on 48.0 percent shooting and 7 rebounds as Montana finished third at the Christmas City Classic at Bethlehem, Pa. Valley matched a career high with 29 points in Sunday's consolation-game victory over Drexel.

LAST WEEK'S ACTION - AGAINST PORTLAND

WSU had a five point lead with 1:34 remaining in the game but the Pilots went on a 5-0 run tying the game up at 55-55 with 12 seconds left on the clock.

Okoye came through for the Wildcats in the end scoring a layup with four seconds left to give the Wildcats the 57-55 victory.

The Wildcats were led by Okoye with 21 total points for a new season high. She shot 66 percent from the field and 71 percent from the free throw line.

Deeshrya Thomas also scored in double digits having 11 points on the night. Quinn added eight points for the Wildcats and Dunbar contributed seven.

Okoye and Jocelyn Adams had game highs of eight rebounds each. Kailie Quinn also pulled down six rebounds for the Wildcats. Thomas had the game high of three steals and Adams had the game high of three blocks.

Weber State shot 41.2 percent from the field and 70 percent from the free throw line. The Wildcats had 13 turnovers to the Pilots 17. There were six lead changes during the game and the score was tied 5 times.

SERIES HISTORY - NORTH TEXAS

This will be the third meeting between North Texas and Weber State. The two teams are tied at 1-1 overall in the series. The last match up between the two teams was in 2003 in Ogden. The Wildats downed the Mean Green 70-65. This is the first time the Wildcats will play in Denton, Texas since January of 2003. Weber State is 0-1 overall at North Texas.

ABOUT NORTH TEXAS

North Texas is 2-3 overall on the season. The Mean Green are coming off a 60-57 win over Southern Methodist University. UNT are averaging 57.6 points per game and shoot 42.4 percent from the field, 35.6 from the three and 66.7 percent from the free throw line. The team averages 35.4 rebounds per game.

North Texas is led by Terra Ellison who averages 12.2 points per game. She has a 41.7 field goal percentage so far on the year and is shooting 62.5 percent from the free throw line. Acheil Tac is the Mean Green's top rebounder averaging 7.8 per game and pulling down 39 total on the season.

HEAD COACH BETHANN ORD

Bethann Shapiro Ord is beginning her fifth seeason as head coach of the Weber State women's basketball team. Ord was named head coach of the Wildcats in May of 2011 after a long career as an assistant coach. She is the fifth head coach in WSU women's basketball history.

Ord came to WSU with 22 years of coaching experience. Before coming to Weber State she spent four seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Louisville. At Louisville, Ord was instrumental in the Cardinals signing three top 15 recruiting classes and one in the top five. She also helped bring two high school All-Americans to Louisville.

A native of Rochester, Ord earned her bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County in 1989. She was a three-year letterwinner and starting point guard for the Retrievers. She earned a Master's degree in Elementary Education from Wagner College in 1992.

SERIES HISTORY - STEPHEN F. AUSTIN

This will be the first ever meeting between Stephen F. Austin and Weber State.

ABOUT STEPHEN F. AUSTIN

Stephen F. Austin is 4-2 overall on the season. The Ladyjacks are coming off a 67-63 loss to UT Arlington. SFA is averaging 74.2 points per game and shoot 44.5 percent from the field, 39.6 percent from the three and 72.1 percent from the free throw line. The team averages 33 rebounds per game. SFA is led by Taylor Ross who averages 22.3 points per game. She has a 56 field goal shooting percentage from the field. Ross is also 72.7 percent from the free throw line. Stevi Parkis is the Ladyjacks top rebounder averaging 7.2 per game and pulling down 43 total on the season.

LOOKING AHEAD

Something to look forward to during non-conference play is the road game to Washington. The Wildcats will have a trio of home games against in-state rivals Brigham Young, Utah Valley and Westminster. Big Sky Conference play will start Jan. 2 at Idaho State to take on the Bengals. The first home Big Sky Conference game will be Jan. 14 against Portland State for the annual Field Trip day.

COACHING STAFF

Weber State head coach Bethann Ord is returning for her fifth season at Weber State. Returning with the Wildcat coaching staff is Devan Newman who is also in her fifth year. There are two new additions to the coaching staff this year with JD Gustin and Matt Thune. Gustin served the last four years with the University of Utah's women's basketball program. Before his time with the Utes he was the head women's basketball coach at Westminster and led the team to five consecutive NAIA National Championship appearances. Thune spent the last three years on staff with Lousiville women's basketball including two as the program's video coordinator.

RETURNING WILDCATS

After losing three seniors off last years squad, Carlee Lough, Brianna Averette, and Zakiyyah Shahid-Martin the team is returning nine players including seniors Regina Okoye, Tinisha Toussaint and Brittney Dunbar.

Okoye has played in 86 career games and started 80 games. She finsihed the 2015 season leading the country in steals averageing 3.68 per game and had a total of 107 on the year. Toussaint has played in 84 career games and started eight games. In one year at Weber State, Dunbar has played in 21 career games and started eight games.

The returning juniors are Deeshyra Thomas and Dionne Coe. Thomas battled with injuries last year but still remained a leading point guard for the Wildcats. Coe redshirted last year with the Wildcats.

Sophomores Jocelyn Adams, Kailie Quinn, CeCee Wooten, and Sira Toure coming back as well. Quinn was one of the teams top scorers averaging 6.2 points per game and played in all 29 games starting in 15. Quinn also racked up 62 career three pointers last year.

NEWCOMERS

The Wildcats are welcoming four new freshmen to this year's squad including Tyschal Blake, Yarden Danan, Emily Drake and J'aimoni Welch-Coleman.

2014-15 SEASON RECAP

The Wildcats are coming off a 11-18 overall record and 6-12 Big Sky Conference record. Weber State started off the season with three consecutive wins for the first since the 2006-07 season. The Wildcats picked up a big double over time win over New Mexico State with a final score of 100-97.

Weber State picked up six conference wins including two over Southern Utah and one over Northern Arizona. They ended the year with a thrilling overtime loss to Eastern Washington falling 64-62.

Weber State took on No. 19 Oklahoma State last year only falling by six to the Cowgirls and manage to keep the score within three the majority of the game.
