AROUND THE LEAGUE

Ticket Punched

Defending C-USA Champion WKU, currently at 10-0 in league play, became the first squad to clinch a berth in this season's postseason tournament with a victory over UAB on Sunday, Oct. 23. With roughly three weeks left, only one squad has been eliminated from the field.

More Sunday Madness

With eleven squads still in contention for the seven remaining Conference USA Championship berths, the league is seeing the level of competition elevate with each passing weekend. The standings saw a shakeup on Sunday, as Middle Tennessee and Louisiana Tech pulled off upsets in C-USA's 15th and 16th five-set matches of the season. Meanwhile, Charlotte knocked off North Texas in a 3-0 home sweep by holding reigning C-USA player of the year Carnae Dillard in check.

#CUSAVB Upset Alert

Heading into Sunday's match, Rice sat in a tie for fourth place in the 2015 Conference USA Volleyball Standings while Middle Tennessee held a tie for the eighth spot. After a thrilling five-set road victory over the Owls in Tudor Fieldhouse, the Blue Raiders knock Rice down to the seventh spot in the standings. Currently tied for 8th, MT is fighting to qualify for its first C-USA Volleyball Championship since it hosted the event in 2013.

Climbing to the Top of the Hill

After receiving votes in the 2015 AVCA preseason poll, WKU went a perfect 3-0 on opening weekend, including a 3-1 upset of then-No. 5 Wisconsin on the road. As a reward, the Lady Hilltoppers launched up to No. 20 in Week 1 before immediately falling out the next week. After receiving votes in the following four consecutive polls, WKU has found its way back into the national poll, claiming the No. 23 spot in week six and rising to No. 22 in week seven of the rankings.

C-USA on the National Stage

Conference USA volleyball has enjoyed the spotlight so far in 2015, knocking off three of the five AVCA Top 25 ranked squads member schools have faced so far in 2015. In addition the league's members have also managed a 3-3 record against teams receiving votes in the poll. In all of NCAA Division I, Conference USA has amassed a 101-76 overall record in non-conference play, good for the fourth-most wins among all conferences (only the Big Ten, SEC and ACC have more). C-USA is one of four leagues to reach a triple digit non-conference win total. The overall record includes collective undefeated marks (combined 12-0) against the Pac-12, Patriot League, Colonial Athletic Association, Ivy League, Metro Atlantic Athletic, Mid-Eastern Athletic and Northeast conferences. C-USA schools have taken care of business with a 35-10 record against Ohio Valley, Southland and SWAC opponents while also holding a winning record against three of the "power five" conferences (ACC, Pac-12 and Big 10).

VAIO We're Talkin'

Kimberly Vaio and the Rice Owls knocked off No. 23 Colorado at home, 3-1, to sweep the Rice Adidas Invitational and win the championship. #CUSAVB is still undefeated (2-0) against PAC-12 teams (UTSA defeated No. 12 Oregon on September 7, 3-1 at home).

#BirdsUp, #DucksDown

The incredible run for Conference USA volleyball in 2015 continued on with **UTSA** joining the upset trend, knocking off No. 12 Oregon 3-1 (21-25, 25-23, 25-19, 25-23) in front of a crowd of 1,051 fans in the Convocation Center in San Antonio. The Roadrunners' convincing victory gives #CUSAVB two wins against Top 15 teams this season.

David Beats Goliath (Again)

North Texas' upset of (RV) Oklahoma on the road in Norman provided the league with one of its six victories over a Top 25/Receiving Votes opponent this season. The Mean Green relied heavily on senior leader and 2015 Conference USA preseason player of the year Carnae Dillard to lead the way in the five-set thriller (15-25, 25-22, 25-23, 21-25, 15-13). Her 22-kill, 14-dig performance provided the cushion needed to squeeze past the Sooners on the road, giving North Texas wins over Big 12 opponents in back-to-back seasons now.

WKU Knocks Off No. 5 Wisconsin

The highlight of the season's opening night came from one of the league's two Top 25-matchups, as (RV) WKU knocked off No. 5 Wisconsin, 3-1 (13-25, 25-23, 25-19, 25-19), on the road in Madison, Wisc. WKU's triumph over the Badgers marks the third consecutive season that the Lady Tops have knocked off a ranked-Big Ten foe as WKU defeated then-No. 8 Purdue, 3-2, last season in E.A. Diddle Arena after knocking off the #16 Boilermakers, 3-2, in West Lafayette in 2013.

Rice Mounts Comeback, Downs (RV) LSU

The Owls bounced back from a season-opening defeat at the hands of No. 3 Texas to knock off (RV) LSU, 3-2 (24-26, 21-25, 25-17, 25-16, 15-10). Rice trailed 0-2 in the match before turning on the jets to mount a furious comeback against the Tigers, dominating the final three sets of play to pull off the league's second major upset in the first two days of the 2015 season.

CUSAVB Gains Social Media Presence

Due to the gaining popularity of the sport and the continued success of the league's 13 volleyball members, Conference USA has launched a Twitter account solely dedicated to #CUSAVB. By following @CUSAVB, Conference USA volleyball fans, coaches, and players alike will have the ability to receive up-to-the-minute updates of the league's happenings.

WKU Looks To Defend Title

Following a share of the C-USA regular season crown and a C-USA tournament title during its inaugural season in the league, WKU made its eighth appearance in the NCAA tournament, facing Iowa State in 2014. The Lady Toppers only lost one league match en route to their titles, and the squad has been tabbed to repeat in the #CUSAVB preseason poll, where it collected 163 points as voted by the league's 13 head coaches.

UTSA To Host Championship

The Conference USA Volleyball Championship will be hosted by the Roadrunners of UTSA in San Antonio, Texas, on Nov. 20-22. The 2015 edition of the event will mark the first time UTSA will play host to a Conference USA championship in any sport.

Tie-Breaking Procedures

Article II - Section T - Page 145 - 2015/2016 C-USA Membership Handbook

Ties in winning percentage, and thus for seeding positions shall be broken according to the following formula (in order):

1. Overall Conference win/loss percentage of all Conference matches;
2. Head to head match record between tied teams;
3. Compare records vs. teams with highest winning percentage in Conference play in descending order until tie is broken. When arriving at a set of tied teams (i.e., winning percentage) while comparing records, use each team's record vs. the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking process);
4. Most recent RPI.

For multiple team ties, the first team to win the above tiebreaker will be seeded and separated from the tied teams. Once this happens, the remaining teams will start the process again at step 1. This process will continue until all ties have been resolved.
