2010: Led North Texas with eight tackles at Clemson ... Intercepted a Kyle Parker pass in the end zone, ending a potential Clemson scoring drive ... Had a game-high 11 tackles against Rice ... Had a tackle for a loss against the Owls, and recovered a Rice fumble in that game ... Led all players with 11 tackles at Army ... Made five stops at FAU ... Registered a game-high 12 stops against Louisiana-Lafayette ... Picked up two sacks against the Ragin' Cajuns ... Made a game-high 13 stops against Arkansas State ... Registered 2.5 tackles-for-loss against the Red Wolves, which is tied for ninth-most in a single game for North Texas ... Ran for 64 yards on a fake punt against FIU ... Collected a game-high 12 tackles and 0.5 tackles-for-loss against the Golden Panthers ... Made a game-high nine stops at Western Kentucky ... Added a tackle for a loss and broke up three passes against the Hilltoppers ... Collected a career-high 14 tackles against Troy ... Made one stop for a loss against the Trojans ... Forced one fumble and made a total of eight tackles at Middle Tennessee

2009: Was the leading tackler last season with 107 en route to being named to the honorable mention all-conference ... Had 67 unassisted tackles, three tackles for a loss, one forced fumble, and one interception ... Recorded double figure totals in tackles in four games last season ... Robertson had a season-high 13 tackles against Arkansas State ... Led the team in tackles with eight against WKU ... Along with his eight tackles, Robertson had one tackle for a loss against WKU ... Had 10 tackles against Troy and one pass broken up ... Recorded eight tackles against FAU ... Led the team in tackles against Louisiana-Lafayette with eight tackles ... Had his first full sack of the season against Louisiana-Lafayette ... Had nine tackles against Ohio and half a sack ... Also recorded a tackle for a loss against the Bobcats ... Named the Sun Belt Conference Week One Defensive Player of the Week ... Was the team's leading tackler in the 20-10 victory over Ball St. with 12 tackles ... Also recovered a fumble against the Cardinals.

2008: Was second on the team with 94 tackles ... Set a season best with 11 tackles in the season-opener at Kansas St. ... Had an interception against Western Kentucky and Middle Tennessee ... Was a Sun Belt Conference honorable mention ... Started all 12 games in 2008.

2007: Earned honorable mention honors on the Scout.com Freshman All-America team ... Was also an honorable mention all-conference selection ... Won the 2007 Byron Gross Award for the team's most outstanding linebacker ... Led North Texas with five interceptions on the season ... Recorded 38 tackles in seven games despite being inserted into the starting lineup mid-way through the season ... Tallied an interception in his first career start in win over ULM ... Helped force seven turnovers against the Sun Belt's top offensive team in Troy, including his two interceptions.

2006: Took a redshirt.

High School/Personal: A two-way athlete at Stafford High School, Robertson was named to the first-team defense and second team offense in District 25-3A as a senior ... As a junior, was named second team offense and defense ... Registered 101 tackles, four sacks and three forced fumbles in 2005 ... Earned 11 total letters in four sports, including first-team all-district nods in basketball, baseball and football ... Averaged nearly 22 points per game in basketball and batted .487 with 21 stolen bases for the Spartan baseball team ... Was named to the Academic Honor Roll and was a member of the Student Council ... Son of William and Beverly Robertson ... Born February 11, 1988.
