NORTH TEXAS QUICK HITS

North Texas is 17-11 in nonconference games this season, including an 8-2 mark in nonconference home games. The Mean Green have five home games remaining, beginning with a doubleheader against Texas Tech.

With Sunday's 9-3 loss to Louisiana Tech, North Texas was mathematically eliminated from contention for

the Conference USA Tournament in Denton. The Mean Green have six conference games remaining.

Kelli Schkade leads Conference USA in home runs (12) and slugging percentage (.745) and ranks third in on-base percentage (.488) and fourth in batting average (.406).

After a 6-4 start that included a pair of wins over nationally-ranked Baylor and a tournament title at the Getterman Classic, the North Texas softball team received votes in one of the national polls for the first time in school history. North Texas received two votes in the USA Today/NFCA Division I softball coaches poll.

North Texas garnered 41 points and was picked to finish 10th of 12 teams in the C-USA preseason poll. Florida Atlantic, with nine first-place votes and 141 of a maximum 144 points, was tabbed as the favorite.

Leading Off

North Texas concludes a five-game homestand with a doubleheader against Texas Tech on Wednesday, before returning to the road for its final four road games of the season. The Mean Green look to snap a seven-game losing streak, dating back to a 10-2 run-rule win over Georgia Tech in five innings on Sunday, April 10 at the Kansas Round Robin. North Texas is 17-11 in nonconference games, 9-10 in home games, 8-2 in nonconference home games and 2-4 against Big 12 teams this season. North Texas is 4-5 all-time against Texas Tech, dropping both games of a doubleheader in Lubbock in 2014.

Final Two Weekends Of Conference Play

With two leagues series remaining, on the road against UTEP and at home against UAB, North Texas sits in 12th place of 12 teams with a league record of 3-15 and has been mathematically eliminated from contention for the Conference USA Tournament. The eight-team Conference USA Tournament field will include the top three teams (by winning percentage) in the East Division standings and the top three teams (by winning percentage) in the West Division Standings, as well as two wild card teams from either division.

Schkade's Streak

Kelli Schkade recorded a hit in each of the first 19 games, setting the school record for the longest hitting streak. Her solo home run in the fourth inning against Sam Houston State on Feb. 28 broke the record. In addition to a hit in each of the first 19 games, she also had eight multi-hit games. During the 19-game stretch, she led the team in batting average (.431), home runs (8), RBI (23), as well as slugging percentage (.881) and total bases (59). She saw her hit streak come to an end, going 0-for-3 in the series opener against UTSA.

CONFERENCE USA PRESEASON POLL ANNOUNCED

Florida Atlantic, with nine first place votes and 141 of a maximum possible 144 points, has been tabbed as the favorite to take the 2016 Conference USA softball crown, as selected by the league's 12 head coaches. UAB's Caitlin Attfield, the reigning 2015 C-USA player of the year, was named the 2016 preseason player of the year. For the second-consecutive season, Florida Atlantic snagged preseason pitcher of the year honors, thanks to junior ace Kylee Hanson.

After finishing second to WKU in both regular season and tournament action a year ago, the Owls look poised to reload and get over the hump in 2016. Joan Joyce's squad returns 12 of 16 players from her 2015 roster, including a scary pitching duo of Hanson and Amanda Wilson, who shutout eventual national champion Florida through seven innings in the Gainesville regional last year.

Marshall, voted a close second in the poll, picked up two first place votes and landed a league-most four athletes on the preseason All-Conference USA squad. The Thundering Herd return a stock of talent including

2015 C-USA freshman of the year Elicia D'Orazio, Team USA member Morgan Zerkle and 33-game winner Jordan Dixon.

After nearly knocking off the eventual C-USA champion Lady Toppers in the semifinals in 2015, UAB is slated to challenge for this year's championship once again after being tabbed third in the preseason poll. Head coach Marla Townsend has the Blazers aimed at a return trip to the NCAA Tournament (2014), led by Conference USA preseason player of the year Attfield and preseason All-C-USA member Sara Beth Williamson, both of which earned first team honors at the conclusion of last season.

The 2016 Conference USA Championship is slated to take place May 11-14 at Lovelace Stadium, hosted by North Texas, in Denton, Texas. The league's top eight teams in the final regular season standings qualify for the tournament, with the first round being a single elimination format and the quarterfinals/semifinals being a double elimination format. The championship game will be televised live nationally by CBS Sports Networks.

Playing Them Close

Through 46 games, North Texas has already played six extra-inning games and 13 one-run games, posting a 3-3 record in extra-inning games and a 7-6 record in one-run games. The most recent such game was a 3-2 loss at Southern Miss. North Texas has won four games in walk-off fashion and has also lost two games in walk-off fashion. Freshman first baseman Rhylie Makawe drove in the game-winning run to defeat Southern Utah 6-5, junior outfielder Danielle Gregory scored the game-winning run to defeat Liberty 1-0 and drove in the game-winning run to defeat nationally-ranked Baylor 7-6, and freshman third baseman Harley Perella drove in the game-winning run to defeat UT Arlington 1-0.

Playing The Field

The nation's fifth-best fielding team in 2015, North Texas has turned in a repeat performance in 2016 fielding at a .974 clip in 2016, the best mark in Conference USA and the fourth-best nationally, recording 903 putouts, 314 assists and just 32 errors in 1,249 fielding chances. Senior catcher Bryana Wade has also thrown out 17 of 36 runners who have attempted to steal a base this season.

Honors Roll In For Schkade

After a week of games at Stephen F. Austin and WKU that saw her lead North Texas in several offensive categories, including batting average (.571), on-base percentage (.667) and slugging percentage (.929), junior shortstop Kelli Schkade was recognized by the league office as the Conference USA Co-Player of the Week on March 28. It's the second Conference USA weekly honor for the Mean Green this season and the second of her career, earning the honor after the first week of play on February 15.

Topping The Defending Champs

Hitting, and specifically timely and significant hitting, proved to be the difference in the series at defending regular season and tournament champion Western Kentucky. After being limited to just five hits, tied for its third-lowest output of the season in the first game, a 6-3 loss in eight innings, North Texas bounced back with 15 hits in a 9-4 win in game two and 10 hits in a 9-6 win in the rubber game. In the first game, North Texas was 3-for-19 with runners on base, including 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position, and 1-for-10 with two outs. In the second and third games, North Texas was a combined 14-for-32 with runners on base, including 10-for-24 with runners in scoring position, and 7-for-17 with two outs.

History Repeating

With the weekend sweep of then-No. 21 Baylor, North Texas picked up its 10th and 11th win over nationally-ranked teams in school history, improving to 11-90 all-time against top-25 teams. North Texas has defeated multiple ranked teams in the same season for the third time in school history and the first time since 2011, when the Mean Green defeated three ranked teams. In addition, seven of the 11 wins over nationally-ranked teams have come against Baylor, including three in the last two seasons.

Coming Through In the Clutch

Timely hitting lifted North Texas to both of its wins over No. 21 Baylor. In the first game, North Texas scored four of their seven runs with two outs, including the game-tying runs in the sixth inning and what proved to be the game-winning runs in the ninth inning. In the second game, North Texas scored six of their seven runs with two outs in the inning, including the game-tying runs in the seventh inning and the game-winning run in the eighth inning.

By The Rankings

North Texas has played four ranked teams this season, winning twice at No. 21 Baylor, losing once at No. 13 Arizona, losing once at No. 19 Baylor, and losing once at No. 9 Oklahoma, moving to 11-92 all-time against top-25 opponents.

Tracking The RPI

North Texas checks in at No. 125 in this week's RPI rankings, the 10th-highest ranking among Conference USA teams. North Texas enters the week with a 7-14 record against RPI top 100 teams, including a 2-3 record against RPI top 25 teams, which includes two wins over No. 14 Baylor and a win each over No. 78 UT Arlington, No. 86 Northwestern State, No. 87 Marshall and two wins over No. 98 Nicholls State.

Power-Five Competition

North Texas has faced six of its eight power-five conference opponents this season, going 2-1 against Baylor, 1-1 against Georgia Tech, 0-2 against Kansas, and dropping one game each to No. 15 Arizona, Purdue and No. 9 Oklahoma. The Mean Green will face Texas Tech on Wednesday and Texas next week.

NCAA Tournament Tested

North Texas will face five 2015 NCAA Tournament teams in 2016, as the program pursues its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in its own right. NCAA Tournament teams from last season on the schedule include Super Regional participants in Arizona and Oklahoma, Western Kentucky from Conference USA, as well as Baylor and Texas from the Big 12 Conference.

Third Year 🕨 East Carolina '90

Tracey Kee is entering her third season at North Texas as

one of the winningest active coaches in NCAA Division I, boasting a career record of 734-415-1. Hired in August 2013, she became the fourth Mean Green softball head coach in the current era. In her two years, Kee has led the program to record heights and several program records and firsts.

Most notably, Kee took the Mean Green to the most wins in the program's 11-year history with 31 in 2014. The following year, North Texas upset No. 7 Baylor on the road in Waco, the highest ranked team that the Mean Green have defeated in program history and just their second-ever top-25 win.

The Mean Green has seen four different players earn all-conference honors under Kee, including Kat Strunk, a two-time honoree and the 2014 C-USA Newcomer of the Year, the first specialty award in program history.

In 2015, Taylor Schoblocher earned Amateur Softball Association/USA Softball National Player of the Week honors, the program's first national award.

As a team, under Kee, the Mean Green has set several records, including the most conference wins (14), most runs scored (272), most RBI (242), highest batting average (.279), highest fielding percentage (.978) and fewest errors committed (30).

In 2014, Ashley Kirk broke the single-season wins record with 22 victories and single-season strikeout record with 214. In 2015, Schoblocher set the singleseason marks for on-base percentage (.477) and slugging percentage (.833) and finished with the second-best single-season batting average (.389) and second-most home runs (17) and total bases (120).

Off the field, North Texas softball graduates Lauren Poole and Madison Thompson were awarded the Jim Castaneda Postgraduate Scholarship in consecutive years, the first and second North Texas athletes to receive the honor in school's first two years of conference membership.

Prior to North Texas, Kee compiled a 684-362 record in 16 seasons as the East Carolina head coach, and guided the Pirates to four NCAA Tournament appearances including three in her last five years. Kee and her staff were also named a National Fastpitch Coaches Association Mideast Region Coaching Staff of the Year honoree twice.

She also captured nine league championships, with back-to-back C-USA Tournament titles in 2010 and 2011. From 2009 to 2011, no Conference USA program won more games than East Carolina's 125.

ECU recorded 41 victories in 2011 to become only the fourth team in C-USA history to win 40 or more games in three-straight seasons. Kee's clubs have reached the 40-victory plateau 12 of her 16 seasons. Four times her teams have tallied 50 or more wins, including the 2000 group she directed to a schoolrecord 60 victories. Personally, she reached the 650win threshold as a head coach in 2011.

ECU won its first C-USA titles in 2010, claiming both the regular season and tournament titles before repeating as tournament champions in 2011.

In just her first season as head coach in 1997, Kee's team posted a 49-24 record, and she was named Big South Coach of the Year. Two seasons later, in 1999, East Carolina won 50 games and made its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Under Kee's tutelage, many players have earned allconference and all-region honors. During her time in the Big South, she led 11 all-conference players, two Rookie of the Year selections, the league's tournament MVP, Denise Reagan, in 1999 and the two-time league player-of-the-year in Polonius (1998 and 1999).

The accolades continued in Conference USA as Kee's players received 12 first-team selections and 15 second-team honors. Additionally, 14 studentathletes have been named to the all-rookie team with two named the league's freshman of the year.

In 2009, Kee led Toni Paisley to Conference USA Female Athlete of the Year honors, becoming just the second softball selection in league history. Kee





North Texas advanced to the Conference USA Tournament for the second straight year, upsetting No. 7 Baylor on the road in Waco, the highest-ranked team that the Mean Green have defeated in program history and just their second-ever top-25 win.

North Texas finished 19-31 with an 11-12 record in Conference USA play, earning the No. 7 seed in the Conference USA Tournament, where the Mean Green bowed out in the first round with a 5-0 loss to No. 2 seed FAU.

Under Kee's tutelage, North Texas placed Kat Strunk on the first team All-Conference USA team and Taylor Schoblocher on the third-team All-South Region team. Schoblocher also earned Amateur Softball Association/USA Softball National Player of the Week honors, the program's first national award, after hitting six home runs and driving in 12 runs during the opening weekend of the season.

Schoblocher and Strunk were also the bookends for Conference USA Players of the Week, with Schoblocher earning the honor for the first week of the season and Strunk earning the honor for the last week of the season.

As a team, North Texas set several individual and team records. The Mean Green fielded at .978 clip and committed just 30 errors, the best marks in school history.

Individually, Schoblocher hit .389 for the season with 17 home runs and 120 total bases, the second-best marks in school history. Her .477 on-base percentage and .833 slugging percentage were the best in school history.

Struck hit .359 for the season with 13 home runs, the fifth-best and fourthbest marks, respectively, in school history. Dani Hoff also tied for the best field percentage in school history, posting a .997 mark, recording 297 putouts with 18 assists and just one error.
