North Texas cruised past the University of the Southwest in a rare weekday noon game, which saw hundreds of area school children come out to enjoy Mean Green hoops. Shannon Shorter enjoyed his first career double-double in the 91-62 victory. Rice is coming off a tough 85-64 loss at a game Harvard squad. Tamir Jackson is gaining a reputation as a steals artist for the Owls, already tallying 16 on the young season.

Quick Hitters

- The last meeting between these Texas rivals came down to the last shot, but the Mean Green emerged victorious, 71-69, back in Nov. of 2006. Morris Almond tallied 38 points, but NT answered with 26 from Calvin Watson and 21 from Michael Sturns. NT leads the overall series (7-3) which dates back to 1932.
- Josh White became the 12th player in NT history to notch 100 career 3-pointers. White nailed 2-of-4 from deep, and is shooting 46.2 percent from 3-point this season.

Double-Double Guard - Shannon Shorter broke out against USW on Wednesday with 11 points and 10 rebounds for his first career double-double. The junior is the first North Texas guard to post a double-double since Chris Davis tallied 19 points and 10 rebounds versus New Mexico State on Feb. 1, 2003 - a span of 195 games.

Century Mark - Josh White became the 12th player in school history to notch 100 career 3-pointers with his efforts on Wednesday. White nailed 2-of-4 from deep and now has 100 for his career. The junior ranks seventh in school history in career 3-point percentage with a clip of .383, and needs just five more to tie for 10th in school history in career makes.

Look Out Blakeley! - With the win over USW, North Texas head coach Johnny Jones snagged his 130th win at NT, and is just four wins shy of tying Hall-of-Fame coach Bill Blakeley on the Mean Green coaching list.

Climbing The Charts - Josh White has had back-to-back 20-point games, and has jumped into 29th place in school history in career points with 871. White needs just 38 more points to reach his former teammate Quincy Williams (2004-08), who finished his career 24th with 909 points. Only 17 players in Mean Green history have ever scored 1,000 points, and the last was Calvin Watson (1,253 from 2004-07).

Free Throw Magic Mark - Getting to the free throw line is a big part of the Mean Green's game. NT ranks sixth in the nation with 21 free throws made per game, but hasn't topped the all-important 20-make plataeu in three of its last four games. NT is 61-23 (72.6 percent) since 2001-02 when it makes 20 or more free throws in a game, including a 35-9 (79.6 percent) mark since 2006-07.

Fast Break Specialists - North Texas has scored 20 fast break points in its last three contests, but more importantly has limited its opponent's opportunities. NT's last three opponents have been held to a total of three fast break buckets, including none for the SWAC favorites, Jackson State.

INSIDE THE GAME

- This will be the 11th meeting between NT and Rice, and the Mean Green holds a 7-3 edge in the series that dates back to 1932. This will be just the second meeting in the Johnny Jones era (2001 to present), with North Texas taking the only other game 71-69 at Autry Court on Nov. 18, 2006.
- North Texas is 57-142 all-time against current members of Conference USA, but is 4-2 since the 2005-06 season. The Mean Green program shares a rich history against several CUSA squads, including Houston, Memphis, Tulsa, Southern Mississippi and SMU, who was the opponent in North Texas' first-ever game way back on Jan. 17, 1917.
- Rice coach Ben Braun is in his second season at the helm after a 10-22 campaign in 2008-09. His 33rd overall year as a head coach, Braun has led his teams to seven NCAA Tournaments and four NIT bids, including a Sweet 16 and an NIT Championship at California. He has won nearly 570 games and four conference Coach of the Year awards (3 MAC & 1 Pac-10).
- In the last meeting with Rice, Calvin Watson's 26 points and Michael Sturns' 21 were enough to fend off Morris Almond's 38 point outburst in a 71-69 NT win at Autry Court on Nov. 18, 2006. The Mean Green hit 49.1 percent from the floor, including 46.7 percent from deep in the win. Rich Young forced five of NT's 11 steals. NT had trouble from the line, going 10-of-21 (47.6 percent). Almond would go on to be selected 25th overall in the NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.
- Rice is coming off an 85-64 loss at Harvard, which is starting the season 6-1. Lawrence Ghoram netted 14 points for Rice, while Trey Stanton and Emerson Herndon each tallied 13 for the Owls. Rice shot just 38.9 percent from the floor, while Harvard shot 60.8, and muscled a 46-32 edge in points in the paint.

White Back On Top - Josh White has netted his last 10 free throw attempts dating back to the UT Arlington game, vaulting him back into first place in school history in career free throw percentage. White has hit 245-of-281 (87.19 percent) from the stripe in his career, and ranked second in the NCAA in '08-09 with a mark of 90.6 percent.

Spreading The Wealth - The Mean Green is 40th in the country in scoring with 80.2 points per game, but is once again doing it with a multi-faceted attack. Ten different North Texas players are averaging double-digit minutes, and eight players are averaging more than 5.5 points per game. NT as a team ranked 32nd in the NCAA in scoring last year despite not having a player in the national top 500 in individual scoring.

Double-Double Man - With double-doubles in three of the year's six outings, George Odufuwa is currently averaging 9.8 points and 11.0 rebounds per game. He ranks 9th in the NCAA with 11.0 rebounds per game. Odufuwa hauled in 24 boards in the season opener against Cameron, becoming just the ninth player in the NCAA since 2005-06 to register 24 or more rebounds in a single game.

Preseason All-Sun Belt Accolades - Eric Tramiel was named to the first-team and Josh White earned second-team honors on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference squads. Tramiel was the Mean Green muscle in the middle, leading NT in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. White played most of 2008-09 with a hand injury, but still ranked second in the NCAA in free

throw percentage, and piloted the Mean Green's 31st ranked scoring offense.

Best In The West-North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - North Texas finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1976-78. NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas and Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones arrival at North Texas.

Lighting Up The Scoreboard - Johnny Jones and NT play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

North Texas has won at least 10 conference games in each of the last three years – a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Milestone Jones - Head coach Johnny Jones is nearing a couple of career milestones in '09-'10. Jones is just seven games shy of his 250th game coached at NT, and 26 games away from the 300th of his career overall. The ninth year head coach will suit up for his 250th game at North Texas against Texas Southern on Dec. 28th, and can reach his 300th overall with a trip to the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 68-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 608 games.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 53 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

Packing The Pit - North Texas averaged 3,084 fans per game at the Super Pit last year, and 3,178 in 2007-08. That two-year average of 3,131 is the highest in any two year period at NT since 1987-89 (3,167). As a matter of fact, the last two years' attendance figures are just the fifth and sixth time for NT to top the 3,000 per game attendance mark since moving to the Super Pit in 1972.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,003-1,162-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).



piled a 20-87 record in four years.

- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7. 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Feb. 26, 2003 Jones picks up his 50th career victory with an 84-81 overtime victory over 2004 Sun Belt Con-

ference Tournament runner-up New Orleans.

- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, including Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Nov. 11, 2007 - In front of the largest Super Pit crowd since 1980 (6,793), Jones and the Mean Green knocked off Oklahoma State 82-73.

Dec. 1, 2007 - Down 21 points at New Mexico State with 14:20 remaining, Jones and the Mean Green engineer the biggest comeback in school history. NT beat the Aggies 75-72 in regulation.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most lopsided road victories in school history in a 72-40 drubbing of Louisiana at Monroe. It is the largest margin of defeat in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history, and the least

Feb. 26, 2009 - With a win over Arkansas State, North Texas secured its 10th conference win for a third straight season, a feat not seen at NT since 1924-27.

Nov. 18, 2009 - Broke the 14-year hold UT Arlington had on North Texas with a 101-99 double OT win. The Mavericks had won the previous five meetings.






