MEAN GREEN TRAVEL TO AUSTIN TO BEGIN THE 2014 SEASON

→ North Texas opens the 2014 season on the road at No. 24 Texas. The Mean Green is coming off a 9-4 season, capped by winning the Heart of Dallas Bowl. NT was picked as the preseason favorite to win the West Division of Conference USA in 2014. Texas begins a new era as Charlie Strong enters his first season as the head coach of the Longhorns.

Live Stats:

- → Head coach Dan McCarney has won 18 games at North Texas, which already ranks in the top-10 all-time, tied for ninth in coaching wins. McCarney reached 18 wins faster at North Texas than any coach since Rod Rust in 1967-69. McCarney joins Odus Mitchell as the only coaches at North Texas to record a season of at least nine-wins in their first three years. Mitchell won a school-record 10-games in 1947, his second year.
- → North Texas had the second biggest turnaround in school history from one season to the next in 2013, and the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The 2013 team was just the third in school history to win five or more games from the previous year. The nine wins were tied for the second most in school history.
- → North Texas is 38-57-3 all-time in the season debut. The Mean Green has won just three season-openers in the last 17 years, but knocked off Idaho 40-6 in 2013. NT is starting the year on the road for the 12th time in the last 13 seasons.
- → The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).
- → Turnover margin is an area of immense improvement for North Texas under Dan McCarney. In his first three years, North Texas is a +21. From 2006-2010, the Mean Green was a combined -60 in turnover margin.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **0** North Texas has never beaten the Texas Longhorns. In seven of the nine games played, all of which have been played in Austin, Texas has been ranked in the top-25. In five of the nine games, the Mean Green has faced the Longhorns while they were ranked in the top-10, including three straight.
- 1 Texas enters the game ranked No. 24 in the nation in the coaches preseason poll. The Mean Green has beaten one top-25 team in school history, when it knocked off San Diego State, then ranked No. 20, on Nov. 2, 1974, 14-9 at Fouts Field.
- **16** The Mean Green forced at least one turnover in every game in 2013, the first such season since 1996, and has produced at least one turnover in 16-straight games. Since returning to FBS football in 1995, North Texas' longest streak of games forcing at least one turnover is 20, from 1995 to 1997.
- **28** Dan McCarney and Charlie Strong were assistant coaches at Florida together for 28 games in 2008 and 2009. The pair were part of the Gators 2008 National Championship team, and during their two-year stint together on the defensive staff, Florida had a record of 26-2, winning the national title in 2008 and Sugar Bowl in 2009.
- **62.9** North Texas was No. 2 in the country last season in red-zone defense, allowing its opponents to score only 62.9 percent of the time. The Mean Green defense allowed the second fewest red-zone scores in the nation last season, behind only Alabama. Texas in 2013 had the nation's 23rd best red-zone scoring offense.
- **1.000** Entering the 2014 season, North Texas is going for a 1-0 start for the second-straight season, which would be the first time since 1991 and '92 the Mean Green has had consecutive years of beginning the season with a win. Texas has started the season out at 1-0 for 14-straight seasons. The last 0-1 beginning to a year for the Longhorns was 1999, Mack Brown's second season.

One Away From A Century

North Texas will begin its 99th season of football when it kicks off the 2014 season at Texas. Since the inaugural season in 1913, North Texas has accumulated a record of 488-470-33, amassed 25 conference championships and played in eight bowl games, capturing three bowl championships, including the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl.

Key Offensive Numbers

North Texas shattered the school record for total offense in a single season with 5,336 yards. It is the only time in 100 years of playing football that the Mean Green has surpassed the 5,000-yard mark in total offense on the year. North Texas set a school record for 3rd-down conversions in 2013, converting 46 percent. The Mean Green offensive line, for the second straight season, ranked in the top 10 in the nation for fewest sacks allowed. NT allowed only 11 sacks in 2013, which ranked seventh in the nation. Since 2012, the North Texas offensive line has allowed the fewest sacks in the nation with just 17.

Inexperience Protected By Experience

The Mean Green offensive is one of the most experienced units in the nation, with a combined 122 starts, which is the thirdmost in the country. Cyril Lemon and Mason Y'Barbo have started 37-straight games since their freshman year, while Antonio Johnson has 34 career starts. Kaydon Kirby started all 12 games as a freshman last season and Shawn McKinney made two starts in 2013. Meanwhile, they will be charged with protecting a QB corp that has a total of one career start among the four. That is the 12th fewest career starts in the nation heading into the season.

Awards Candidates

North Texas offensive lineman Cyril Lemon and Mason Y'Barbo have been named to the Rotary Lombardi Award Watch list. It is the second watch list of the preseason to which Lemon has been named, as he was named to the Outland Trophy Award Watch List. For Y'Barbo it is the first time he has been named to any preseason watch list. Y'Barbo has also started 37 straight games and was a second-team all-C-USA pick.

More Squeeze From The Lemon

Lemon enters the 2014 season as one of the most decorated linemen in the nation, having been named to the Outland Trophy and Lombardi Award Watch List. In addition, Lemon was named a fourth-team All-America by Phil Steele's magazine and a first-team all-C-USA preseason selection in *Phil Steele's*, *Athlon* and *Texas Football* magazines.

What's Back

The Mean Green returns only nine starters from the 2013 team, which is the second fewest in the nation. On offense, NT has only four starters returning, all offensive lineman. Entering the 2014 season, North Texas has to replace its leading passer, rusher, receiver, tackler, kick returner and punt returner. On offense, NT has two of the top three rushers returning and two of its top-five receivers.

Second Half, Second Quarter Team

In 2013, North Texas was one of the best second-half teams in the nation, outscoring its opponents 199-85. It was the first time since 2003 that North Texas had outscored its opponents in the second half. Additionally, it was the biggest margin of outscoring its opponents in the second half since 1959. Of the Mean Green's 414 points scored in 2013, 136 of those came in the second quarter. That is the most points scored in a quarter by North Texas since returning to FBS football in 1995 and the most in a quarter since 1994.

Protecting The House

Dan McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas went 5-1 at home in 201,3, tying for the second most wins in school history. In three seasons, North Texas is 12-5 at Apogee Stadium under McCarney, while the previous three seasons the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

Matching A Mentor

Dan McCarney can be the first coach at NT since Jerry Moore to be over .500 for his Mean Green career with more than one season in FBS. Moore was 11-10 in 1980 before losing his final game. Hayden Fry is the last North Texas coach that had been coaching for four seasons and been over .500. McCarney has a chance to catch his former mentor this season. His record stands at 18-19 at NT.

Rushing To The Record Books

North Texas rushed for over 300 yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a single season since 1959. NT had 2,208 rushing yards for the season, which is the 13th most rushing yards in a single season in school history. Since 2011, the Mean Green offense has three of the top-10 rushing games in school history. In addition the Mean Green rushed for 31 touchdowns in 2013, the second most in school history and the most since 1951.

Piling Up The Points

The Mean Green offense scored a total of 414 points in 2013, the second most in school history and the most since 1951. North Texas averaged 31.8 points a game, topping the 30-point mark for only the third time in school history. The North Texas offense scored over 30 points in seven games, the most since returning to FBS football in 1995, and it marked only the fifth time in school history the Mean Green has had a season of scoring 30 points or more in seven games.

Better Than Big Five

The North Texas defense held eight opponents to 16 points or less for only the third time in the last 30 seasons. The defense allowed only 17.8 points a game, which is the lowest average since 2002 and the second lowest scoring average since 1984. The 17.8 points a game ranked eighth in the nation and best in Conference USA. North Texas was one of three non-power five schools to rank in the top 10 in fewest points allowed in 2013. The Mean Green allowed fewer points per game than 13 of 14 SEC teams, 10 of 12 Big 10 schools, 12 of the 14 ACC teams, all 12 of the PAC-12 teams and all 10 of the Big 12 teams in 2013.

Sack Attack Is Back

North Texas tied for the second most sacks in school history with 39 and the most in a single season since 2002. In the Dan Mc-Carney era, the Mean Green has 85 sacks in three seasons. In the previous six seasons from 2005-10, NT had only 91 sacks. However, entering the 2014 season, the Mean Green has to replace all four starters on the defensive line, who recorded 25 of the 39 sacks.

New Faces In Alot Of Places

The Mean Green defense has some big holes to fill entering the 2013 season. Gone are the top-two tacklers in Zach Orr and Marcus Trice, but five of the top-10 tacklers return. The NT defensive line has to find a new starting front four and potentially opens the year with just eight career starts or less among the four lineman. Linebacker Derek Akunne returns after his second-straight 90-tackle season. Akunne has 200 career tackles. The rest of the linebacking unit will be filled with players making their first career starts. The secondary returns the most experience, with a combined 57 starts. Cornerback Kenny Buyers and safety Lairamie Lee earned all-C-USA honors in 2013.

Special Again

In his first season coaching special teams, Tommy Perry led perhaps the biggest turnaround in the nation with the Mean Green in 2013. The Mean Green led the nation with eight blocked kicks while allowing only one blocked kick. From 2008-2012, NT had a total of 142 punt-return yards. Last season under Perry, NT had a school record 457 punt return yards. North Texas did not allow a special teams touchdown in 2013 for the first time since 2006.

Twin City

North Texas has a rare combination this year when it comes to sibling rivalries. The Mean Green has two sets of twins on the roster, and cornerbacks coach LaMarcus Hicks is the father of two sets of twin boys. Vershad and Rashad Jackson along with Terrance and Tillman Johnson make up the twins on the roster. Coach Hicks has four sons to take care of at home, with them each being twins.

Welcome Aboard

Not only does the Mean Green defense have to replace seven defensive starters, NT lost three defensive coaches in the offseason leaving defensive coordinator John Skladany as the only returning coach. The Mean Green hired Perry Carter, LaMarcus Hicks and Kevin Patrick this off-season. Carter, who, coaches safeties, comes to the Mean Green after spending eight seasons in the NFL with the Houston Texans. Hicks coaches the cornerbacks and was a former player under coach McCarney at Iowa State. He was a first-team All-Big 12 selection in 2005. Patrick is in charge of the defensive line after spending the last six years at South Florida.

Wallace Ready To Roll

Transfer Anthony Wallace is eligible this season and looks to make the same impact that other FBS transfers have made at NT. Wallace, a Dallas native who transferred from Oregon in 2012, had to sit out last season, but has been battling Fred Scott for playing time. Coming out of high school, Wallace was ranked as the sixth best linebacker in the nation by *Rivals.com* and *Scout.com*.

Welcome Home

For the first time in school history, North Texas will play three-straight home games in the month of September. In addition, the Mean Green does not have a road game in the month of September for the first time since 1966. Prior to 1975, college football teams rarely played more than three games in September, and prior to 1969 it was common for teams to play only two games in September.

Punting Insider

Blake Macek in his first season as the punter did more than just exceed expectations. He registered a freshman school-record 41.1 yards a kick and was named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Forty percent of his punts were downed inside the 20-yard line, which ranked 15th in the nation last season.



Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of a historic turnaround at Iowa State, and now you can add North Texas to that list. McCarney has turned around North Texas in three seasons and taken the program to heights that were unthinkable when he arrived in 2011.

On their way to the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl Championship, the Mean Green won nine games in 2013, tied for the second most in school history and just the sixth time in 100 years North Texas has won nine games. The season culminated with North Texas winning the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl 36-14 over UNLV on January 1.

McCarney led the Mean Green to a 6-2 record in the inaugural season in Conference USA, tying for second place and the second most conference wins in school history. Along the way, the Mean Green broke offensive, defensive, special teams and attendance records.

The Mean Green achieved the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The North Texas offense set a new school record for total offense in a single season, topping the 5,000-yard mark for the first time. North Texas rushed for over 300-yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a season since 1959.

The North Texas defense allowed the fewest points per game since 2002, and tied for the second most sacks in school history. McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the second most wins in school history. In three seasons at home, North Texas is 12-5 at Apogee Stadium under McCarney, while the previous three seasons the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

McCarney has won 18 games at North Texas, which already ranks in the top-10 all-time, tied

for ninth in coaching wins. McCarney reached 18 wins faster at North Texas than any coach since Rod Rust in 1967-69.

He has brought out the best individually at North Texas as the Mean Green had 12 players earn 14 spots on the C-USA all-conference team in 2013, the second most in school history. Brelan Chancellor became just the second player in league history to earn first-team all-conference honors as a kick and punt returner, and was the only player in the nation to rank in the top 10 in punt and kick returns in 2013.

The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008. He helped win a national championship at Florida.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. In his 11 years with Fry at Iowa, their teams went to eight bowl games after not having a winning season the previous 19 years. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival. McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North cochampionship. In 119 years of football at Iowa State, only 17 teams have won seven or more games in a season and McCarney coached five of those.

After leaving Iowa State, McCarney spent one season as the assistant head coach at the University of South Florida, where his defensive line ranked third in the nation in tackles for loss. From 2008-10 at the University of Florida, McCarney helped guide the team to two Southeastern Conference Championship games and three bowl appearances.

In all, McCarney has coached in 21 bowl games in 36 years as a collegiate coach, five of which are current BCS bowls. He has coached 22 players that have been drafted by the NFL, including nine that have gone in the first three rounds.
