Ouick Hitters

- Prior to the loss to Creighton, NT had won a school-record 11-straight openers.
- Tony Mitchell (18 points vs. Creighton) is averaging 18.3 career PPG against teams that played in the 2012 postseason.
- Creighton's crowd of 17,139 was the third largest NT has ever played in front of, just shy of the record 17,181 that packed "The Pit" at New Mexico in 1990.
- North Texas hasn't started a season with an 0-2 record since 2000-01.

Welcome Aboard - Tony Benford, a collegiate coaching veteran of 21 years, took the reigns of the program for 2012-13. Benford spent the last three years at Marquette, including the 2011-12 season as Buzz Williams' Associate Head Coach. Aside from helping the Golden Eagles reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in each of the last two years, Benford has coached in 14 postseason appearances and has recruited and coached five NBA first-round draft picks.

First-Class Staff - Tony Benford brought a first-class coaching staff with him to NT. The staff, which collectively owns over 100 years of collegiate coaching experience, features Associate Head Coach Rob Evans, who has 205 head coaching wins and 14 postseason appearances at Arizona State and Ole' Miss. Bart Lundy, a veteran of 211 head coaching victories at High Point and Queens, came from Marquette to join Benford's staff as an assistant. David Anwar spent the last six seasons at Nebraska, and is a 12-year collegiate coaching veteran.

All-American - Tony Mitchell was named a Preseason All-American by several national publications, including ESPN, CBS Sports, Athlon, Basketball Times and Blue Ribbon Report. He was also named the Sun Belt's Preseason Player of the Year after bringing home Freshman of the Year and All-SBC Tourney honors in '11-12. At 14.7 points and 10.3 rebounds, Mitchell joined Kentucky's Anthony Davis as the only freshmen in the country to average a double-double.

Offense Catching Up - A team accustomed to high scoring, NT led the Sun Belt with 71.8 PPG in league play last year. But on Friday No. 16 Creighton limited NT to 51 points and 31.9 percent shooting - marks that NT hasn't been held to since a 47 point/30.0 percent outing against Arkansas State in 2010-11. NT started slow offensively last season, shooting under 40 percent in four of its first five games.

INSIDE THE TOURNAMENT

- This will be NT's first trip to the NIT Preseason Tip-Off, although NT will be quite familiar with its second-round opponent Lamar or Kansas State. Lamar, a former Southland Conference foe, owns a 17-11 all-time edge over NT, although the two teams haven't faced off since 2004-05 (NT 70-66). Kansas State ended NT's season in an 82-62 loss in an NCAA Tournament first round matchup in 2010 in Oklahoma City, Okla. The Wildcats are 5-1 against NT all-time.
- Monday will be NT's first ever meeting with Alabama-Huntsville. The Chargers are the No. 3 team in the NABC/Division II Coaches Poll, and are coming off back-to-back trips to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight. They been in the national poll for 30 straight weeks, which is the third longest streak in the country. The Chargers are picked to repeat as Gulf South Conference champs in 2012-13.
- Zane Campbell and Jaime Smith are getting tons of preseason buzz for Alabama-Huntsville. Campbell ranked 12th in the country in field goal percentage (60.7 percent) last season, and was an All-Gulf South and NABC All-District selection. Smith led all of Division II with a 48.6 three-point percentage, nailing 107-of-220 attempts from deep. He was named to the All-Region team as well as the Gulf South Honor Roll.
- Kansas State opened the Bruce Weber era on Friday with a win over North Dakota. The Wildcats are led by senior Rodney Mc-Gruder, who joined Tony Mitchell on the Top 50 candidate list for the John Wooden Award. The unanimous Preseason All-Big 12 selection is one of just three returning players to the league to have ranked in the top 20 in scoring and rebounding in 2011-12.
- Led by Pat Knight, Lamar is coming off a sensational 23-12 season that included a Southland Conference title and a trip to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2000. The Cardinals lost their top five scorers from that team, and were tabbed to finish fifth in their league.

Tough Schedule - Matchups against No. 16/15 Creighton, the NIT Season Tip-Off, St. Louis and Lehigh got the attention of USA Today, which ranked the NT schedule as the nation's fifth toughest overall, and the best by any mid-major this year.

Winning Ways - Benford & Co. are taking over a North Texas program that knows how to win. NT has averaged 21 wins per year over the last six seasons, including five straight 20-win seasons from 2007-11. NT won the 2007 and 2010 Sun Belt titles, and played in the NCAA Tournament in both of those seasons.

Third Straight Final - The Mean Green, which fell just two wins shy of its sixth consecutive 20-win season, advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament finals for a third straight year. That makes NT just the third program in Sun Belt history to advance to three straight SBC Tournament finals, and the first since Western Kentucky in 2001-03.

Block Party - Last year, Tony Mitchell set the program's single season blocks record at 70 blocks in just 23 games. He passes Shawnson Johnson, who tallied 69 blocks in 23 games in 2003-04. At 3.04 blocks per game overall, Mitchell's pace was just ahead of Johnson's 3.00 average for the best in NT history.

Killer Camps - Tony Mitchell was one of just 14 collegiate players invited to the prestigious Amar'e Stoudemire Skills Academy in June, and the 6-8 forward was measured with a 7-3 wingspan - the camp's largest. Mitchell's exploits at that camp earned him an invite to the Lebron James Skills Academy in July.

By The Numbers - North Texas returns its top seven scorers from 2011-12, including four double-digit scorers. In fact, the Mean Green will have 86.4 percent of its scoring back for this year. NT also brings back 72.7 percent of its rebounding, 82.3 percent of its blocks and 81.6 percent of its assists.

All-Tourney Team - Tony Mitchell and Jacob Holmen were named to the All-Sun Belt Tournament team. NT is the only program to have multiple players named to the all-tournament team in each of the last three seasons, and has placed a total of seven players in the last three years.

Bringing Them In - Last season NT averaged over 4,000 fans for just the third time in school history and for the first time since 1976-77. The Mean Green finished the year with an average of 4,006 fans per home

game after a season-high 6,921 fans attended the home finale. That average ranked third in the Sun Belt in 2011-12 behind only Denver (5,460) and Middle Tennessee (5,035).

Pit Prowess - The reason for the attendance spike has a lot to do with the fact that North Texas has been nearly unbeatable at home. NT is a Sun Belt best 75-17 (.815) at the Super Pit since the 2006-07 season.

Big Minutes - Alzee Williams played 1,013 minutes in 2011-12, which are the eighth most in school history. Williams joins Josh White (3) George Odufuwa (2), Tristan Thompson (1) and Ben Bell (1) as the only North Texas players since Tony Worrell in 1988 to play over 1,000 minutes in a single season. Williams led the Sun Belt with 35.6 minutes per league game after taking over the bulk of the point guard duties with 13 games remaining.

Can't Stop Holmen - Jacob Holmen simply finished the year on fire. After recording just one double-digit scoring game in the regular season, Holmen scored at least 10 points in all three Sun Belt Tournament game. In fact, Holmen's career-high 21 point burst in the semifinals helped NT advance to its third straight SBC final. He averaged a teamhigh-tying 14.0 points per game in the SBC Tournament, including a 6-of-9 mark from 3-point, and snagged an All-Tournament team nod.

Forward Thinking - Roger Franklin had a tough assignment to transition from a veteran guard role into a post presence, but the Oklahoma State transfer excelled in 2011-12. Franklin ranked sixth in the Sun Belt with four double-doubles on the year, and finished with averages of 8.2 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. His 15-rebound performance at ULM ranked as the Sun Belt's fifth best outing last year.

Recruiting Class - Joining NT on the court this year is a local hoops hero and a pair of high-major signees. Clarke Overlander, a two-time district MVP at nearby Argyle High School, led the Eagles to their first state championship, and even took home state tournament MVP honors. Big man Keith Coleman was named by Hot100Hoops.com as one of the nation's top-25 junior college players, and originally signed with Nebraska before playing a season at Marshalltown CC (Iowa). Point guard P.J. Hardwick, who originally signed with Mississippi State, was Benford's first signee. He averaged 15 points and 10 assists per game as a senior at Houston's Christian Life Academy.

One of the nation's most respected assistant coaches, Tony Benford, has taken the reigns of the North Texas men's basketball program.

A veteran of 20 years in Division I basketball and 14 postseason appearances, Benford served as the associate head coach under Buzz Williams at Marquette last season; his fourth year with the Golden Eagles. During his time at Marquette, Benford helped recruit and coach six All-Big East players, including 2012 Big East Player of the Year Jae Crowder.

Tabbed by Basketball Times, Fox Sports and Hoop Scoop as one of the country's top assistant coaches, Benford also spent time at Nebraska (2006-08), Arizona State (1998-06) and New Mexico (1992-98) developing some of the nation's most talented players.

"I couldn't be more excited about the opportunity of taking over the basketball program at North Texas," Benford said. "I would like to thank Rick Villarreal and President V. Lane Rawlins for this opportunity, and Johnny Jones for doing such a great job in making North Texas a winner. My philosophy is all about the players, and we will do everything in ensure that our players grow in the classroom, the community and on the court."

In his career Benford recruited and coached five NBA first-round draft picks: Garland, Texas; Ike Diogu (Arizona St., '05), Charles Smith (New Mexico, '97), Kenny Thomas (New Mexico, '99), Lazar Hayward (Marquette, '10) and Jimmy Butler (Marquette, '11), as well as three second-round picks in Eddie House (Arizona St., '00), Tommy Smith (Arizona St., '03) and Jeff Pendergraph (Arizona St., '09).

A native of Hobbs, N.M., Benford played collegiately at Texas Tech and was the catalyst for the Red Raiders Southwest Conference regular-season and tournament titles in 1985, and their 1986 SWC Tournament championship. He earned All-Southwest Conference and SWC Tournament MVP honors as a senior. The Boston Celtics selected Benford in the fourth round of the 1986 NBA Draft, and he played professionally in Holland for the 1986-87 season.

With Williams and Benford at the helm at Marquette, the Golden Eagles have reached the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 in each of the last two years. Marquette was ranked No. 11 in the final AP poll of 2012, and ranked 31st in the country in scoring offense with an average of 75.4 points per game. MU won at least 20 games and reached the NCAA Tournament in each of Benford's four years with the program.

Before arriving at Marquette, he had spent the previous two campaigns at Nebraska under head coach Doc Sadler. The Huskers collected 37 total victories in the two seasons, highlighted by a trip to the National Invitation Tournament in 2008. The squad posted 20 wins in 2007-08, just the 12th 20-win campaign in the program's 112-year history. North Texas forward Alonzo Edwards was recruited to Nebraska by Benford prior to transferring to Denton.

Benford served on the Arizona State bench as an assistant coach for his first six years in Tempe before being named associate head coach for his last two seasons. Benford helped the Sun Devils to four post-season appearances during his tenure, including earning a spot in the second round of the 2003 NCAA Tournament. While at ASU, Benford recruited Keith Wooden and George Odufuwa to Phoenix before the pair transferred to North Texas and went on to start a combined 143 games for the Mean Green.

In six seasons with New Mexico, Benford helped the Lobos reach five NCAA Tournament bids while winning 73.2 percent of their games (139-51 record). New Mexico picked up a pair of Western Athletic Conference tournament titles in 1993 and 1996, and a regular-season championship in 1994. During his stint with the Lobos, Benford coached the top four scorers in program history, including all-time leading scorer in Kenny Thomas.

As a prep all-star, Benford was a Converse All-American and the New Mexico Player of the Year after pouring in 27.5 points per game as a senior at Hobbs High School. He led Hobbs to the state title in his final season, earning MVP honors of the state championship tournament after posting 29 points in the title game.


