Volleyball Eagles Travel Rice, North Texas

HATTIESBURG, Miss. -- The Southern Miss volleyball team is back on the road traveling to Rice and North Texas on Oct. 29 and 30, respectively. The Golden Eagles face the Owls on Thursday at 6 p.m. and take on the Mean Green Friday at 7 p.m.

The Golden Eagles improved to 21-7 overall with an 8-3 record in league play following a 3-0 sweep of UAB on Sunday, Oct. 25. So far in 2015, six Eagles have recorded 120 or more kills, including junior Stephany Purdue who leads the team with a 3.93 kills per set average. Freshman Kylie Grandy is not far behind with 2.35 kills per set. Freshman setter Sarah Bell has been the primary setter this season, averaging 9.81 assists per set. Senior libero Mary Pursell has a team-high 4.70 digs per set.

As a team, Southern Miss is averaging 12.99 kills, 15.39 digs and 2.19 team blocks.

Rice is 16-8 overall with a 6-4 record in Conference USA play. Leah Mikesky paces the Owls with a 3.65 kill per set average while Chelsey Harris is next at 3.07 kills per set. Madison McDaniel guides the offensive with 10.62 assists per set. Kimberly Vaio is averaging 3.82 digs per set while Portia Okafor is averaging 1.19 blocks per set.

As a team, Rice is averaging 14.10 kills, 15.81 digs and 2.12 team blocks.

Southern Miss vs. Rice

The Golden Eagles are 4-11 all-time against the Owls in a series dating back to 1991. This is the first meeting between the two teams this season.

North Texas is 14-11 overall and 6-4 against C-USA opponents prior to the Southern Miss matchup. Carnae Dillard leads the Mean Green and C-USA with a 5.35 kill per set average. Four Mean Green players average over 2.00 digs per set, with Dillard lead the quartet at 2.94 digs per set. Amy Henard guides the office with 9.70 assists per set.

As a team, North Texas is averaging 13.36 kills, 14.23 digs and 1.97 team blocks.

named Conference USA Players of the Week with Stephany Purdue earning Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Mary Pursell earning Defensive Player of the Week for October 5.

Stephany Purdue tallied 65 kills on a .225 hitting clip to average 4.64 kills per set. She recorded double-digit kills in each match including a pair of matches with 20 or more kills. Purdue had one double-double with 25 kills and 10 digs against South Alabama. She had four service aces against UAB. For the week, she totaled 24 digs and seven total blocks. On her first kill against UAB, she reached the 1,000-kill milestone.

Mary Pursell collected 68 digs during the week to average 4.86 digs per set. She recorded 20 or more digs in each of the matches. She also tallied two aces and had 19 assists during the week. She had a .975 reception percentage. Pursell moved into the No. 3 spot on the all-time digs list and needs just two to move into the No. 2 slot.

BELL NAMED FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Sarah Bell posted a pair of double-doubles in guiding Southern Miss to two conference wins over the weekend. She totaled 106 assists for a 10.60 per set average. She also finished with 28 digs for a 2.80 dig per set average. Against FIU, Bell tallied 50 assists and 11 digs while adding a block. In the win against LA Tech, she put down two key kills in the fifth set including the final kill to seal the victory. She tallied 56 assists and 17 digs. Bell finished with nine kills on the weekend. This is her first C-USA honor.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Southern Miss had a pair of Golden Eagles earn Conference USA Player of the Week honors for their respective performances. Stephany Purdue was named Co-Offensive Player of the Week after tallying 94 kills for a 4.95 per set average while hitting .254 for the week. She recorded double digit kills in each match including a season-high 25 against Southeastern Louisiana (9/1). She also had a 23-kill performance against Alabama (9/5). Purdue posted three double-doubles during the week. She collected 49 digs for a 2.58 per set average. She record four aces and had nine total blocks while scoring 5.39 points per set. Purdue was named the MVP of the Bama Bash Tournament. This is Purdue's first career honor.

Mary Pursell was named the Defensive Player of the Week as she finished the week with 119 digs for a 6.26 per set average. She posted back-to-back 30-dig performances in the Bama Bash Tournament and just missed a 30-dig performance against Southeastern Louisiana (9/1) when she finished with 29 digs. She tallied 14 digs against College of Charleston and 12 against Northwestern State. She had two aces and finished with a .979 reception percentage. Pursell was named to the Bama Bash all-tournament team. This is Pursell's second career Defensive Player of the Week honor.

FOR 30

Senior Libero Mary Pursell posted back-to-back 30-dig performances with a 31 against Alabama (9/5) and followed with 33 against Tulsa (9/5). She just missed the 30-dig mark with 29 against Southeastern Louisiana (9/1).

SOUTHERN MISS PICKED SIXTH IN PRESEASON POLL, PURSELL NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE USA

Defending Conference USA volleyball champion WKU has been tabbed as the 2015 C-USA Volleyball preseason favorite, as voted by the league's 13 head coaches while North Texas player was picked as the preseason Player of the Year.

UTSA was picked to finish second while Rice and North Texas rounded out the top four. Southern Miss was picked to finish six, behind Florida Atlantic.

The reigning Libero of the Year Mary Pursell was named to the 2015 preseason all-conference team. She was a first team selection last season. She finished with 546 digs and ranked third overall in the league while sitting atop of that category against C-USA teams. Pursell totaled 28 matches with double digit digs, including her last 24. She also had the team in digs at 4.51 digs per set. She was named Defensive Player of the Week.
