North Texas won its fifth straight home game by clipping ULM, 79-62, last Sunday afternoon. The Mean Green has now won its last three Sun Belt openers, and is taking a week off for finals before battling FIU at the Super Pit.

Ouick Hitters

- FIU is led by 12-time NBA All-Star, Isiah Thomas, who was selected one of the league's best 50 players of All-Time, is enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, and had his No. 11 jersey retired by the Detroit Pistons. His Golden Panthers have lost six of their last seven games, and are in the midst of an eight game road trip.
- North Texas pounded the ULM Warhawks with season highs in field goal percentage (57.1), 3-point field goal percentage (53.3), assists (17) and steals (7). Tristan Thompson's season-best 20-points powered the 79-62 win, which was NTs fifth straight over the Warhawks.

Super Starters - North Texas has gotten off to great starts under Johnny Jones. A win over FIU would give NT a 7-3 record in its opening 10 games. That would give the program a 7-3, or better, start in four straight seasons. Prior to this stretch, the last 7-3 start for a North Texas team came back in 1977-78.

Strong Shooting - North Texas located its shooting touch just in time for Sun Belt Conference play, pounding the ULM Warhawks with season highs in field goal percentage (57.1), 3-point field goal percentage (53.3), assists (17) and steals (7). Tristan Thompson's season-best 20-points powered the 79-62 win over ULM, which was NTs fifth straight over the Warhawks.

Look Out Louisiana - Tristan Thompson poured in 20 points in the win over ULM, continuing a trend of great play against schools from Louisiana. The junior is averaging 17.7 points per game against Louisiana schools since his sophomore season (six games against UNO, ULM and ULL). Thompson is shooting 33-of-61 (54.1 percent) from the floor, 17-of-26 (64.4 percent) from 3-point and 23-of-28 (82.1 percent) from the free throw line against those teams.

Moving Past The Legends - A couple of recent Mean Green greats have seen their records bested by North Texas guard Josh White. The junior leapt over his former teammate, Quincy Williams, on the North Texas all-time scorers list, and is also tied with Kendrick Davis in career 3-pointers. White is up to 23rd place with 915 career points, moving past Williams' 909 points from 2004-08. White is tied with Davis for 9th place in school history with 106 career 3-pointers.

Look Out Blakeley! - With the win over ULM North Texas head coach Johnny Jones snagged his 132nd win at NT, and is just two wins shy of tying Hall-of-Fame coach Bill Blakeley on the Mean Green coaching list.

Most Wonderful Time of the Year - December has been a good time for Mean Green basketball, and not just because of the holidays. Over the last five years, North Texas is 23-9 (71.9 percent) in the month of December, including a 6-1 mark in 2006-07. NT is 3-1 so far this year in December, with the only loss coming at No. 16 Texas A&M.

INSIDE THE GAME

- You might have heard of FIU's first-year coach, Isiah Thomas. The 12-time NBA All-Star was selected one of the league's best 50 players of All-Time, is enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, and had his No. 11 jersey retired by the Detroit Pistons. He led Indiana to an NCAA national title in 1981, and was selected No. 2 overall by the Pistons. Thomas is donating his 2009-10 salary back to FIU.
- North Texas leads the all-time record with the Golden Panthers, 8-2, including wins in each of the last two seasons.

- In the last meeting with FIU, a nasty dunk from Eric Tramiel sealed an 80-75 win for NT. Draped by 2 defenders, Tramiel shook the rafters with his dunk that slammed the door on FIU. The dunk was the icing on a near perfect night for Tramiel, who notched his second straight double-double with 22 points and 15 rebounds both career highs. Kedrick Hogans was just as potent with 13 of his career high 15 points coming in the second half.
- FIU has struggled to a 3-9 record this year, including losses in six of their last seven games. NT will be the seventh of eight straight road games for the Golden Panthers. The 8-game road streak covers 5 states.
- FIU ranks eighth in the NCAA in 3-pointers attempted. The Golden Panthers have taken 252 (21 per game) 3-pointers so far, but are shooting just 25.4 percent from downtown.

Eric Has Awakened - Eric Tramiel has come alive over the last five outings, pouncing those opponents for 14.4 points per game on 57.5 percent shooting. The senior has reached double figures in each of those games, and is shooting 38.5 percent from 3-point, and has four assists, five blocks and seven steals.

3-Point Threat - North Texas is suiting up three players that rank in the top 10 in school history in career 3-point percentage. Dominique Johnson ranks 4th with 40.2 percent, Josh White is 5th with 39.1 percent and Tristan Thompson ranks 10th with 37.5 percent.

A Rare Miss Indeed - Josh White missed a free throw against ULM - a rare miss for a guy that doesn't miss many in the month of December. As a matter of fact, White is 74-of-81 (91.3 percent) from the stripe in the month of December in his career. White ranks No. 2 in school history with an 87.0 career free throw mark, and ranked second in the NCAA last year.

Spreading The Wealth - The Mean Green is 79th in the country in scoring with 76.6 points per game, but is once again doing it with a multi-faceted attack. Ten different North Texas players are averaging double-digit minutes, and eight players are averaging more than 6.3 points per

game. NT as a team ranked 32nd in the NCAA in scoring last year despite not having a player in the national top 500 in individual scoring.

Double-Double Man - With double-doubles in three of the year's outings, George Odufuwa is currently averaging 9.8 points and 10.4 rebounds per game. He ranks 22nd in the NCAA with 10.4 rebounds per game. Odufuwa hauled in 24 boards in the season opener against Cameron, becoming just the ninth player in the NCAA since 2005-06 to register 24 or more rebounds in a single game.

Preseason All-Sun Belt Accolades - Eric Tramiel was named to the first-team and Josh White earned second-team honors on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference squads. Tramiel was the Mean Green muscle in the middle, leading NT in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. White played most of 2008-09 with a hand injury, but still ranked second in the NCAA in free throw percentage, and piloted the Mean Green's 31st ranked scoring offense.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

Lighting Up The Scoreboard - Johnny Jones and NT play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

Milestone Jones - Head coach Johnny Jones is nearing a couple of career milestones in '09-'10. Jones is just four games shy of his 250th game coached at NT, and 23 games away from the 300th of his career overall. The ninth year head coach will suit up for his 250th game at North Texas against Texas Southern on Dec. 28th, and can reach his 300th overall with a trip to the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb.

27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 68-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season a span of 611 games.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 54 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,005-1,163-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).



- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Feb. 26, 2003 Jones picks up his 50th career victory with an 84-81 overtime victory over 2004 Sun Belt Con-

ference Tournament runner-up New Orleans.

- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, including Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State


