	<p>+ The cost of a parking citation depends on the type of violation. They can range from \$25 to \$250 and can assess late fees if not paid on time.</p>	<p>+ Buy a permit online ahead of time. All you need is internet access, a printer, and you can purchase before classes start.</p> <p>+ After ordering your permit online, print your receipt which you will use as your temporary permit. Display the receipt on the dashboard of your car until you receive your permit in the mail.</p> <p>+ Look for the parking signs and be sure you are in the correct lot</p> <p>+ Contact the Parking &amp; Transportation office if you have any questions</p>	<p>+ All visitor parking is in Lot 20 (Fouts Parking) where a permit is required or in the Highland Street or Union Circle Garages.</p>	<p>+ Yes. If you park in an "A" Reserved space (marked green), your vehicle may be impounded. If you have three or more citations your vehicle may also be impounded. <i>Impounds will not be released until payment is made in full.</i> Please pay your citations in a timely manner and avoid parking in reserved parking lots. It is always a good idea to study the parking map before parking on campus.</p>
