Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. Coming off its third straight 20-win season, the Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Preseason All-Sun Belt Accolades -

Eric Tramiel was named to the first-team and Josh White earned second-team honors on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference squads. Tramiel was the Mean Green muscle in the middle, leading NT in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. White played most of 2008-09 with a hand injury, but still ranked second in the NCAA in free throw percentage, and piloted the Mean Green's 31st ranked scoring offense.

Just Eight Away - North Texas head coach Johnny Jones is just eight wins shy of tying Hall-of-Fame coach Bill Blakeley on the Mean Green coaching list. In his ninth-year at NT, Jones has 126 wins, which is just eight behind Blakeley for second in program history.

INSIDE THE GAME

- Johnny Jones is a perfect 8-0 in season openers, giving the program its longest stretch of season opening wins (eight years). No other coach in school history has won more than four straight openers. The program is 49-42 in season openers overall.
- A retooled Cameron squad was picked to finish third in the Lone Star Conference's North Division. The Aggies welcome 12 newcomers and return just three players to a squad that finished 14-13, but was just 3-8 away from Lawton, Okla.
- This will be the fourth straight year that North Texas and Cameron will meet in the season opener. NT leads the all-time series 5-0, and the average margin of victory in the three meetings of the Johnny Jones era is 37 points.
- Last year's meeting took place in North Texas' old home, the Snake Pit, as the Mean Green pulled away for a 87-66 in front of 1,792 boisterous fans. NT had four players in double-digits, led by a team-high 13 points from sophomore Tristan Thompson. Sophomore point guard Josh White had 12 points, seven of which came in the first half. Overall the Mean Green shot 55 percent from the field, including 8-of-17 from three-point territory (47 percent).

- North Texas guard Collin Mangrum showed what he can do when healthy against Middle Tennessee last year. The junior poured in 19 points off the bench, including a trio of 3-pointers. Mangrum missed all of 2007-08 with injuries.
- Forward Jacob Holmen knows how to excel on the court and on the track. The All-East Texas Basketball MVP finished sixth in his region in the 400 meter dash with a time of 50.77. Not bad for a guy who checks in at 6-foot-8 and 220-pounds.
- Center Ben Knox put on around 15 pounds of muscle last year in an intensive weight room routine designed to bulk up the 6-foot-10 freshman.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - North Texas finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas and Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones arrival at North Texas.

Mean Green In Season Openers - North Texas, which opens the year on Friday against Cameron, is 49-42 all-time in season opening games, and 16-4 when those season openers occur at the Super Pit. The Mean Green was 16-8 in season openers at its former home, the Snake Pit (now known as the Ken Bahnsen Center), where it opened against Cameron last year. Head coach Johnny Jones is a perfect 8-0 in season openers, giving the program its longest stretch of season opening wins (eight years). No other coach in school history has won more than four straight openers.

History In The Making - The Mean Green has posted a .500 record or better in each of the past five years, which makes this makes this the most prosperous stretch of hoops at NT since 1931 when the program enjoyed 14 straight winning seasons. North Texas has won at least 10 conference games in each of the last three years – a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Milestone Jones - Head coach Johnny

Jones is nearing a couple of career milestones in '09-'10. Jones is just 12 games shy of his 250th game coached at NT, and 31 games away from the 300th of his career overall. The ninth year head coach will suit up for his 250th game at North Texas against Texas Southern on Dec. 28th, and can reach his 300th overall with a trip to the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament in Hot Springs, Ark.

Lighting Up The Scoreboard - Johnny Jones and the Mean Green play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 65-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Mid-Major Top 25 - The inaugural Collegelnsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll was released on Nov. 2, and the Mean Green just missed out on their first preseason ranking. NT is the top squad in the "Others Receiving Votes" section after garnering 84 votes, just behind Radford for No. 25. North Texas reached a high of No. 17 on the poll in Dec. of 2006.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 602 games.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 50 games at the Super Pit over the last four years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games over the last three years than the Mean Green.

Heart Of Glass - Johnny Jones and the Mean Green pride themselves in their rebounding prowess. North Texas led the Sun Belt in every rebounding statistic in

2006-07 and 2007-08, and wasn't too shabby last year. NT was half a board per game shy of leading the league in overall rebounding last season, and averaged a +2.3 rebounding margin and 12.7 offensive rebounds per game.

Walk The Line - North Texas has been one of the nation's best free throw shooting teams over the years. The Mean Green ranked 42nd in the country last year with a 73.2 percent mark from the stripe, and wasn't too far behind in 2007-08 with a 71.9 percent clip from the line. Those percentages rank third and fifth in the 91 year history of North Texas basketball.

Packing The Pit - North Texas averaged 3,084 fans per game at the Super Pit last year, and 3,178 in 2007-08. That two-year average of 3,131 is the highest in any two year period at NT since 1987-89 (3,167). As a matter of fact, the last two years' attendance figures are just the fifth and sixth time for NT to top the 3,000 per game attendance mark since moving to the Super Pit in 1972.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 999-1,160-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).



- April 16, 2001 Jones named 16th head coach in North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who compiled a 20-87 record in four years.
- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Feb. 26, 2003 Jones picks up his 50th career victory

with an 84-81 overtime victory over 2004 Sun Belt Conference Tournament runner-up New Orleans.

- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, including Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most

lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least amount of points by an NT opponent since 1994.

March 5, 2008 - A win over Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference opening round secures a second straight 20-win season for the Mean Green.

Dec. 31, 2008 - Jones coaches the 250th game of his career, which has spanned eight seasons at NT and Memphis. Jones has amassed a 129-121 record.

Feb. 26, 2009 - With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.






