## MIDDLE TENNESSE BLUE RAIDERS

All-Time Series: North Texas trails 8-12 Last Meeting: North Texas won 3-2 on 10/31/14

Middle Tennessee is 8-20 on the season, a record that ultimately resulted in the mid-season departure of the team's head coach. Even so, MTSU can still take the final birth to the conference tournament with wins this weekend, meaning Middle will be desperate and dangerous.

Chelsea Ross is the No. 1 option for Middle Tennessee. Averaging 4.77 kills per set, Ross ranks second in the league. On defense, Jacqueline Lux leads the team with 4.20 digs per set, while LaVondria Covington's 1.01 blocks per set is eight-best in C-USA.

## **UTSA ROADRUNNERS**

All-Time Series: North Texas trails 8-16 Last Meeting: North Texas lost 3-0 on 9/27/15 Palileo Era: 1-3 Palileo's Career: 1-3

UTSA hasn't been able to pry the conference's top spot from nationally-ranked WKU, but the Roadrunners have been the league's No. 2 team all season. At 21-7, the Mean Green will have a tough test in its last home match of the year.

UTSA has one of the league's top attackers in junior Dajana Boskovic, who averages 4.46 kills per set and has won C-USA's Offensive Player of the Week award each of the last three weeks. In addition to Boskovic, the Roadrunners have two players in the league's top 10 for blocks - Megan Slan (1.05 b/s) and Kylie Schott (1.03 b/s) - as well as the top-10 list for service aces - Antonela Jularic and Amanda Gonzalez.

## MEAN GREEN STORYLINES

#### #NaeDay

Thursday's match against Middle Tennessee will serve as senior night for Carnae Dillard. The team's lone senior will be recognized prior to the 6 p.m. start time. North Texas has won its last six senior day matches, doing so in convincing fashion. Since 2009, every Mean Green senior day match has resulted in a 3-0 win. The last NT loss on senior day came in 2008, a 3-2 shortfall to Little Rock.

#### **Conference Kill Queens**

All three of the conference's kills leaders will be in action for North Texas matches this weekend. The Mean Green's own Carnae Dillard leads Conference USA with 5.49 kills per set. Middle Tennessee's Chelsea Ross (4.77 k/s) and UTSA's Dajana Boskovic (4.46 k/s) come in at second and third, respectively.

#### Atop the Mountain

All season long, watchfuf eyes have been set on Carnae Dillard as she approached the program's all-time kills record. On Friday, the wait was over as Dillard finally reached the mountaintop. With her fourth kill of the match, the North Texas senior officially passed Mean Green hall-of-famer Corina Marginas for the program's top spot on the kills list. Now with 2,260 career kills, Dillard leads all active D-I volleyball players.

## National Recognition Once Again

Carnae Dillard continues to garner national attention. On Wednesday, she was named espnW's National Player of the Week, following a 52-kill weekend that saw her take the program's kill record. Dillard won Sports Imports/AVCA DI Player of the Week honors last season, exactly one year prior to Wednesday's award.

## E for Efficiency

This year's volleyball team is hitting at a historically accurate pace as the squad's .235 hitting percentage would be the third-best mark in team history. Additionally, sophomore Amanda Chamberlain's .316 percentage comes in at third all-time as she has a .310 average for her career. The all-time career record for hitting percentage is .330, set by Karissa Flack in 2013.

#### **Five-Time Favorite**

On five seperate occassions this season, senior Carnae Dillard has been named C-USA Offensive Player of the Week. The San Antonio native most recently won the award after combining for a .312 hitting mark and 44 kills in two matches against LA Tech and #22 WKU. Thirty of those kills came in a five-set thriller against the conference frontrunner Lady Toppers.

## Welcome to the Club

With her very first kill in the team's first matchup against Rice of 2015, Dillard became only the second player in North Texas history to reach 2,000 career kills. With every match, the outside hitter approaches the all-time kills record set by Corina Marginas in 2003. She broke the all-time kills record last week against Florida Atlantic.

## A Hot Start In C-USA

North Texas got off to a strong start in conference play, accumulating a 6-1 C-USA record to start league action. That was the best conference start to a season since 2002, before a No. 22-ranked WKU team handed the Mean Green its first C-USA loss at home on Oct. 18.

#### Home Winning Ways

The North Texas Volleyball Center has been an increasingly tough place for visiting teams to play since head coach Andrew Palileo's arrival in 2013. In fact, the Mean Green has a 30-9 record in home matches under the Mean Green skipper, dropping only two matches in 2013, three contests in 2014 and four matches this season. Overall, North Texas has an 85-53 record from its home court.

## Pali's Progress

In his third season at the helm, Palileo has established himself as one of the most effective coaches in North Texas history.

#### Fountain of Youth

With only two upperclassmen, this year's squad is one of the youngest teams in C-USA. Seven newcomers - made up of six freshmen and a transfer from Texas Tech - join nine let-terwinners from a year ago. North Texas brings back 75 percent of its scoring and 76 percent of its kills from 2014.

#### Last Woman Standing

Senior Carnae Dillard is the only remaining player or coach from her freshman season in 2012. Since that time, head coach Andrew Palileo & Co. made their way to Denton, and the freshmen that accompanied Dillard during her first year are no longer on the roster.

#### North Texas Picked Fourth In C-USA

NT was picked to finish fourth in Conference USA for the third consecutive year, according to the 13-team poll of league coaches.

The Mean Green is picked to end the year behind WKU, UTSA and Rice, while a fifthranked Florida Atlantic rounds out the top five.

#### **Dillard Named Preseason C-USA POY**

Senior Carnae Dillard was named the 2015 Conference USA Preseason Player of the Year in a poll of the league's coaches in July.

Dillard's selection comes as she looks to defend the conference's top individual honor from a season ago. In 2014, Dillard led C-USA in kills (615) and points (672.5).

## Coaching Changes in 2015

Head Coach Andrew Palileo is joined by two new faces on the coaching staff. Vinh Nguyen was named associate head coach in July after volunteering with the the team for part of the 2014 season. He brings 20+ years of volleyball experience from the West Coast. Also joining the staff is assistant coach Rachel Todorovich, a former player for Palileo during her freshman and sophomore seasons at Washington State.

Head coach Andrew Palileo (paw-leh-lay-oh) continues to develop what has been a young and exciting North Texas volleyball team.

In his second year at the helm. Palileo guided the Mean Green to one of the best seasons in school history. Led by eventual Conference USA Player of the Year Carnae Dillard, Palileo & Co. racked up a 21-9 record entering the postseason, the second-best regular season win total in North Texas history. With momentum on its side and riding a program-best 10-match win streak, North Texas would make it to the C-USA semifinal round before falling to eventual conference champion WKU. The team's individual talent was recognized as Dillard took all-conference first team honors, senior Hanna Forst was named to the second team, and Amanda Chamberlain was placed on the conference's all-freshman squad.

In his first year at North Texas, Palileo led the Mean Green through its initial year in C-USA and accumulated a 17-15 record that came within a few points of the conference's semifinal round. Two players, sophomore Carnae Dillard and senior Karissa Flack, were named to the C-USA all-conference team while setter Amy Henard was an all-freshmen selection..

Palileo arrived in Denton from Ohio State where he was an assistant coach for two years bringing an extensive resume of experience at the Big-10 and Pac-12 levels to the Mean Green. His most recent head coaching position was at Washington State from 2008-2010. While in Pullman, Wash., Palileo took the Cougars to the NCAA tournament in 2009, their first trip in seven years. He also received the Pac-12 Coach of the Year award that same season.

Before heading to Washington State, Palileo was head coach for seven years at South Dakota State where he gathered 154 wins and 86 losses. He was named the 2007 Summit League Coach of the Year, when the South Dakota State Jacks were the Summit League regular season and tournament champions and made the first trip in school history to the NCAA Championship Tournament that fall. Palileo's crew broke or tied 23 team or individual records during 2007.

Prior to South Dakota State, Palileo was the head volleyball coach at Bethel University (St. Paul, Minn.), where he had an 85-53 record in four seasons, the best four-year mark in school history. While at Bethel, he produced eight first-team All-Conference players, a first-team All-American and two academic All-Americans.

Palileo also coached the Club SoDa 18s volleyball team in Brookings, S.D., from 2002-2008, and was the Heartland Adidas Select Volleyball Program 18s head coach for five years in Minneapolis, Minn. He served as the director of the Crosstown Junior Olympics at Edina High (Minn.) from 1993-97, and he was the JV coach at Waconia (Minn.) High from 1986-90. A highly-regarded clinician, Palileo has also been the head coach of the Midwest Volleyball Instructor Elite Camps since 1997.

A graduate of Crown College (St. Bonifacius, Minn.), Palileo received his bachelor of arts degree in missiology in 1991 and a bachelor of arts degree in social science/secondary education in 1995. He went on to earn a master's degree in educational leadership from Bethel University (St. Paul, Minn.) in 2000.

Palileo and his wife, Wendy, have three sons, Ashton, Austin and A.J., and one daughter, Alyvia.
