North Texas picked up a crutial win over Rice on Saturday before falling at No. 16 Texas A&M on Monday. The Mean Green is now 2-1 against teams from the Lone Star state, and will have two more Texas opportunitites versus Texas Southern and Houston Baptist later this year. Now NT puts its four-game home winning streak on the line in its Sun Belt opener against ULM. NT has won its last four meetings with the Warhawks.

Fast Track To Five - The Mean Green took just seven games to pick up its fifth win of the season - a feat that North Texas has either topped or matched in each of the last four years. Aside from this four year stretch, NT has accomplished that feat on only two other occasions since the 1979-80 campaign. North Texas has won its last four home games dating back to last year.

Most Wonderful Time of the Year - December has been a good time for Mean Green basketball, and not just because of the holidays. Over the last five years, North Texas is 22-9 (70.9 percent) in the month of December, including a 6-1 mark in 2006-07 (the only loss came in double-overtime). NT is 2-1 and entering Sun Belt play so far this month.

Eric Has Awakened - Eric Tramiel has come alive over the last five outings, pouncing those opponents for 14.0 points per game on 52.6 percent shooting. The senior has reached double figures in each of those games, and is shooting 38.5 percent from 3-point, and has four assists, four blocks and four steals.

Threats From Three - North Texas presents a 3-point threat like few teams. The Mean Green has three players that rank in the top 10 in school history in career 3-point percentage. Dominique Johnson (40.2 percent) ranks fourth, Josh White (38.3) is seventh and Tristan Thompson (36.0) is 11th. Forward Eric Tramiel, who checks in a 6-foot-7, is also 10-of-28 (35.7) from deep in his career.

A Rare Miss Indeed - Josh White missed a couple of free throws at Texas A&M on Monday night, a rare occurrence for the junior who hadn't missed in the month of December since 2007. As a matter of fact, White is 71-of-77 (92.2 percent) from the stripe in the month of December in his career. White ranks No. 1 in school history with an 87.16 career free throw mark, and ranked second in the NCAA last year.

Look Out Blakeley! - With the win over Rice North Texas head coach Johnny Jones snagged his 131th win at NT, and is just three wins shy of tying Hall-of-Fame coach Bill Blakeley on the Mean Green coaching list.

INSIDE THE GAME

- North Texas and ULM are meeting for the 45th time, but the Mean Green has taken the last four dating back to 2006-07. The two schools joined the Southland Conference in the 1982-83 season and remained rivals until the Mean Green moved to the Big West in 1996-97. The Warhawks joined the Sun Belt in all sports in 2006-07, and own a 27-17 all-time edge over the Mean Green. NT fell in its first nine SLC games against ULM, but won the 1988 conference tournament with an 87-70 win over the Warhawks.
- North Texas will be opening the Sun Belt slate at home for the first time since 2005-06 when the Warhawks come to town on Sunday. The Mean Green is 5-4 in Sun Belt openers after last year's 78-64 win at Louisiana-Lafayette. NT is 94-129 all-time against current members of the Sun Belt Conference, and 68-90 since the Mean Green joined the league for the 2000-01 season.
- In the last meeting with ULM, Adam Mc-Coy led six players scored in double-figures with 20 points in a 95-80 North Texas victory on Feb. 19, 2009 at the Super Pit. NT ran away from the Warhawks with a 57 percent shooting performance in the second half en route to a season-high 95 points. McCoy bagged eight points in a 12-2 run that put the game away for NT in the second.
- ULM has a 3-5 overall record, but has struggled to a 1-4 mark away from Fant Ewing Coliseum. The Warhawks knocked off Morehead State, 74-73, on the road, but fell at LSU, Oklahoma, Centenary and Alabama by an average of 17.4 points per game.
- Ten Warhawks are averaging double-digit minutes this year, led by former All-Sun Belt performer Tony Hooper. The senior is averaging 12.9 points per game in 28.1 minutes.
- Tony Hooper also leads the ULM 3-point attack, which ranks 46th in the country. The Warhawks are shooting 39.6 percent from deep as a team, and Hooper is hitting 46.3 percent on 19-of-41 shooting.

Climbing The Charts - Josh White has a trio of 20-point games this season, and has jumped into a tie for 26th place in school history in career points with 900. White needs just nine more points to reach his former teammate Quincy Williams (2004-08), who finished his career 24th with 909 points. Only 17 players in Mean Green history have ever scored 1,000 points, and the last was Calvin Watson (1,253 from 2004-07).

Century Mark - Josh White is just the 12th player in school history to notch 100 career 3-pointers. White made 3-pointers at Rice and Texas A&M and now has 102 for his career. The junior ranks seventh in school history in career 3-point percentage with a clip of .383, and needs just three more to tie for 10th in school history in career makes.

Free Throw Magic Mark - Getting to the free throw line is a big part of the Mean Green's game. NT ranks 12th in the nation with 20.1 free throws made per game, and got back on track with a 21-of-26 performance at Rice. NT is 62-23 (72.9 percent) since 2001-02 when it makes 20 or more free throws in a game, including a 36-9 (80.0 percent) mark since 2006-07.

Spreading The Wealth - The Mean Green is 82nd in the country in scoring with 76.2 points per game, but is once again doing it with a multi-faceted attack. Ten different North Texas players are averaging double-digit minutes, and eight players are averaging more than 6.6 points per game. NT as a team ranked 32nd in the NCAA in scoring last year despite not having a player in the national top 500 in individual scoring.

Double-Double Man - With double-doubles in three of the year's outings, George Odufuwa is currently averaging 9.4 points and 10.6 rebounds per game. He ranks 16th in the NCAA with 10.6 rebounds per game. Odufuwa hauled in 24 boards in the season opener against Cameron, becoming just the ninth player in the NCAA since 2005-06 to register 24 or more rebounds in a single game.

Preseason All-Sun Belt Accolades - Eric Tramiel was named to the first-team and Josh White earned second-team honors on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference squads. Tramiel was the Mean Green muscle in the middle, leading NT in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. White played most of 2008-09 with a hand injury, but still ranked second in the NCAA in free throw percentage, and piloted the Mean Green's 31st ranked scoring offense.

Best In The West- North Texas was tabbed as the favorite in the Sun Belt West Division in every major preseason publication, as well as the league's coaches in the SBC's annual Preseason Poll. NT was picked alone atop the West Division for the first time since joining the league in 2000. The Mean Green garnered the top spot with a league-high 85 points, and nine first place votes. NT was picked in a tie with UALR for the West's top spot in last year's poll.

Mean Green 20/20/20 - North Texas finished last season with a 20-12 mark, giving the program back-to-back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since

NT is one of only three teams in the Sun Belt (South Alabama & Western Kentucky) and three in the state of Texas (Texas and Texas A&M) to win at least 20 games in each of the last three years. The Mean Green had won a total of 20 games in the four years prior to Johnny Jones arrival at North Texas.

Lighting Up The Scoreboard - Johnny Jones and NT play up-tempo basketball, and the results speak for themselves. North Texas has ranked no lower than 34th in the NCAA in scoring in each of the last four seasons. Last year, NT ranked 31st in the country with an average of 77.3 points per game.

Milestone Jones - Head coach Johnny Jones is nearing a couple of career milestones in '09-'10. Jones is just five games shy of his 250th game coached at NT, and 24 games away from the 300th of his career overall. The ninth year head coach will suit up for his 250th game at North Texas against Texas Southern on Dec. 28th, and can reach his 300th overall with a trip to the Sun Belt Tournament quarterfinals.

Air Time - The Mean Green is slated to appear on television 17 times in the 2009-10 regular season, including a four-pack of nationally televised games. North Texas will appear on FSN-Southwest in its Big XII showdowns with Oklahoma State and Texas A&M on Nov. 21 and Dec. 7. The Sun Belt Network will air the Mean Green's games against UALR on Feb. 20 and ULM on Feb. 27. Every North Texas home game

can be seen locally in Denton on NTTV. The Mean Green will have additional chances for televised games at the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

Eighty Or Bust - One of the highest scoring teams in the nation, North Texas is deadly when it reaches 80 points. The Mean Green ranked 31st in the nation with 77.3 points per game last year, and is 68-16 all-time under Johnny Jones when scoring 80 or more.

Deadly From Downtown - One of the alltime great three-point shooting programs, North Texas has now hit a three-pointer in each game dating back to the 1987-88 season - a span of 610 games.

Pressure Pit - The Mean Green has made the Super Pit one of the nation's toughest places to play. NT won a school-record 15 home games in 2007-08, and has won 53 games at the Super Pit over the last five years – the most in any period in school history. As a matter of fact, no other team in the Sun Belt has won more home games since 2006-07 than the Mean Green.

92nd Season - North Texas is playing its 92nd season of basketball, compiling an all-time record of 1,004-1,163-1. North Texas State Normal College, as the school was known in 1917, played its first basketball game on January 17 in a 25-23 loss at home to SMU. Since then, North Texas has hauled in 16 conference titles (14 regular season and two tournament championships) and three postseason appearances (NCAA in 1988, 2007 and NAIA in 1943).

- April 16, 2001 Jones named 16th head coach in North Texas history, taking over for Vic Trilli who compiled a 20-87 record in four years.
- Nov. 16, 2001 Jones won his first game as head coach at North Texas, defeating Southwest Missouri State 79-77 at the Super Pit.
- March 1, 2002 Jones and the Mean Green defeated Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The game marked NT's first ever victory in the SBC Tournament and its first in any conference tournament since the 1995-96 season.
- March 2, 2002 North Texas ended the season with a 15-14 record to give the Mean Green its first winning season in six years. NT posted the nation's third best one season improvement in winning percentage for 2000-01 to 2001-02.
- Dec. 7, 2002 Jones led the Mean Green to a victory over Winthrop at the Brother's Air and Heat Championship game, giving North Texas its first regular-season tournament title in more than 20 years.
- Dec. 6, 2003 North Texas picked up its biggest margin of victory in school history in a 109-49 win over Hardin-Simmons.
- Feb. 26, 2003 Jones picks up his 50th career victory with an 84-81 overtime victory over 2004 Sun Belt Con-

ference Tournament runner-up New Orleans.

- Nov. 9, 2005 Jones and his staff signed four players on the first day of the early signing period and, including Arizona State transfer Keith Wooden, had the 29th ranked class in the nation for the early signing period according to Hoop Scoop.
- Nov. 18, 2005 Jones won his 50th game at North Texas with the victory over Hardin-Simmons in the season opener.
- Nov. 12, 2006 In what is being referred to as his signature win, Jones' Mean Green toppled NIT participant Charlotte 90-72 on the road.

Dec. 19, 2006 - Jones leads the Mean Green to another program first - its first win over Western Kentucky in eight tries.

Feb. 15, 2007 - Jones scores his 80th victory at North Texas, passing John Reid for fourth all-time.

March 6, 2007 - Jones gives NT its first-ever Sun Belt Conference title with an 83-75 win over Arkansas State

March 16, 2007 - North Texas plays in its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988, falling to Memphis 73-58 in the opening round.

Feb. 2, 2008 - Jones records his 100th win at North Texas with a 60-57 victory over Florida International. Only Bill Blakeley reached the milestone faster at NT. Feb. 20, 2008 - North Texas records one of the most loss observed in the most object of the most o




