Mean Green Poised For Repeat In 2011

North Texas posted the nation's 24th biggest turnaround last season, going from 12 to 20 wins, and second-year head coach Ken Murczek is eager to prove that 2010 was no fluke. The Mean Green retains 75 percent of its digs, 72 percent of its blocks and 55 percent of its kills, and welcomes one of the best incoming classes in school history to Denton this year.

Scouting The Week Ahead

Lamar was picked to finish fourth in the Southland, and is led by All-SLC middle blockers Christina Hobbs and Wendy Krellwho. Hobbs is the reigning SLC Freshman of the Year.

Houston Baptist is led by Isis Gardner, an NC State transfer who racked up First-Team All-Great West honors in 2010. The Huskies return six starters from a 17-13 squad that finished fourth in the Great West.

Texas Southern's new head coach Jocelyn Adams was handed the reigns in June, and takes over a Tigers squad that lost its final 10 matches and was 5-20 overall.

Mean Green Turnaround

North Texas won 12 matches in 2009, followed by a 20 win campaign last season. That eight-match turnaround is the largest in the Sun Belt, and ranks 24th in the NCAA. Only Houston (+10) and UTSA (+9) showed bigger improvement among Texas' 21 Division I programs.

West Division Co-Champs

North Texas claimed a share of the Sun Belt West Division title in 2010, the program's second SBC Division championship. NT was tabbed to finish 4th in the 2010 Preseason Sun Belt Coaches Poll, but finished 20-13 overall and 11-5 in league play.

20-Wins On The Way

North Texas tallied the program's fifth 20-win campaign last season, and its first since 2006. At 20-13 (60.6 percent) on the year, the Mean Green notched the fourth best win percentage in school history, trailing only 1995 (70.6), 2006 (63.9) and 2003 (61.1).

To The Rafters

North Texas shattered attendance records last season en route to winning the Sun Belt West Division title. The Mean Green led the SBC and set a new school record with an average of 452 fans in attendance in 2010. The standing-room only senior night crowd of 697 (seating capacity 600) was the largest to ever see an NT team play.

Saey What?!?!

Kayla Saey proved one of the Sun Belt's top setters in 2010 in leading the league with 11.31 assists per set. Her accolades led to a Second-Team All-Sun Belt nod and ranked her fourth in school history in single season assists. The senior also ranks fourth in program history with 2,660 career assists.

Willey 500

Last season, Sarah Willey became just the second player in North Texas history to rack up over 500 digs in a single season with her 559 dig year. The junior joins her former assistant coach Jessica Hulsebosch, who had three 500-plus dig campaigns from 2005-07, as the only NT players with at least 500 digs. The senior now has 1,268 digs for her career.

Class With Class

Ken Murczek is welcoming possibly the best incoming class in school history. This class has combined for six all-state selections and five state titles among the eight newcomers. Setter Liz Powell led the state of Kansas in assists, while defensive specialist Addason Lamb owns three state title rings from Lucas Lovejoy HS. Courtney Windham, a 6-3 transfer from Baylor, was a PrepVolleyball.com All-American at Cy-Creek. Eboni Godfrey and Analisse Shannon also earned All-State honors in Texas.

Record-Book Offense

The 2010 season will go down as one of the most proficient in school history offensively speaking. As a team, NT posted a .223 attack percentage, which ranks third in school history, and NT's 1,804 kills rank as the fourth most by an NT squad. The Mean Green also ranks third in program history with 1,691 total assists.

Magic Mark

A hitting percentage of .200 is usually the magic mark for North Texas. NT is now 76-16 since 2004 (including 16-4 in 2010) when it hits above .200, but that record dips to 16-118 when the Mean Green hits under .200.

Stellar Starters

Setting the tone early is important for the Mean Green. North Texas is 56-16 since 2006 (including 15-6 in 2010) when it wins the first game of a match. However, that record falls to 15-76 when its opponent takes set one.

Ken Murczek was handed the reigns of the North Texas volleyball program in January of 2010, and wasted no time in making the Mean Green a force in the Sun Belt Conference. In his first season at the helm, Murczek guided the Mean Green to just its second Sun Belt West Division title.

The former Kansas and Virginia assistant led the Mean Green to just the fifth 20-win season in program history after being picked fourth of six teams in the SBC West's Preseason Poll.

"Ken is a coach that is well versed in his sport, has an excellent track record

in recruiting and great recommendations from not only the coaches that he worked with, but also those he coached against," said North Texas athletics director Rick Villarreal. "His energy, preparation and his connections to the Texas volleyball recruiting process make him a great fit."

Academics are at the heart of Murczek's vision for the Mean Green, and after his first season at the helm NT was presented with the AVCA Team Academic

Award for the first time in school history. The award was given to teams nationally who maintained a 3.30 cumulative GPA for the 2010-11 academic year.

Murczek spent two seasons at Kansas, and despite playing 10 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, the Jayhawks enjoyed their winningest campaign since 2004 (16-14), and even knocked off No. 21 Baylor. Their two-match sweep of in-state rival Kansas State was the program's first since 1993.

While with the Jayhawks, Murczek had two players named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District squad and a leaguebest eight Academic All-Big XII honorees in 2009 alone.

Prior to his arrival at Kansas, Murczek spent a year at Virginia where he helped the Cavaliers pile up 18 wins and a fourth place finish in the ACC. On top of his administrative and recruiting duties, he was responsible for training the outside hitters, and helped develop Sarah Kirkwood into a two-time AVCA All-American - a first in Virginia volleyball history.

Murczek also spent time at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.,

where he assisted with skill development and on-court training of the United States Women's National Volleyball Team.

From 2005-06, Murczek served as an assistant at Western Michigan, and was a volunteer assistant at Purdue in 2004. Over the two-year span at Western Michigan, Murczek helped guide six all-conference players and aided in the Broncos receiving the highest honorable mention award for the 2006 recruiting class according to prepvolleyball.com. In addition, Murczek was integral in the development of senior setter Jenifer Sulewski, who broke the

> school record for singleseason assists.

In his stint at Purdue, he helped the Boilermakers to their first NCAA Tournament berth since 1990 and first-round upset over nationally-ranked host Colorado State.

A successful player at all levels, Murczek began his volleyball career at Marist High School in Chicago where he became an all-state selection in 1993. Murczek played collegiately at San Diego State, where he led his team

to a top 15 ranking, and finished fifth in the country in digs per game. He then went on to the University of Arizona where his club volleyball team won back-to-back national championships.

After college, Murczek played four seasons of professional indoor volleyball in Gelterkinden, Switzerland; Biendenkopf, Germany; Niort, France and Bandung, Indonesia. He continues competed in several beach volleyball tournaments during the summer months throughout the United States, and recently played in the 2011 Aduld Open Nationals.

Murczek is currently seeking his CAP III certification from USA Volleyball's Coaching Accreditation Program.

Murczek earned his B.S. in kinesiology from San Diego State University in 1998 before going on to earn a master's in teaching and teacher education from the University of Arizona in 2000. Murczek also holds a secondary education teaching credential in physical education and science from the state of Indiana, and an M.S. in sport management from Western Michigan University (2007). Murczek and his wife, Jennifer, married in August 2007.
