On Tap

All five starters reached double figures for North Texas in an 86-78 win over South Alabama last Thursday. George Odufuwa and Eric Tramiel both tallied a double-double - a first for NT since the 2007 SBC Tournament semifinals. After a weekend break, the Mean Green heads to E.A. Diddle arena to take on Western Kentucky. The Hilltoppers have lost four straight games for the first time since 2003-04.

Quick Hitters

- George Odufuwa upped his season averages to 11.1 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. That rebounding average ranks 20th in the nation and makes him one of just 24 in the NCAA averaging a double-double.
- Since returning from a wrist injury three games ago, Eric Tramiel is averaging 16.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. The senior has hit 20-34 (58.8 percent) of his attempts and has blocked a pair of shots as well.

Double-Double-Odufuwa - After posting 16 points and 16 boards against South Alabama, George Odufuwa upped his season averages to 11.1 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. That average ranks the junior 20th in the nation on the boards and makes him one of just 24 in the NCAA averaging a double-double. At this rate of 10.1 rebounds per game, Odufuwa should challenge for one of the top five seasons on the glass in program history.

Five Alive - North Texas is known as one of the nation's deepest teams, but the starters carried the load in the win over South Alabama. Led by Eric Tramiel's 25 points, all five starters reached double figures, and scored 80 of NT's 86 points. It was just the third time in the Johnny Jones era (since '01-02) that all five starters reached double figures, and the first time since the 2007 Sun Belt Tournament championship game against Arkansas State.

Tramiel's Terrific Too - George Odufuwa wasn't the only player to pounce on the Jaguars last Thursday. Eric Tramiel got his first starting nod since a wrist injury sidelined him for five games in Dec., and poured in a career-high 25 points and notched 13 rebounds. His fifth career double-double, Tramiel owned the paint with seven offensive rebounds. It also marked the first time North Texas had two players with a double-double since the 2007 Sun Belt Tournament semifinals against ULM.

What Injury? - Since returning from a wrist injury three games ago, Eric Tramiel is averaging 16.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. The senior has hit 20-34 (58.8 percent) of his attempts and has blocked a pair of shots as well.

30 Shy Of 30th - Josh White has been climbing the NT career scoring charts, but fellow junior Tristan Thompson is about to join him. Thanks to a streak of 11 straight games in double figures, Thompson has scored 814 points in his career - just 30 shy of the top 30 scorers in program history. Thompson already ranks sixth in career 3-point field goal percentage with a mark of 39.1 percent, and eighth with a 79.94 career free throw mark.

INSIDE THE GAME

- Western Kentucky leads the all-time series with North Texas, 11-2, including a 5-1 edge in Bowling Green, Ky. The Mean Green did, however, solve the riddle of E.A. Diddle Arena in its 2006 appearance at the facility. Keith Wooden hit the winning layup with just over five seconds remaining in December of 2006 to give NT its first win in seven tries in the facility.
- With 41 conference titles and a win percentage that ranks among the top 10 in NCAA history, Western Kentucky is one of college basketball's top programs. WKU has accounted for five of the last 10 Sun Belt regular season and tournament MVPs. Orlando Mendez-Valdez and Courtney Lee both led WKU to wins in the NCAA Tournament, and Lee went on to play in the NBA Finals with the Orlando Magic after being drafted 22nd overall.
- Since joining the league in 2000, the Hill-toppers have knocked NT out of the Sun Belt Tourney three times, including the last two seasons. NT fell to WKU in the 2008 Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals, 84-70, at the Mitchell Center in Mobile, Ala., and in the 2009 semifinals, 77-70, in Hot Springs, Ark.
- Western Kentucky has been stellar at home this year with an 8-2 clip at E.A. Diddle Arena, but fell in its last home contest to Middle Tennessee, 84-74. SBC Preseason Player of the Year A.J. Slaughter leads the way for WKU with 16.8 points per game, followed by Steffphon Pettigrew with 14.5 and Jeremy Evans with 9.7. Indiana State is the only other team to best WKU at home.
- Last time vs WKU: The Hilltoppers were able to outlast NT 77-70 in the semifinals of the SBC Tourney at Summit Arena. Despite 20 points from Dominique Johnson and 14 points from Adam McCoy the Mean Green was unable to advance to its second conference title game in the last three years. Sergio Kerusch led the way for WKU with 23 points, but A.J. Slaughter wasn't far behind with 22.

Manufacturing Points - North Texas has crashed the boards and made the most of its second chance opportunities lately. Over the last six games, North Texas has grabbed an average of 14.3 offensive rebounds, and has turned them into 14.8 second chance points per game. Not surprisingly, George Odufuwa has been the main culprit with 24 offensive rebounds over that span.

White's The Way - It's no secret that as Josh White goes, so goes the Mean Green. White is one of the SBC's leading scorers at 14.8 points per game and a top 5 assist man at 3.9 per game. NT is 10-1 this year when the junior shoots 40 percent or better, but is 2-6 when he shoots under 40 percent.

Two-Minute Drill - In the final two minutes of the win over South Alabama, North Texas hit 6-of-6 free throws to ice the game. One of the SBC's top freethrow shooting squads, NT has been clutch from the charity stripe all year. Eight of the Mean Green's 12 wins have come down to free throws in the final minutes to seal the victory. NT is 54-of-64 (84.4 percent) from the stripe in the final two minutes of those games. Josh White (27-32) and Tristan Thompson (14-17) are shooting a combined 83.7 percent in the final two minutes this year.

Super Scorer - Josh White is climbing the NT career scoring charts, and currently sits in 16th place in school history with 1,047 points. White is expected to challenge the top four scorers in school history by the end of his senior season.

Sun Belt Specialist - Tristan Thompson has been simply electric in Sun Belt play this year, leading the conference with an average of 18.9 points per contest.

Take It To The Bank - A halftime lead has been a sure thing for North Texas this year. The Mean Green is 10-0 so far this season when heading into the break with a lead.

All Alone In Second - Johnny Jones stands alone in second place in North Texas career wins after the 83-78 win over UALR on New Year's Eve. Jones' 135th win passed Hall-of-Famer Bill Blakeley for second in program history. Blakeley, who complied a 134-85 mark from 1976-83, also coached the Dallas Chaparrals before they became the San Antonio Spurs. Only one other NT coach has coached more games than Jones - Pete Shands (482 games in 22 years).

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 58 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 70-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - NT finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

Air Time - NT is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the SBC Tourney.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 621 games.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,011-1,167-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).



 Nov. 16, 2001 - Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.

• April 16, 2001 - Jones named 16th head coach in

North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who com-

piled a 20-87 record in four years.

- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, includ-

- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State.

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer

the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most postided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least amount of points by an NT opponent since 1994.

March 5, 2008 - A win over Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference opening round secures a second straight 20-win season for the Mean Green.

Dec. 31, 2008 - Jones coaches the 250th game of his career, which has spanned eight seasons at NT and Memphis. Jones has amassed a 129-121 record.

Feb. 26, 2009 - With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Nov. 18, 2009 - Broke the 14-year hold UT Arlington had on North Texas with a 101-99 double OT win. The Mavericks had won the previous five meetings.

Dec. 31, 2009 - In the last game of the decade, Jones passes Bill Blakeley for 2nd place in school history in career victories with 135 wins.




