NT GOES BETWEEN THE HEDGES WITH BEST RECORD SINCE 1994

→ North Texas has is best start to a season since 1994 with a 2-1 record. The Mean Green came from behind to knock off Ball State 34-27 and now faces its biggest test of the season at No. 9/10 Georgia. The Bulldogs had the week off after a 41-30 win at home against South Carolina. The game with No. 9/10 Georgia this week will be the 13th time in 14 years that North Texas has faced a team ranked in the top 10. Since 2000, the Mean Green has faced a top 10 opponent every year except 2010.

- → Dan McCarney is the fastest coach to win 11 games at North Texas since Corky Nelson in 1984. McCarney has also guided North Texas to a perfect 2-0 start at home for the first time since the 2003 season.
- → North Texas has forced the most turnovers in the nation with 11 through three games. The seven forced fumbles also lead the nation. In the Dan McCarney era the Mean Green is now a +15 in turnover margin.
- → North Texas ranks second in the nation in red zone defense, allowing opponents to score just 50 percent of the time inside the Mean Green 20-yard line. The three North Texas opponents have eight trips inside the 20 and have scored three touchdowns and one field goal.
- → North Texas came from 18 points down to beat Ball State last week, trailing 27-9 in the second quarter before outscoring the Cardinals 25-0 in the last 33 minutes of the game. The last time a North Texas team came from 18 points down to win a game was against Texas Tech in 1988 when it trailed 21-3 before coming back to win 29-24.
- → A win over Georgia would give North Texas its best start to a season at 3-1 since 1989. North Texas has just one win over a ranked team in school history in 45 tries. The lone win came in 1974 over No. 20 San Diego State.
- → The Mean Green offense through three games has piled up 1,395 yards of total offense, which is the most through the first three games of the season since 1951. In two of the three games the Mean Green has topped 500-yards of total offense, which is the first time since 1983 that North Texas has had 500-yards of total offense in two of the first three games.
- → Derek Thompson, who was named the C-USA Player of the Week, tied his career-high with 31 completions and 47 attempts against Ball State. He set a new career-high with a 26-yard TD run and climbed to fifth all-time in school history with 5,369 passing yards. Brelan Chancellor had a career-high nine grabs against Ball State, likewise for freshman Darvin Kidsy who had four catches. Chancellor crossed the 4,000 all-purpose yard mark in the win, becoming just the third player in school history with over 4,000 all-purpose yards in their career.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **0** The North Texas defense hasn't allowed a point at home in the second half in three straight games dating back to the end of the 2012 season. In 2013, the Mean Green defense hasn't allowed a touchdown and has only surrendered six second half points in three games. North Texas is outscoring its opponents through three games in the second half 46-6.
- **24** North Texas has won 24 conference championships to rank 12th among all FBS teams in the nation.
- **30** North Texas topped the 30-point mark against Ball State and that has been the magic number in Dan McCarney era. The Mean Green is a perfect 8-0 when scoring 30 points or more under McCarney.
- **47** North Texas is converting on 47 percent of its 3rd downs this season, good for 45th in the nation. Georgia has converted just 36 percent on 3rd down, 86th in the nation. Last season the Mean Green converted only 33 percent on 3rd down.
- **65** Three different players rushed for over 65 yards in the win over Ball State for North Texas. Its the first time the Mean Green has had three players rush for over 65 yards in a game since September 25, 2010 against Florida Atlantic.
- **92** North Texas ran 92 plays in the win over Ball State, which is only seven shy of the school record and the most plays run in a game since 2008.
- **95** North Texas has scored 95 points through the first three games, which is the most after three games since the 1988 season. That year the Mean Green scoring 102 points in the first three games of the year on their way to an 8-4 season.
- **16,119** Aaron Murray is third in passing yards among all active quarterbacks in the NCAA and second among FBS players. Derek Thompson has 5,396 passing yards, which is just 100-yards shy of Chuckie Keaton of Utah State for 25th among active quarterbacks in FBS. The two QB's have combined to throw for 16,119 yards.

Point Explosion - The 95 points for North Texas in the first three games this season is the most to begin a season since 1988 when the Mean Green scored 102 in the first three games. The 60 points allowed in the first three games is the fewest points given up by a North Texas team since it allowed 60 in the first three games of the 2002 season.

Protecting the QB – North Texas led the nation last season by allowing the fewest quarterback sacks in FBS with six. Through three games this year, North Texas has allowed just two to rank fifth nationally among FBS teams. Both sacks this year came against Ohio on scramble attempts by Mean Green quarterback Derek Thompson. The only team in FBS that has allowed less sacks with at least 100 pass attempts is Fresno State which has allowed just one, but has only played two games.

Receiving Depth – North Texas set a school record by having 12 different players catch passes in the season-opening win over Idaho. In three games, 14 different Mean Green players have caught at least one pass. For the entire season last year, North Texas had 15 different players catch a pass. Senior Brelan Chancellor has the most experience with 79 career receptions and 10 career touchdowns.

Stability at Quarterback- Senior Derek Thompson is in his third year as the starting quarterback, breaking a 16-year trend of a revolving door at that position. This is the first time North Texas has had a three-year starter since Jason Mills was the starting QB from 1995-97. Thompson moved into fifth place on the career passing yards list in the win over Ball State last week. He is fifth in career pass completions at North Texas and only one touchdown pass away from being in the top five in career touchdown passes. His five career 300-yard passing games is second only to Steve Ramsey, who had six from 1966-69. Thompson currently ranks 19th in FBS in passing yards and 17th in pass completions. Additionally Thompson is working on his master's degree after graduating early from North Texas last season.

Brelan's Breakout –Senior wide receiver Brelan Chancellor is having a breakout season. He led the team in receiving in both wins and has a team-high 256 receiving yards and two touchdowns. He tied a career-high with six catches in the season opening win against Idaho and set a new career-high with nine catches in the win over Ball State. He is also having a great year as a returner, ranking second in the nation as a punt returner (27.8) and 27th as a kick returner (26.2). Of the 25 explosive plays for North Texas this season (20 yards or more) Chancellor has had 11 of them.

Passing the Test – North Texas is 2-0 this season when attempting 30 or more passes in a game and 0-1 when attempting less than 30 passes. Last season the Mean Green was 1-3 in games that it attempted 30 or more passes. Quarterback Derek Thompson has been the difference. In both games this year that he attempted 30 or more passes he has no interceptions, in the game that he attempted less than 30 passes, he had two interceptions.

Three-Headed Monster – North Texas has perhaps more depth at running back than ever in its history. Senior Brandin Byrd, sophomore Antoinne Jimmerson and Junior Reggie Pegram will all carry the load when it comes to the Mean Green ground game this season. Byrd is the starter and has the most experience with 294 carries and 1,290 vards in his career. Jimmerson led the team in rushing touchdowns last season with five and has 132 carries for 615 yards in two years. Pegram is a transfer from Purdue has 33 carries for 135 yards in three games. Last season was the first time in the last 60 years of North Texas football that the Mean Green had three backs rush for over 500 yards in the same season.

Depend On The Rev - Junior right guard Cyril Lemon is the only player in the nation to start 24 straight games as a freshman and sophomore and earn back-to-back all-conference honors. Known as The Reverend, Lemon has not missed a single snap since arriving on campus in 2011. Lemon's 27 career starts is tied with his line-mate Mason Y'Barbo for the most on the team – one ahead of offensive tackle Antonio Johnson who has 26.

Protecting Apogee - Since the opening of Apogee Stadium in 2011 and the start of the Dan McCarney era, North Texas has a home record of 9-4. In the previous six seasons dating back to 2005, the Mean Green had won only five home games in six years.

Record Books Beware - Senior QB Derek Thompson is establishing his place among North Texas career passing leaders. Thompson is in the top seven of every major passing category in North Texas history.

Halftime Adjustments - The Mean Green has not allowed a touchdown in the second half this season. North Texas has outscored its opponents 46-6 after halftime, with the only points allowed being two field goals at Ohio. The Mean Green only held one opponent without a second-half touchdown in all 12 games last year (South Alabamba).

Picked Apart – The North Texas defense intercepted Ball State's award-candidate quarterback Keith Wenning twice last week. Wenning, who is on the preseason watch list for the Davey O'Brien, Maxwell and Unitas Awards, entered the game having thrown 72 passes with five touchdowns and no interceptions. Wenning was picked off by junior safety Larime Lee and senior linebacker Will Wright.

Playing from Behind – North Texas has won the coin toss every game this season and has deferred possession until the second half. Unfortunately, all three opponents have scored a touchdown on the opening drive of the game. The Mean Green offense has trailed 7-0 before it has taken its first snap in each game. After the three combined touchdowns on the three opening drives, the Mean Green defense has only allowed a total of three touchdowns on 38 opponent offensive possessions after the opening drive.

Stopping Quick Scoring Drives – Of the six touchdown drives allowed by the Mean Green defense this season, three have come in four plays or less. North Texas allowed Idaho to score on four plays on the opening drive of the game then allowed Ohio to score on its first play of the game. Ball State had three touchdown drives against North Texas, one of which was four plays, covering 91 yards.

Made To Orr-der – Senior team captain Zach Orr recorded a career-high 108 tackles last season and has picked up where he left off to begin 2013. Orr was named Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week for his 11-tackle performance in the win over Idaho, and backed that performance up with 10 tackles at Ohio and 11 against Ball State. Zach, who is the son of former Washington Redskin great Terry Orr, is a two-time all-conference player and should finish in the top five on the all-time tacklers list at North Texas. Orr is one of only two players in C-USA to be named to the Lombardi Award list this year.

Trice Leading Secondary - Senior safety Marcus Trice is having his best season with the Mean Green. The Oklahoma transfer had a career-high 14 tackles and had an interception that was nearly a pick-six in the loss to Ohio and came back with nine tackles and a fumble recovery in the win over Ball State. Trice is second on the team with 28 tackles in three games.

Finally Familiarity - After having three defensive coordinators in three years, the Mean Green has found some stability and experience in the defense. John Skladany is entering his second season as defensive coordinator and North Texas has returned its top-six tacklers from last season. It is the first time since 2003 that a Mean Green defense brings back its top-six tacklers from the previous year. The 2003 team, led by the defense, won the third most games in school history by going 9-4.

Not So Young Anymore - Last season the starting lineup in the secondary for North Texas entered the year with zero starts at the FBS level. This year the secondary has 49 games worth of starting experience. As a whole, the North Texas defense returns eight starters who have made 119 career starts. Entering 2012, that figure was just 49 and 39 of those came from defensive linemen.

Transfer Impact - Four FBS transfers are eligible this season for North Texas. Brock Berglund (Kansas), Darius Terrell (Texas), and Reggie Pegram (Purdue) sat out last season after transferring to North Texas. Zed Evans is a graduate of the University of Louisville and has two years of eligibility with North Texas. Additionally safety Peter Ashton arrived in Denton this fall from Oregon State and Anthony Wallace joined the team after transferring from Oregon. Both Ashton and Wallace must sit out this season but will be eligible in 2014.

Worst to First – Senior wide receiver/punt returner Brelan Chancellor had more yards on his first punt return of the 2013 season than the entire team did in 12 games last year. Chancellor took his first return back 48 vards in the win over Idaho and had 111 vards on three returns for the game. His 167 punt return yards in three games ranks second in the nation and is more than the teams total in the last three years combined. As a team in 2012. North Texas had a total of eight punt returns for 17 yards which was the lowest output in school history. North Texas has not returned a punt for a TD since 2007, which covers a span of 45 games. The last three punt returns for TD's have come off of blocked punts. The last true punt return for a TD for the Mean Green came in 2004 when Johnny Quinn brought back a punt 85 yards for a TD against ULM, 101 games ago. NT Punt Returns Since 2009

Two years into his rebuilding project, North Texas head football coach Dan McCarney is beginning to see familiar signs of a program on the mend. He saw it at Iowa when he coached for Hall of Fame head coach Hayden Fry, where they took a team from the bottom of the Big 10 to a conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance.

He saw it at Wisconsin, where McCarney went with Barry Alvarez, taking a downtrodden program and turning it into a Big 10 champion and Rose Bowl winner. And he saw it up close at Iowa State where he took a team that was winless the year before his arrival and turned it into program that went to five bowl games in his last seven years.

According to McCarney, the signs of a turnaround are beginning to emerge at North Texas. He sees a team that invites discipline and accountability. He sees a team that doesn't hold a sense of entitlement. He sees a team that understands that academic success can translate to success on the field. He sees a team that has mastered the intangibles of success: effort, toughness and the ability to communicate. Lastly he sees a team taking ownership in the turnaround, understanding that they will be the ones that initiate the change in culture.

He has also won some games along the way. None of the previous four North Texas coaches won more games in their first two years than McCarney. McCarney's seven wins at Apogee Stadium in his first two years is the best start by a North Texas coach at home since Rod Rust won eight home games in 1967 and 1968.

He defeated a Big 10 Conference opponent for the first time in school history. He defeated

a team that won nine games and a New Orleans Bowl championship in Louisiana-Lafayette. He gave the No. 5 team in the nation and Big 12 Conference champion Kansas State one of its toughest games of the year. The academic improvement under McCarney is perhaps more impressive than what has happened on the field. The football team GPA for the fall of 2012 was the highest it has ever been since the measurement began being recorded in the mid-1990s. McCarney had more than half his team make the honor roll last fall, with 45 players earning a 3.0 or higher.



With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney, 59, is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history.

In his 11 years with Fry at Iowa, their teams went to eight bowl games after not having a winning season the previous 19 years. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival.

The year before McCarney became head coach at Iowa State, the Cyclones suffered through an 0-10-1 record. His rebuilding process at Iowa State took five years, but, in his sixth season, he became the first head coach in the previous 94 years at Iowa State to win nine games in a season and gave the Cyclones their first-ever bowl victory and first bowl appearance in 23 years.McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North co-championship. In 119 years of football at Iowa State, only 17 teams have won seven or more games in a season and McCarney coached five of those.

McCarney is a 1975 graduate of the University of Iowa where he was a three-year letterman on the offensive line and a team captain in 1974. He is married to his wife Margy and has three children, Jillian, Melanie and Shane.
