On Tap

North Texas got the upper hand in the overtime thriller at Western Kentucky on Thursday night. If you saw Sportscenter, you saw Steffphon Pettigrew send the game into OT on a 35-foot miracle. But the Mean Green was 4-5 from the floor in overtime, including Eric Tramiel's game winning layup with eight seconds left. Now NT turns its attention to the hottest team in the Sun Belt, Middle Tennessee, winners of four straight.

Ouick Hitters

- Winning on the road is what separates the good teams from the pack, and North Texas has been as good as any in the Sun Belt. NT is 5-5 away from the Super Pit overall, and 3-2 in SBC play. Only South Alabama (6-5) has a better road win percentage than NT.
- With his third straight double-double, George Odufuwa upped his averages to 11.3 points and 10.4 rebounds per game. That average ranks 14th in the nation on the boards and makes him one of just 24 in the NCAA averaging a double-double.

20-Game Report - With nine regular season games left, the NT is seven wins shy of its fourth consecutive 20-win season. North Texas is one of just two teams in the Sun Belt Conference to rack up 13 wins this season (Denver & NT). As a matter of fact, only eight of the 21 teams from the state of Texas have reached 13 wins - and four of those are from the Big XII.

Double-Double-Odufuwa - George Odufuwa has posted three straight double-doubles, upping his season averages to 11.3 points and 10.4 rebounds per game. That average ranks the junior 14th in the nation on the boards and makes him one of just 24 in the NCAA averaging a double-double. At this rate of 10.4 rebounds per game, Odufuwa should challenge for one of the top five seasons on the glass in program history.

10 Shy Of 30th - Thanks to a streak of 12 straight games in double figures, Tristan Thompson has scored 832 points in his career - just 10 shy of 30th place in school history. Thompson already ranks fifth in career 3-point field goal percentage with a mark of 39.2 percent, and eighth with a 80.3 career free throw mark.

Five Alive - North Texas is known as one of the nation's deepest teams, but the starters have scored 164 of NT's 170 points in its last two games. All five starters reached double figures in both games, led by Eric Tramiel's 25 points in each outing. Thursday's game at Western Kentucky was just the fourth time in the Johnny Jones era (since '01-02) that all five starters reached double figures, and marked the first time in consecutive games.

Tramiel's Back - Eric Tramiel has scored 25 points in each of his last two games, and has been a destructive force in the paint since his return from a wrist injury five games ago. Since then he is averaging 18.3 points per game on 65.3 percent shooting.

INSIDE THE GAME

- The series between North Texas and Middle Tennessee is tied at 6-6 following the Mean Green win in the 2009 Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals. NT has won the last two meetings in the series, as well as four of the last six meetings dating back to 2007. North Texas' 2009 win at the Murphy Center was it's first in five tries at the facility.
- The Blue Raiders and the Mean Green have met in two of the last three Sun Belt Conference Tournaments, with NT taking both games. NT took the first meeting, 59-52, in the 2007 semifinal in Lafayette, La., and won 88-79 in the 2009 quarterfinal in Hot Springs, Ark.
- In his career, NT fourth-year junior Collin Mangrum has played just 27 total minutes against MTSU albeit 27 very productive minutes. Mangrum exploded for a careerhigh 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting, including 5-of-9 from 3-point, in a 22 minute outing on New Year's Eve of 2008.
- The combination of Josh White and Tristan Thompson powered North Texas past Middle Tennessee 88-79 in the Sun Belt Conference quarterfinals at Summit Arena last season. The pair combined for 46 points as the Mean Green (20-11) earned its third straight 20-win season. NT led wire-to-wire against Middle Tennessee jumping on the Blue Raiders early with a 7-2 start, and hitting its first 20 from the charity stripe. Thompson ended the game with 19 points and hit 12-of-13 from the free throw line.
- Middle Tennessee is led by perennial All-Sun Belt big man Desmond Yates. The fifth-year senior is averaging 14.9 points per game, and despite his 6-foot-7 frame, has hit 20-of-47 (42.6 percent) of his attempts from 3-point. Yates earned Sun Belt Player of the Week honors this week for his 28-point performance against rival Western Kentucky. Montarrio Haddock isn't far behind Yates with 13.7 points and a team-high 6.4 rebounds per game.

Manufacturing Points - Over the last seven games, North Texas has grabbed an average of 14.6 offensive rebounds, and has turned them into 15.6 second chance points per game.

Super Scorer - Josh White is climbing the NT career scoring charts, and currently sits in 16th place in school history with 1,058 points. White is expected to challenge the top four scorers in school history by the end of his senior season.

Sun Belt Specialist - Tristan Thompson has been simply electric in Sun Belt play this year, leading the conference with an average of 19.0 points per contest.

Take It To The Bank - A halftime lead has been a sure thing for North Texas this year. The Mean Green is 11-0 so far this season when heading into the break with a lead.

Two-Minute Drill - In the final two minutes of the win over South Alabama. North Texas hit 6-of-6 free throws to ice the game. One of the SBC's top freethrow shooting squads, NT has been clutch from the charity stripe all year. Eight of the Mean Green's 12 wins have come down to free throws in the final minutes to seal the victory. NT is 54-of-64 (84.4 percent) from the stripe in the

final two minutes of those games. Josh White (27-32) and Tristan Thompson (14-17) are shooting a combined 83.7 percent in the final two minutes this

All Alone In Second - Johnny Jones stands alone in second place in North Texas career wins after the 83-78 win over UALR on New Year's Eve. Jones' 135th win passed Hall-of-Famer Bill Blakeley for second in program history. Blakeley, who complied a 134-85 mark from 1976-83, also coached the Dallas Chaparrals before they became the San Antonio Spurs. Only one other NT coach has coached more games than Jones - Pete Shands (482 games in 22 years).

Johnson Injured - North Texas will unfortunately be without the services of Dominique Johnson for the remainder of the year. The senior led the squad with 120 assists in 2008-09, but broke a bone in his ankle in the second half of the Rice game. Johnson had played in just four games this year due to a preseason shoulder injury.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 58 games at the Super Pit over the last five years - the most in

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 71-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - NT finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas & Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones' arrival.

Air Time - NT is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the SBC Tourney.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the all-time great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 622 games.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,012-1,167-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).

- April 16, 2001 Jones named 16th head coach in North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who compiled a 20-87 record in four years.
- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, includ-

ing Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.

- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State.

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer

the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least amount of points by an NT opponent since 1994.

March 5, 2008 - A win over Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference opening round secures a second straight 20-win season for the Mean Green.

Dec. 31, 2008 - Jones coaches the 250th game of his career, which has spanned eight seasons at NT and Memphis. Jones has amassed a 129-121 record.

Feb. 26, 2009 - With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Nov. 18, 2009 - Broke the 14-year hold UT Arlington had on North Texas with a 101-99 double OT win. The Mavericks had won the previous five meetings.

Dec. 31, 2009 - In the last game of the decade, Jones passes Bill Blakeley for 2nd place in school history in career victories with 135 wins.




