

Students must take the THEA test, maintain a 2.75 GPA, and be admitted to Teacher Education before enrolling in education courses. Degree plans/audits should be updated with all music proficiency exams completed the semester before student teaching. All music education and education courses must be passed with a minimum grade of “C”. TEXES test in All-Level Music and All-Level Professional Development are taken during the student teaching semester.

** All non-keyboard majors must enroll in secondary piano each long semester until proficiency is passed. If more than 2 hours of class piano are needed the other hours will subtract from free electives.
