- Student must earn a grade of “C” or better in core English classes.
- Student must earn a grade of “B” or better in Jazz classes.
- For core class options please refer to current schedule of classes under “University Core Curriculum” or access your degree audit in the Student Center site of your my.unt.edu account.
- Additional requirements include the Piano Proficiency Examination, Upper Divisional Examination, Concentration Proficiency Examination, Theory Proficiency Examination and Computer Proficiency.
- Students must pass the Jazz Concentration Proficiency in voice.
