#### On Tap

North Texas picked up a key win over Sun Belt East Division leader Troy on Thursday thanks to clutch free throws. The Mean Green went 8-of-10 from the stripe in the game's final minute to ice the victory. Now, NT will look for a measure of revenge when the top team in the West Division, Arkansas State, comes to the Super Pit. The Red Wolves handled NT 71-56 at the Convocation Center on Jan. 2.

#### **Quick Hitters**

- Tristan Thompson has been simply electric in Sun Belt play this year, leading the conference with an average of 20.1 points per contest and a 3-point percentage of 54.8. The junior has reached double figures in each of his last nine games.
- Before the Jan. 2 loss at the Convocation Center, the Mean Green had taken the previous six meetings with ASU dating back to the 2007 Sun Belt Championship game. Arkansas State sits atop the Sun Belt West standings and has won 3 of its last 4 games.

Welcome Back - Eric Tramiel made the most of his return from a wrist injury by racking up 11 points on 5-of-10 shooting at Troy. The senior missed NT's last four games with the injury, but came off the bench to spark the Mean Green win with 18 key minutes. North Texas was 2-2 with Tramiel sidelined, but is a different defensive team with the Preseason All-Sun Belt forward.

**Two-Minute Drill -** In the final two minutes of the win over Troy, North Texas hit 8-of-10 free throws to ice the game. One of the SBC's top free-throw shooting squads, NT has been clutch from the charity stripe all year. Seven of the Mean Green's 11 wins have come down to free throws in the final minutes to seal the victory. NT is 48-of-58 (82.8 percent) from the stripe in the final two minutes of those games. Josh White (27-32) and Tristan Thompson (12-15) are shooting a combined 83.0 percent in the final two minutes this year.

Road Tested - NT's longest tenured player, Collin Mangrum, has been apart of the Mean Green since the 2006-07 season. Thanks to Thursday night's 75-72 win at Troy, NT has won at least one game at 11 of the Sun Belt's 13 venues since Mangrum's freshman campaign. The only places that North Texas hasn't won at since '06-07 are South Alabama's Mitchell Center (0-3) and FAU Arena (0-1). NT will get its chance win at FAU on Feb. 4.

Sun Belt Specialist - Tristan Thompson has been simply electric in Sun Belt play this year, leading the conference with an average of 20.1 points per contest and a 3-point percentage of 54.8. The junior has reached double figures in each of his last nine games, averaging 19.3 points and 50.5 percent shooting over that span. Thompson has amassed 785 career points, which means he is only 59 points away from joining Josh White in the top 30 scorers in program history.

#### INSIDE THE GAME

- Arkansas State holds a slim 17-15 margin in the all-time series with North Texas. Before the Jan. 2 loss at the Convocation Center, the Mean Green had taken the previous six meetings dating back to the 2007 Sun Belt Championship game. The series at the Super Pit is tied at 7-7.
- NT assistant coach Shawn Forrest is as familiar with Arkansas State's program as anyone. In his second year at NT, Forrest spent six seasons with Arkansas State prior to his arrival in Denton.
- Since last facing NT, the Red Wolves have picked up a couple of key SBC wins and find themselves atop the West Division standings. ASU knocked off MTSU 69-67 on Jan. 7 before taking down South Alabama 69-63 on the road.
- ASU is led by a trio of double-figure scorers; Daniel Bryant (13.4), Brandon Reed (13.5) and Martavius Adams (10.9). An excellent rebounding outfit, ASU leads the Sun Belt in defensive rebounds, and holds a +2.4 rebounding margin. Trey Finn leads the Red Wolves with 7.6 boards per game.
- ASU is coming off a 69-63 win at South Alabama, one of the SBC's East Division favorites. Brandon Reed paved the way with a game-high 26 points and five assists. Martavius Adams tallied 12 points and Rashad Allison added 11. South Alabama turned 14 ASU turnovers into 19 points, but shot just 41.7 percent as a team.
- Last time vs Arkansas State; The duo of Brandon Reed and Martavius Adams were too much for North Texas as ASU ended the NT's three-game winning streak with a 71-56 win on Jan. 2. Reed and Adams combined for 41 points as ASU led wire to wire. The Red Wolves raced out 12-2 in the first four minutes, and took a 32-22 lead into the break. Tristan Thompson single handily kept the Mean Green alive in the second half scoring 10 straight points and finishing with a team-high 18.

White Nets 1,000 - With his 21-point performance against New Orleans last Saturday, Josh White became just the 18th player in North Texas history to record 1,000 career points. After dropping 18 points at Troy, the All-Sun Belt performer sits in 16th place in school history with 1,028 points. White is expected to challenge the top four scorers in school history by the end of his senior

Texas Ten-Step - The state of Texas contains 21 NCAA Division I programs, and NT reached 10 wins faster than all but eight of them (four of the eight teams are members of the Big XII). NT is 3-1 against teams from the Lone Star State so far this year, and will have another chance against Houston Baptist in Feb. Only two other Sun Belt teams reached 10 wins faster (Denver & South Ala-

Double-Double Odufuwa - The list of NT players that have averaged a double-double for a full season reads like a list of the program's all-time greats. George Odufuwa, who is averaging 10.5 points and a Sun Belt best 9.6 rebounds per game, could become just the 13th player in school history to reach that feat. The last NT player to average a double-double was Jesse Ratliff in 1993. Ratliff averaged 23.1 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, and still ranks third in career scoring. Jim Mudd in 1960 had perhaps the greatest season in NT history with 25.2 points and 11.4 rebounds per game - and he did it with six games against top 20 opponents in Missouri Valley Conference play.

Take It To The Bank - A halftime lead has been a sure thing for North Texas this year.

The Mean Green is 10-0 so far this season when heading into the break with a lead.

All Alone In Second - Johnny Jones stands alone in second place in North Texas career wins after the 83-78 win over UALR on New Year's Eve. Jones' 135th win passes Hall-of-Famer Bill Blakeley for second in program history. Blakeley, who complied a 134-85 mark from 1976-83, also coached the Dallas Chaparrals before they became the San Antonio Spurs. Only one other NT coach has coached more games than Jones - Pete Shands (482 games in 22 years).

Dean Of The Sun Belt - No other current coach has been apart of more Sun Belt games than North Texas' Johnny Jones. In his ninth season with the Mean Green, Jones has coached 136 Sun Belt Conference games, and 286 games overall. In the league, only Troy's Don Maestri has been at his program longer than Jones has coached at NT.

Johnson Injured - North Texas will unfortunately be without the services of Dominique Johnson for the remainder of the year. The senior led the squad with 120 assists in 2008-09, but broke a bone in his ankle in the second half of the Rice game. Johnson had played in just four games this year due to a preseason shoulder injury.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record

**Eighty Or Bust -** One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 69-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - NT finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

Lighting Up The Scoreboard - Johnny Jones

and NT play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Tournament.

**Deadly From Downtown -** One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season a span of 619 games.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,010-1,166-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).

• Nov. 16, 2001 - Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.

• April 16, 2001 - Jones named 16th head coach in

North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who com-

piled a 20-87 record in four years.

- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7. 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, includ-

- according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State.

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least amount of points by an NT opponent since 1994.

March 5, 2008 - A win over Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference opening round secures a second straight 20-win season for the Mean Green.

Dec. 31, 2008 - Jones coaches the 250th game of his career, which has spanned eight seasons at NT and Memphis. Jones has amassed a 129-121 record.

Feb. 26, 2009 - With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Nov. 18, 2009 - Broke the 14-year hold UT Arlington had on North Texas with a 101-99 double OT win. The Mavericks had won the previous five meetings.

**Dec. 31, 2009 -** In the last game of the decade, Jones passes Bill Blakeley for 2nd place in school history in career victories with 135 wins.
