2011: Carried the ball 12 times for 51 yards and a touchdown against Western Kentucky ... Ran for two touchdowns and 110 yards on 19 carries, just 12 yards shy of his career record ... Rushed for 10 yards on six carries against Tulsa ... Rushed for 64 yards on 12 carries against Indiana ... Threw a pass for 34 yards ... Averaged 4.7 yards per carry against Alabama on seven carries.

2010: Played in five games, starting the season opener at Clemson, before falling to injury ... Rushed for 214 yards on only 26 carries (8.2 avg) and a touchdown on the season ... Caught five passes for eight yards as well ... Returned two kicks for 28 yards ... Rushed for 52 total yards on only six carries (8.7 avg) at Clemson ... Rushed for 24 yards on five carries at Army ... Returned a kick for 28 yards against the Black Knights, totaling 52 all-purpose yards in West Point ... Carried the ball 11 times for a career-high 122 yards at FAU ... Rushed 32 yards for a touchdown with 7:45 remaining against the Owls, which was the eventual game-winning score ... Rushed for 10 yards and added six receiving yards against Louisiana-Lafayette.



2009: Played in nine games with no starts ... Was fourth on the team with 47 rushing yards on 11 carries ... Had a season-high seven carries for 31 yards against Alabama and added three carries for 16 yards and a touchdown against Western Kentucky ... Had two receptions vs. Middle Tennessee ... Played extensively on special teams, which included three kickoff returns for 63 yards.

2008: Carried the ball eight times for 49 yards ... Scored on a one-yard run at Florida Atlantic ... Longest rush was 23 yards ... Rushed for a season-high 31 yards against FAU ... Caught four passes for 32 yards with a long of 15 ... Returned six kickoffs for 110 yards (18.3 avg) ... Longest return was 29 yards ... Made the switch from defensive back to running back in the middle of the season ... Had two tackles ... Played in 11 games.

High School/Personal: A quarterback in high school ... Saw most of his production come with his feet instead of his arm as he led the team with 1,778 yards rushing yards and 20 touchdowns ... Led an offense that averaged 392.6 yards and 38 points per game in 2007 ... Named to 2007 Super List for HS quarterbacks by 5ATexasFootball.com ... Earned All-District 8-5A first team in 2007 ... Rated No. 53 on the Dallas Morning News area top 100 list ... Playing against an Irving MacArthur defense that only allowed 110 yards rushing per game, Hamilton ran for 196 yards on 20 carries and three touchdowns ... Son of James Hamilton and Chiquita Blackwell ... Born on March 25, 1990.
