Computer Proficiency Requirement

The purpose of the Computer Proficiency Requirement is to demonstrate that you can use basic computer applications in ways that relate to your studies in music.

You complete the proficiency by submitting evidence that you can use the following applications:

Music Notation and Sequencing:

- a. Select a Gregorian Chant score and mp3 file from this web site: http://www.ccwatershed.org/kyriale/
- b. Use any music notation editor to transcribe the chant. Note that the site contains files in modern notation (click on "organist PDF").
- c. Harmonize the chant melody in four voices (add three voices to the chant melody).
- d. Create a PDF file from your music notation (Print to PDF).
- e. Create an mp3 file from your transcription.
- f. Use a free sequencing program (like Audacity) to mix your mp3 file with the mp3 file that you downloaded from http://www.ccwatershed.org/kyriale/
- g. You will need to edit your mp3 file with the sequencing program so that it is time-synchronized with the downloaded file. The "time shift" tool in Audacity will help.

Attach these items to an email addressed to <u>jaymee.haefner@unt.edu</u> during the first two weeks of April, the second week of July, or the first two weeks of November. **Include your full name and student ID number.**

If you completed Theory III at UNT before Fall 2011 and did not receive credit for the computer proficiency, it is because you did not submit all of the required items. Please submit all of the above items.

If you completed Theory III at UNT (regular section of class, not the accelerated section) with a C or better during or after Fall 2011, you have met the computer proficiency requirement. Students may also complete the computer proficiency by successfully completing MUCP 4670, MUJS 3610, or MUGC 4890 (Finale) at UNT.
