## On Tap

North Texas snapped a two-game skid with a 71-57 thumping of New Orleans on Saturday afternoon. Josh White paved the way with 21 points as the Mean Green led by as much as 20 points with three minutes remaining. Now, North Texas heads to Troy, Ala., where two of the Sun Belt's top three offenses will face off.

#### **Ouick Hitters**

- With his 21-point performance against New Orleans on Saturday, Josh White became just the 18th player in North Texas history to record 1,000 career points. A junior, White needed just 77 games to reach the milestone, giving him a career average of 13.1 points.
- NT and Troy have only met six times in their brief history, but the Mean Green leads the series 4-2. These two teams first met in January of 2006, with NT taking the first three. North Texas and Troy have split a pair of games in Troy, Ala.

White Nets 1,000 - With his 21-point performance against New Orleans on Saturday, Josh White became just the 18th player in North Texas history to record 1,000 career points. The All-Sun Belt performer hit 5-of-12 shots and 9-of-11 free throws against the Privateers, and now sits in 17th place in school history with 1,010 points. A junior, White needed just 77 games to reach the milestone, giving him a career average of 13.1 points per game. With that average, White could challenge the top four scorers in school history by the end of his senior season.

**Texas Ten-Step -** The state of Texas contains 21 NCAA Division I programs, and NT is one of just eight to have already amassed 10 wins this year (four of the eight teams are members of the Big XII). NT is 3-1 against teams from the Lone Star State so far this year, and will have another chance against Houston Baptist in Feb. Only two other Sun Belt teams have reached 10 wins (Denver & South Alabama).

Sun Belt Specialist - In conference games, Tristan Thompson ranks second in the Sun Belt in scoring with an average of 20.0 points per contest. The junior ranks third in 3-pointers made in Sun Belt games, and leads the league in 3-point shooting with a 57.1 percent mark. Thompson has amassed 764 career points, which means he is only 80 points away from joining Josh White in the top 30 scorers in program history.

Double-Double Odufuwa - The list of NT players that have averaged a doubledouble for a full season reads like a list of the program's all-time greats. George Odufuwa, who is averaging 10.8 points and a Sun Belt best 9.6 rebounds per game, could become just the 13th player in school history to reach that feat. The last NT player to average a double-double was Jesse Ratliff in 1993. Ratliff averaged 23.1 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, and still ranks third in career scoring. Jim Mudd in 1960 had perhaps the greatest season in NT history with 25.2 points and 11.4 rebounds per game - and he did it with six games against top 20 opponents in Missouri Valley Conference play.

#### INSIDE THE GAME

- North Texas and Troy have only met six times in their brief history, but the Mean Green leads the series 4-2. These two teams first met in January of 2006, with NT taking the first three games. North Texas and Troy have split a pair of games in Troy, Ala.
- North Texas' last two wins in the series have been by a wide margin 41 and 26 points. The Mean Green set the school record for the largest win over a Division I opponent with the 41 point blowout in 2007. The next season, North Texas knocked off the Trojans 90-64 at the Super Pit. The common factors NT held Troy to a combined 29.4 percent shooting and posted an 88-22 edge in points in the paint.
- Brandon Hazzard leads a potent Trojan offense that ranks 23rd in the country at 80.5 points per game. The senior All-Sun Belt selection leads the league with 19.0 points per game on 44.8 percent shooting from 3-point. As a team, Troy is one of the country's most efficient offenses, ranking 16th in field goal percentage (49.4) and 14th in 3-point percentage (40.8).
- Troy responded to an 83-69 loss at Florida Atlantic with a hot-shooting 84-68 win at Florida International on Saturday night. The Trojans, led by Brandon Hazzard's 29 points, shot 57.7 percent from the floor and hit 13-of-23 (56.5 percent) from 3-point. Hazzard posted six of those 3-pointers himself, and Richard Delk wasn't far behind with five 3-pointers and 17 points. Michael Vogler, who ranks in the NCAA top 25 in assists, posted a game-high eight dimes.
- Last time vs Troy: Eric Tramiel scored a team-high 19 points and George Odufawa snagged a then career-high 18 rebounds, but it wasn't enough to overcome a late run by Troy, falling 77-69 on Jan. 29, 2009 at the Super Pit. Down 4 points with 4 minutes remaining, Troy went on a 14-2 run to close the game. Brandon Hazzard scored a gamehigh 23 points. Odufuwa's 18 boards were the most by a Sun Belt player in '08-09.

**Take It To The Bank** - A halftime lead has been a sure thing for North Texas this year. The Mean Green is 9-0 so far this season when heading into the break with a lead.

All Alone In Second - Johnny Jones stands alone in second place in North Texas career wins after the 83-78 win over UALR on New Year's Eve. Jones' 135th win passes Hall-of-Famer Bill Blakeley for second in program history. Blakeley, who complied a 134-85 mark from 1976-83, also coached the Dallas Chaparrals before they became the San Antonio Spurs. Only one other NT coach has coached more games than Jones - Pete Shands (482 games in 22 years).

**Double-Digit Dealer -** Josh White is working his way up the program's scoring charts, and now has 52 career double-digit scoring games to his credit. The junior posted 22 double-digit games as a freshman, 17 last year, and already has 13 through 16 games this year. It only took White 75 career games to reach his 50th double-digit scoring effort.

**Dean Of The Sun Belt -** No other current coach has been apart of more Sun Belt games than North Texas' Johnny Jones. In his ninth season with the Mean Green, Jones has coached 135 Sun Belt Conference games, and 285 games overall. In the league, only Troy's Don Maestri has been at his program longer than Jones has coached at NT.

Happy Holidays - North Texas was 6-2 (75 percent) in the month of December this season, which was the fifth best December in the 92 year history of Mean Green basketball. Over the last five years, North Texas was 26-10 (72.2 percent) in December.

**Pressure Pit -** The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 57 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 69-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

**Spreading The Wealth -** The Mean Green is 93rd in the country in scoring with 73.9 points per game, but is once again doing it with a multi-faceted attack. Ten different North Texas players are averaging 9.5 minutes or more, and eight players are averaging more than five points per game. NT as a team ranked 32nd in the NCAA in scoring last year despite not having a player in the national top 500 in individual scoring.

Best In The West-North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a leaguehigh 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - NT finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

**Lighting Up The Scoreboard** - Johnny Jones and NT play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North

Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

**Deadly From Downtown -** One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 618 games.

**92nd Season -** North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,009-1,166-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).

- April 16, 2001 Jones named 16th head coach in North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who compiled a 20-87 record in four years.
- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, includ-

ing Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.

- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

**Dec. 19, 2006 -** Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

**Feb. 15, 2007 -** Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State.

**March 16, 2007** - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

**Nov. 11, 2007** - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

**Dec. 1, 2007 -** Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer

the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least amount of points by an NT opponent since 1994.

March 5, 2008 - A win over Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference opening round secures a second straight 20-win season for the Mean Green.

**Dec. 31, 2008** - Jones coaches the 250th game of his career, which has spanned eight seasons at NT and Memphis. Jones has amassed a 129-121 record.

**Feb. 26, 2009 -** With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Nov. 18, 2009 - Broke the 14-year hold UT Arlington had on North Texas with a 101-99 double OT win. The Mavericks had won the previous five meetings.

**Dec. 31, 2009** - In the last game of the decade, Jones passes Bill Blakeley for 2nd place in school history in career victories with 135 wins.




