Ouick Hitters

- Roger Franklin ranks third in the Sun Belt with a 58.0 field goal percentage.
- NT has 10-plus fast break points in four straight games, and is averaging 11.1 per game this year.
- Alzee Williams leads NT with 31.8 minutes a game, but has just five total turnovers an average of one every 51.7 minutes.

Blocks Machine - With 93 career swats, Tony Mitchell jumped past his former teammate Kedrick Hogans (91 blocks, 2008-12) for third place in NT history. Mitchell has at least two blocks in each of the last 12 games. The sophomore is only 26 blocks shy of the school career record (119 - Jeffrey Simpson, 2004-06) despite playing in just 31 career games.

Scoring Inside-Out - Tony Benford emphasizes paint touches in his offensive philosophy, and NT's ability to score in the lane goes a long way in the final score.

Bounce Back - Justin Patton, who had arthroscopic knee surgery on Oct. 25, had a breakout game against Louisiana on Saturday. The senior poured in eight points on 4-of-6 shooting, and added three steals in just 10 minutes. Patton, the SWAC's leading rebounder in his final season at Grambling State (7.1 RPG in 2010-11), describes his knee's recovery process as "90 percent".

Pick Pocket - Chris Jones has 10 steals in the last two games, which gives him 17 overall - the second most in the Sun Belt and 44th most in the nation. As a team, NT has posted back-to-back games with 10-plus steals, and is tied for 38th in the country with 67 total steals this year. Jones' six steals against UT Arlington are tied for the third most in NT history, while NT's 15 steals against the Mavericks are the most since 2005.

Best In The Belt - With a winning percentage of 64.4, North Texas is the Sun Belt's winningest program since the 2006-07 season. NT has made four trips to the SBC Tournament finals since then, including championships in '07 and '10.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP

- It might be a little tough to glean much from the all-time series record between NT and St. Louis since the last meeting was in 1981 long before a player on either team was born. Still, SLU leads the series 28-9, but the Mean Green has taken all three meetings since NT left the Missouri Valley Conference following the 1975 season. SLU won the first 11 games in the series overall.
- At Saint Louis, NT is 2-16 against the Billikens, including losses to ranked SLU teams in 1959 (No. 15) and 1960 (No. 12). Below are the only two NT wins at St. Louis.

NT wins at St. Louis Jan. 10, 1970 67-62 Dec. 11, 1981 84-70

- North Texas and Saint Louis shared a Missouri Valley Conference rivalry from 1957-58 until 1974-75, when the Mean Green left the league in favor of independent status under legendary NT football coach and athletic director Hayden Fry.
- SLU is coming off a fantastic season, which included a 26-8 record (12-4 in A-10 play) and a trip to the third round of the NCAA Tournament. No. 9 SLU knocked off No. 8 Memphis, 61-54, before falling to No. 1 Michigan State, 65-61. The Billikens return four starters, and were tabbed to finish second in the A-10 Preseason Poll behind only VCU. Senior guard Kwamain Mitchell was named a Preseason First-Team All-Conference selection, while junior guard Jordair Jett was named to the preseason All-Defensive team.
- Jim Crews has been serving as the interim head coach of the Billikens since August. Crews is in his second year with SLU, and entered the season with 354 head coaching victories after stays at Army (2003-10) and Evansville (1985-02). Crews played for Bob Knight at Indiana from 1972-76. His senior year in 1975-76, the Hoosiers went 32-0 and won the national title. They remain the last team to finish a season with an undefeated record.

Glass Gurus - Owning the boards are an essential part of Tony Benford's philosophy, and NT isn't disappointing. NT leads the Sun Belt in offensive rebounding (16.6 per game) and is second in offensive rebounding percentage (39.7 percent).

Tournament Jake - Dating back to last year's Sun Belt Tournament Jacob Holmen has hit 15 of his last 29 shots (51.7 percent) from 3-point. Holmen was a 25.0 percent career 3-point shooter (22-of-88) prior to the 2012 SBC Tournament. Holmen earned All-SBC Tournament honors for helping NT advance to its third straight finals.

First Of Many! - Tony Benford led NT to a 74-59 win over Lamar on Nov. 13, which was the first victory of his head coaching career. Benford came to North Texas as one of the nation's most respected assistant coaches for the last 20 seasons, which included stops at Marquette, Nebraska, Arizona State and New Mexico.

Working Without Walton - NT will be without the services of sharp shooter Brandan Walton for the rest of the year due to injury, but it does put NT in a nice situation for next season. NT will have Walton as well as Marquette transfer T.J. Taylor on board for 2013-14.

28th Ranked Recruiting Class - North Texas coach Tony Benford just laid the foundation on the nation's No. 28 ranked recruiting class according to HoopScoopOnline.com, which includes Seguin's Greg Wesley, Kingwood's Josh Friar and Oldsmar Christian big-man Tony Nunn. NT's class is ranked higher than that of any Sun Belt school or future CUSA foe.

All-American - Tony Mitchell was named a Preseason All-American by several national publications, including ESPN, CBS Sports, Athlon, Basketball Times and Blue Ribbon Report. He was also named the Sun Belt's Preseason Player of the Year. At 14.7 points and 10.3 rebounds, Mitchell joined Kentucky's Anthony Davis as the only freshmen in the country to average a double-double.

Tough Schedule - Matchups against No. 16/15 Creighton, the NIT Season Tip-Off, St. Louis and Lehigh got the attention of USA Today, which ranked the NT schedule as the nation's fifth toughest overall, and the best by any mid-major this year.

First-Class Staff - Tony Benford brought a first-class coaching staff with him to NT. The staff owns over 100 years of collegiate coach-

ing experience, and features Associate Head Coach Rob Evans, who has 205 head coaching wins at Arizona State and Ole' Miss. Bart Lundy, a veteran of 211 head coaching victories at High Point and Queens, came from Marquette to join Benford. David Anwar spent the last six seasons at Nebraska, and is a 12-year collegiate coaching veteran.

Winning Ways - Benford & Co. are taking over a North Texas program that knows how to win. NT has averaged 21 wins per year over the last six seasons, including five straight 20-win seasons from 2007-11. NT won the 2007 and 2010 Sun Belt titles, and played in the NCAA Tournament in both of those seasons.

Third Straight Final - The Mean Green, which fell just two wins shy of its sixth consecutive 20-win season, advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament finals for a third straight year. That makes NT just the third program in Sun Belt history to advance to three straight SBC Tournament finals, and the first since Western Kentucky in 2001-03.

Block Party - Last year, Tony Mitchell set the program's single season blocks record at 70 blocks in just 23 games. He passes Shawnson Johnson, who tallied 69 blocks in 23 games in 2003-04. At 3.04 blocks per game overall, Mitchell's pace was just ahead of Johnson's 3.00 average for the best in NT history.

Bringing Them In - Last season NT averaged over 4,000 fans for just the third time in school history and for the first time since 1976-77. The Mean Green finished the year with an average of 4,006 fans per home game after a season-high 6,921 fans attended the home finale. That average ranked third in the Sun Belt in 2011-12 behind only Denver (5,460) and Middle Tennessee (5,035).

Pit Prowess - The reason for the attendance spike has a lot to do with the fact that North Texas has been nearly unbeatable at home. NT is a Sun Belt best 76-19 (.800) at the Super Pit since the 2006-07 season.

Big Minutes - Alzee Williams played 1,013 minutes in 2011-12, which are the eighth most in school history. Williams joins Josh White (3) George Odufuwa (2), Tristan Thompson (1) and Ben Bell (1) as the only North Texas players since Tony Worrell in 1988 to play over 1,000 minutes in a single season. Williams led the Sun Belt with 35.6 minutes per league game after taking over the bulk of the point guard duties with 13 games remaining.

One of the nation's most respected assistant coaches, Tony Benford, has taken the reigns of the North Texas men's basketball program.

A veteran of 20 years in Division I basketball and 14 postseason appearances, Benford served as the associate head coach under Buzz Williams at Marquette last season; his fourth year with the Golden Eagles. During his time at Marquette, Benford helped recruit and coach six All-Big East players, including 2012 Big East Player of the Year Jae Crowder.

Tabbed by Basketball Times, Fox Sports and Hoop Scoop as one of the country's top assistant coaches, Benford also spent time at Nebraska (2006-08), Arizona State (1998-06) and New Mexico (1992-98) developing some of the nation's most talented players.

"I couldn't be more excited about the opportunity of taking over the basketball program at North Texas," Benford said. "I would like to thank Rick Villarreal and President V. Lane Rawlins for this opportunity, and Johnny Jones for doing such a great job in making North Texas a winner. My philosophy is all about the players, and we will do everything in ensure that our players grow in the classroom, the community and on the court."

In his career Benford recruited and coached five NBA first-round draft picks: Garland, Texas; Ike Diogu (Arizona St., '05), Charles Smith (New Mexico, '97), Kenny Thomas (New Mexico, '99), Lazar Hayward (Marquette, '10) and Jimmy Butler (Marquette, '11), as well as three second-round picks in Eddie House (Arizona St., '00), Tommy Smith (Arizona St., '03) and Jeff Pendergraph (Arizona St., '09).

A native of Hobbs, N.M., Benford played collegiately at Texas Tech and was the catalyst for the Red Raiders Southwest Conference regular-season and tournament titles in 1985, and their 1986 SWC Tournament championship. He earned All-Southwest Conference and SWC Tournament MVP honors as a senior. The Boston Celtics selected Benford in the fourth round of the 1986 NBA Draft, and he played professionally in Holland for the 1986-87 season.

With Williams and Benford at the helm at Marquette, the Golden Eagles have reached the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 in each of the last two years. Marquette was ranked No. 11 in the final AP poll of 2012, and ranked 31st in the country in scoring offense with an average of 75.4 points per game. MU won at least 20 games and reached the NCAA Tournament in each of Benford's four years with the program.

Before arriving at Marquette, he had spent the previous two campaigns at Nebraska under head coach Doc Sadler. The Huskers collected 37 total victories in the two seasons, highlighted by a trip to the National Invitation Tournament in 2008. The squad posted 20 wins in 2007-08, just the 12th 20-win campaign in the program's 112-year history. North Texas forward Alonzo Edwards was recruited to Nebraska by Benford prior to transferring to Denton.

Benford served on the Arizona State bench as an assistant coach for his first six years in Tempe before being named associate head coach for his last two seasons. Benford helped the Sun Devils to four post-season appearances during his tenure, including earning a spot in the second round of the 2003 NCAA Tournament. While at ASU, Benford recruited Keith Wooden and George Odufuwa to Phoenix before the pair transferred to North Texas and went on to start a combined 143 games for the Mean Green.

In six seasons with New Mexico, Benford helped the Lobos reach five NCAA Tournament bids while winning 73.2 percent of their games (139-51 record). New Mexico picked up a pair of Western Athletic Conference tournament titles in 1993 and 1996, and a regular-season championship in 1994. During his stint with the Lobos, Benford coached the top four scorers in program history, including all-time leading scorer in Kenny Thomas.

As a prep all-star, Benford was a Converse All-American and the New Mexico Player of the Year after pouring in 27.5 points per game as a senior at Hobbs High School. He led Hobbs to the state title in his final season, earning MVP honors of the state championship tournament after posting 29 points in the title game.


