Sun Belt Warrior - Tristan Thompson has picked up right where he left off in Sun Belt play after a stellar sophomore season. The junior has 20 and 27 points outings in NT's two conference games this year, and is shooting 55.6 percent from the floor, and 66.7 percent from 3-point. In his last 20 conference games Thompson is averaging 13.6 points per contest on 50.0 percent shooting from downtown and 81.9 percent from the stripe.

No Lead Is Safe For NT Opponents - Josh White's 25-foot dagger with 0.4 left on the clock sent NT and FIU into overtime, completing yet another improbable Mean Green comeback under Johnny Jones. North Texas erased a 16-point Golden Panther lead, nearly equaling the school record 21-point comebacks in each of the last two seasons. The Mean Green knocked off Denver (Jan. 15, 2009) and New Mexico State (Dec. 1, 2007) after trailing by as many 21 points in the second half.

Jones Milestones On The Way - The magic number for North Texas head coach Johnny Jones is two - as in two wins shy of legendary coach Bill Blakeley, and two games away from his 250th overall contest coached at NT. With 132 wins at North Texas, Jones can move into second place in career victories by passing Blakeley, who complied a 134-85 mark from 1976-83. Having been on the sidelines for 248 Mean Green games, Jones trails only 22-year coach Pete Shands (482 games from 1935-59) in games coached.

Dean Of The Sun Belt - No other current coach has been apart of more Sun Belt games than North Texas' Johnny Jones. In his ninth season with the Mean Green, Jones has coached 131 Sun Belt Conference games, and 248 games overall. In the league, only Troy's Don Maestri has been at his program longer than Jones has coached at NT.

Most Wonderful Time of the Year - Despite the loss to FIU, December has been a good time for Mean Green basketball.. Over the last five years, North Texas is 23-10 (69.7 percent) in the month of December, including a 6-1 mark in 2006-07.

- North Texas has already picked up a win over a Southland Conference team this year when it knocked off UT Arlington, 101-99, in double overtime on Nov. 18. The Mean Green is 226-168 all-time against current teams from the Southland, including an 8-4 mark in the Johnny Jones era. A league with lengthy ties to the Mean Green, NT has played at least 25 games against seven SLC teams. North Texas was a member of the Southland from 1982-1996.
- The Lions have dropped two of their last three games, but were tabbed to be among the best in the Southland Conference in the annual coaches poll. SELA and North Texas have several common opponents, including Sun Belt foe Florida Atlantic (W 90-77), Jackson State (W 77-55) and Texas Southern (L 65-71). The Lions will take on UT Arlington, who NT beat 101-99 in double overtime, in Southland play in February.
- Southeastern presents a rare combination of potent scoring offense and tentatious defense. Entering their game with Texas Southern, the Lions ranked in the NCAA's top 25 in scoring offense (22), scoring margin (18), field goal percentage defense (11), free throw percentage (9), assists (10) and assist/turnover ratio (17).
- In a battle of NT's next two opponents, Southeastern let a hot-shooting Texas Southern squad steal a 71-65 win on Saturday. Texas Southern overcame 20 turnovers by shooting 56.9 percent, and holding SELA to 36.7 percent. SELA's Robert Tibbs led all scorers with 19 points.

Double-Double Man - With double-doubles in three of the year's outings, George Odufuwa is currently averaging 10.0 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. He is one of just 27 players in the nation to average double-digit rebounds. Odufuwa hauled in 24 boards in the season opener against Cameron, becoming just the ninth player in the NCAA since 2005-06 to register 24 or more rebounds in a single game.

Moving Past The Legends - A couple of recent Mean Green greats have seen their records bested by North Texas guard Josh White. The junior leapt over his former teammate, Quincy Williams, on the North Texas all-time scorers list, and Kendrick Davis in career 3-pointers. White is up to 23rd place with 928 career points, moving past Williams' 909 points from 2004-08. White has also hit 108 career 3-pointers, which moves past Davis for 9th place.

A Rare Miss Indeed - Josh White uncharacteristically went 5-of-10 from the free throw stripe against FIU. The junior missed just 10 free throws in all of 2008-09, and ranked second in the NCAA with a 90.6 (96-106) percent clip. White ranks No. 2 in school history with an 85.8 career free throw mark.

Spreading The Wealth - The Mean Green is 85th in the country in scoring with 75.9 points per game, but is once again doing it with a multi-faceted attack. Ten different North Texas players are averaging double-digit minutes, and eight players are averaging more than 5.8 points per game. NT as a team ranked 32nd in the

NCAA in scoring last year despite not having a player in the national top 500 in individual scoring.

Preseason All-Sun Belt Accolades - Eric Tramiel was named to the first-team and Josh White earned second-team honors on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference squads. Tramiel was the Mean Green muscle in the middle, leading NT in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. White played most of 2008-09 with a hand injury, but still ranked second in the NCAA in free throw percentage, and piloted the Mean Green's 31st ranked scoring offense.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - NT finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

Milestone Jones - Head coach Johnny Jones is nearing a couple of career milestones in '09-'10. Jones is just two games shy of his 250th game coached at NT, and 21 games away from the 300th of his career overall. The ninth year head coach will suit up for his 250th game at North Texas against Texas Southern on Dec. 28th, and can reach his 300th overall with a trip to the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Tex-

as is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 68-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the all-time great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 612 games.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 54 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,005-1,164-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).

NT graduate and 1310 The Ticket (KTCK-AM) personality George Dunham will handle the play-by-play duties, with Deputy Athletic Director Hank Dickenson providing analysis. - April 16, 2001 Jones named 16th head coach in North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who compiled a 20-87 record in four years.
- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Feb. 26, 2003 Jones picks up his 50th career victory with an 84-81 overtime victory over 2004 Sun Belt Con-

ference Tournament runner-up New Orleans.

- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, including Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State.

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked

off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least




