SENIOR DAY FOR EIGHT SENIORS

The North Texas swimming and diving team returns home for its final home meet of the season, hosting TCU for its Senior Day meet on Friday afternoon. It's just their second regular-season home meet of the season, having split a dual meet against Incarnate Word and Liberty earlier this season. North Texas will also be honoring its eight seniors during the second diving break. This year's group of seniors includes Jasmine Abercrombie, Michelle Balcaen, Bianca Bocs, Gaby Colunga, Haley Goertz, Zoe James, Sarah Manning and Ashley Payne.

NORTH TEXAS EARNS SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICA HONORS

The College Swimming Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) announced that North Texas was one of 547 teams to be selected as a Scholar All-America Team for the fall semester, an honor that the program has received each year since 2005. To be selected as a CSCAA Scholar All-America Team, programs must have achieved a grade point average of 3.00 or higher over the fall semester. The North Texas women combined to record a 3.55 team grade point average, tied for 15th nationally among Division I programs that earned Scholar All-America honors, first among schools in the state of Texas and second among Conference USA schools.

VAISSE NAMED C-USA CO-SWIMMER OF THE WEEK

With three-place finishes and a third-place finish in the triple-dual meet victory over Arkansas-Little Rock, Southern Illinois and Ouachita Baptist, sophomore Sarah Vaisse was selected as Conference USA Co-Swimmer of the Week, her first career C-USA weekly award. She won first place in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:04.41) and 200-yard individual medley (2:07.39) and also swam the second leg of a first-place finish in the 200-yard medley relay (1:45.42), the second-fastest time by a North Texas relay team in the event this season.

NORTH TEXAS DOWNS USD IN SAN DIEGO SHOOTOUT

The North Texas swimming and diving team repeated as champions of the San Diego Shootout, defeating host San Diego by a score of 62-48 in a dual and shootout format. The Mean Green won five of the eight events, including three of the four 50-meter sprint events. Individual winners included sophomore Isabelle Morris (200 freestyle), freshman Rebekah Bradley (50 backstroke), sophomore Sarah Vaisse (50 breaststroke) and freshman Brittany Thurstin (50 freestyle).

SWIMMERS, DIVERS COMPETE IN LONE STAR STATE INVITES

The North Texas swimmers and divers competed at the Phill Hansel Invitational in Houston and the University of Texas Diving Invitational in Austin. After 18 events over three days, North Texas finished in seventh place of 10 teams in Houston. Sophomore Claudia Kitching won first place in the 200-yard breaststroke, posting two NCAA B time standards. She was one of five swimmers to qualify for an A final, along with senior Bianca Bocsa, sophomore Caroline Culpepper, sophomore Isabelle Morris and sophomore Sarah Vaisse.

ABERCROMBIE EARNS SECOND CONSECUTIVE C-USA HONOR

For the second time in her career, senior Jasmine Abercrombie earned Conference USA Diver of the Week honors for her performance against Incarnate Word and Liberty. She picked up right where she left off last season, winning the last week's (Feb. 10, 2015) diver award and first week's (Oct. 13, 2015) diver award in consecutive seasons. The only diver to finish in the top three of both diving competitions, Abercrombie picked up a win over Liberty in the one-meter competition (230.25), placing second overall among divers from all three teams. Abercrombie also finished second-place overall to teammate Samantha Scheck in the three-meter competition (244.13).

AMONG THE LEAGUE'S BEST

Through nine meets, North Texas boasts a strong presence among the best in Conference USA. A trio of sophomores Sarah Vaisse (100-yard breaststroke), Claudia Kitching (200-yard breaststroke) and Caroline Culpepper (200-yard butterfly) each hold the fastest time in their respective events in the league this season. Kitching has posted two NCAA B time standards in the 200-yard breaststroke, which are two of the three fastest times in the event this season. On the boards, junior Samantha Scheck is the league's sixth-best performer on the 3-meter (246.75) and the eighth-best performer on the 1-meter (233.03).

WINNING TIME

The six dual meet wins is the most under head coach Brendon Bray and tied for the third-most in school history. North Texas also doubled its event wins on the season with 37 wins over its three dual meets against Southern Illinois, Little Rock and Ouachita Baptist. Through nine meets this season, North Texas has 62 individual wins and 12 relay wins. The 62 individual wins and 12 relay wins includes 36 overall first-place finishes.

Third Year ▶ Washington '05

Brendon Bray enters his third season at North Texas, having led the Mean Green to consecutive fifth-place finishes at the Conference USA Championships. He guided the Mean Green to a 4-4 record in 2014-15, including a 3-1 start, the best start in the

program's 16-year history.

The team earned all-conference honors in the 400 medley relay and 400 IM. Seniors Krista Rossum and Mona Groteguth set three program records and notched NCAA B-qualifying times in five events. Rossum's program-best marks came in the 200 IM (2:00.35) and 400 IM (4:15.22) in consecutive days at the C-USA meet, while Groteguth claimed the 200 backstroke record (1:56.20) at Incarnate Word's Christmas Invitational.

In 2013-14, the team's first season in C-USA, Mean Green swimmers set four program records and achieve NCAA B-qualifying times in three events. Rossum originally broke the school record in the 400 individual medley at the Houston Invitational and then went on to break it again at the conference championships finishing with a 4:16.95 time. Groteguth set program records in the 100 backstroke (54.02) and 200 backstroke (1:56.62), accomplishing both feats at the Houston Invitational. On the boards, Catherine Johnson and Rebecca Taylor qualified and competed at their third straight NCAA Zone D diving championships.

Outside of the pool, the Mean Green have received the Spring Scholar All-America Team Award for having one of the top GPA's in the nation in Division I women's swimming and diving in each of the last two seasons. Rossum and Groteguth have also been named to the Conference USA All-Academic team in each of the last two seasons, with Rossum receiving the Conference USA Scholar Athlete of the Year Award in swimming and diving in each of the last two seasons.

Bray arrived at North Texas from San Diego State, he served as the associate head coach for the Aztecs while they achieved a peak dual meet ranking of No. 23 in the country by the CSCAA. After his promotion to associate head coach, SDSU compiled a 26-1 dual meet record and became an annual participant at the NCAA Championships. Bray helped coach all 13 individual NCAA championship participants including five honorable All-American performances, which represented both the first individual and relay points scored by SDSU at the NCAA Championships.

Before his tenure at SDSU, the program had finished last at the conference meet for five straight seasons, and in four seasons, helped the team to their first Mountain West Championship in 2011, and then repeated as league champions in 2013. In his six seasons at San Diego State, He coached three MWC Swimmers of the Year and helped the Aztecs break school records in every swimming and diving event in his six seasons.

Bray began his coaching career in the Pac-12 Conference at his alma mater, Washington. He served as an undergraduate assistant in 2004-05, before spending two more seasons as a men's and women's assistant coach from 2005-07. During his time at Washington, he coached several NCAA Championships participants and helped recruit the top-ranked recruit in the country, according to collegeswimming.com.

Bray also swam three years for Washington and one year at the University of Utah. Bray was a senior national qualifier and Pac-12 championship participant during his time at UW. Bray graduated with a bachelor's degree in economics from Washington in 2005, and earned his master's degree in intercollegiate athletic leadership through the department of education at Washington in 2007. Bray was born in San Francisco, California and has lived in Sacramento, California and Reno, Nevada.
