

INSIDE THE MATCHUP

- This will be North Texas' first trip to the state of Oregon. NT hasn't visited the west coast often in its history outside of a four-year stint in the Big West from 1996-2000, but four players on the team have some experience in the Pacific time zone. Alzee Williams, Chris Jones, Jordan Williams and Brandan Walton (Compton, Calif. native) were apart of the NT team that played in the Loyola Marymount Centennial Classic in Dec. of 2011. NT downed La Sierra (92-45), and Loyola Marymount (76-63), but fell to Columbia (72-57).
- That loss to Columbia is the only previous meeting between NT and the Lions. That day in Los Angeles, Columbia hit 12 three-pointers, while NT was 0-11 from deep just the second time in NT history it failed to hit a 3-pointer. Columbia's Meiko Lyles went 5-of-5 from deep and finished with a game-high 18 points, while Chris Jones led NT with 13.
- Columbia was tabbed to finish last of the eight teams in the Ivy League, although they have one of the league's best 3-point shooters. Steve Frankoski ranks this among all active Ivy League players in career 3-pointers.
- Idaho and North Texas were members of the Big West Conference from 1996-97 until the Mean Green left for the Sun Belt in 2000. The Vandals took all eight meetings against North Texas, which didn't win more than 10 games in any season during that span. The average margin of victory for Idaho over the eight game series is 84-72.
- The Vandals were ranked second in the WAC preseason media poll, and share a common opponent with the Mean Green. Oklahoma led Idaho by 27 with two minutes to play, and coasted to an 85-65 victory.
- This will be NT's first ever meeting with Portland. The Pilots were picked to finish ninth in the 10-team West Coast Conference in the pre-season coaches poll.



Turnaround Evident - Although it's early, Tony Benford and the Mean Green appear to have made a 180-degree turnaround from last year's injury plagued season.

Getting To The Line - The new handcheck rules play right into NT's game plan of driving the lane and getting to the free throw line. NT ranks 16th in the country with 24.0 free throws made per game, and leads C-USA with a free throw percentage of 74.2. Against Nicholls State, NT was 39-of-46 from the stripe, which are the fourth most makes in school history. NT led the nation in free throws made per game in both 2008-09 (20.3) and 2009-10 (20.1).

Fast Start - North Texas is off to a 2-1 start, which is only the eighth time since 1993-94 (21 seasons) that the Mean Green opened with that record.

Glass Cleaners - Tony Benford's emphasis on rebounding has translated to the floor for NT. North Texas ranks second in C-USA in overall rebounds (46.7) and defensive boards (31.7), and fourth in offensive rebounds (15.0).

Welcome To Conference USA! - After 13 seasons in the Sun Belt Conference, North Texas is making the jump to Conference USA. C-USA, which is based locally in Irving, features attractive television packages, elevated competition and a host of regional rivalries. C-USA features four schools within 350 miles of Denton, as well as three instate rivals in UTEP, Rice and UTSA. Tulsa, Louisiana Tech and Tulane round out NT's C-USA West Division foes.

New League, Same Results - North Texas has plenty of reasons to be confident about the move to Conference USA. Over the last 10 seasons, the Mean Green is 26-15 (63.4 percent) against its future C-USA rivals, including a perfect combined 6-0 mark against Rice, Tulsa and Charlotte.

Man On A Mission - Tony Mitchell was selected with the 37th overall pick (2nd Round,

7th Pick) by the Detroit Pistons, which made him the highest NBA Draft pick in North Texas history. Mitchell rewrote NT's shot-blocking records with 157 blocks in just 55 games (2.8 per game). A unanimous preseason All-American prior to the 2012-13 season, Mitchell averaged 13.7 points and 9.3 rebounds per game while shooting 49.0 percent from the floor for his career.

Banged Up - Only two teams in the country experienced more injuries in 2012-13 than North Texas. NT players combined to miss 82 collective games due to injury, which trailed only IUPUI and Utah State. NT lost Brandan Walton for the year just one minute into the season opener, and four additional players missed significant time with injuries. North Texas played with just seven scholarship players in multiple games last season.

19 More Years Of Hoops Experience - College graduates Vertrail Vaughns (George mason) and Kelvin Gaines (Cincinnati) aren't the only new veterans who will suite up for NT. When you add in senior Brandan Walton (missed 2012-13 to injury), T.J. Taylor (Marquette, Paris JC, Oklahoma), Armani Flannigan (Central Wyoming State), Maurice Aniefiok ('Ole Miss) and Collin Voss (Northern Oklahoma, Central Michigan) the Mean Green added 19 years of collegiate experience (including redshirt seasons) to its roster for 2013-14.

Nation's Top Assistant - Associate head coach Rob Evans was named the nation's top mid-major assistant coach in the April edition of Hoop Scoop magazine. Evans is a veteran of 205 victories and six postseason bids in 14 years as a head coach at Arizona State and Ole Miss, where he earned the SEC Coach of the Year and College Insider National Coach of the Year honors in 1997. A standout player at New Mexico State himself, Evans and head coach Tony Benford are actually cousins.

Hard Place To Play - These offseason facilities upgrades will only help enhance the game-day experience for North Texas fans at the Super Pit, a place that the Mean Green has been nearly unbeatable. NT is 84-24 (77.8 percent) at the Super Pit since 2006-07.

Winning Ways - The Mean Green has averaged 20 wins per year over the last seven seasons, including five straight 20-win seasons from 2007-11. NT won the 2007 and 2010 Sun Belt titles, and played in the NCAA Tournament in both of those seasons.
