North Texas bookended a tough weekend of action with a pair of sweeps over Southland Conference opponents and regional rivals UT Arlington and Stephen F. Austin - the program's first ever three-set sweep over the Ladyjacks. In hosting its first of two tournaments of the year the Mean Green welcomed some of the nation's best to Denton. NT fell to No. 17 Oklahoma, as well as the reigning Big East champs, Cincinnati.

Scouting The Week Ahead

UT-Pan American kicks off NT's action at the Islander Classic. Ijanae Holman leads the Broncs offense with 1.83 kills per set, but UTPA has struggled to a 1-7 start.

Towson is riding an eight match win streak, and all eight have come by sweep. Katy Buck and setter Aubrey Kirven, the MVP of the Battle of Baltimore Tournament, leads an offense that averages 13.5 kills per set.

Texas A&M-Corpus Christi has fallen in four of its last five matches, but a potent defense led by Micah Nolen's 5.62 digs per set will be a challenge for the Mean Green.

Eboni In Good Company

Eboni Godfrey is making an assault on the Mean Green statistics, leading NT with 3.22 kills per set in 2011. The last freshman to lead the Mean Green in kills for an entire season was Corina Marginas in 2000 (4.41 kps). Marginas went on to earn All-America honors in 2003 and set the school record for career kills with 2,211. Godfrey earned Lamar Invitational All-Tournament Team honors in her first collegiate action.

Accurate Attack

North Texas has had five different players with outings of .500 hitting on 10-plus attacks in 2011 - Madison Barr (.550 vs Lamar), Melanie Boykins (.609 vs UTA), Courtney Windham (.609 vs Texas Southern), Hallie McDonald (.800 vs Texas Southern) and Eboni Godfrey (.647 vs Texas Southern). The Mean Green set a new school record for attack percentage against Texas Southern. NT hit .527 on the Tigers, smashing the eight-year old school record of .493 set against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in 2003.

Sweet Sweep

In the 35-year rivalry with Stephen Fuller Austin University, North Texas had yet to record a three-set sweep of its former conference mate - until Monday. NT forced the Ladyjacks off their game, and SFA in turn committed 42 total errors and hit just .108 on the afternoon. Eboni Godfrey posted 12 kills, eight digs and four blocks - all team highs.

Moving Up The Charts

Sarah Willey, who earned North Texas Invitational All-Tournament Team honors, continued her climb up the Mean Green dig charts. The senior now has 1,375 career digs, which is good for second place in program history. Willey is just one of two players in NT history to record a 500-dig season (559 in 2010).

Marked For A Repeat

North Texas was picked to repeat as Sun Belt West Division champions on the annual pre-season poll. The Mean Green, coming off the program's first 20-win campaign and West Division title since 2006, garnered a division-

high 65 points and seven first-place votes. Arkansas State picked up 60 points and four first-place votes.

Mean Green Turnaround

North Texas won 12 matches in 2009, followed by a 20 win campaign last season. That eight-match turnaround is the largest in the Sun Belt, and ranks 24th in the NCAA. Only Houston (+10) and UTSA (+9) showed bigger improvement among Texas' 21 Division I programs.

West Division Co-Champs

North Texas claimed a share of the Sun Belt West Division title in 2010, the program's second SBC Division championship. NT was tabbed to finish 4th in the 2010 Pre-season Sun Belt Coaches Poll, but finished 20-13 overall and 11-5 in league play.

To The Rafters

North Texas shattered attendance records last season en route to winning the Sun Belt West Division title. The Mean Green led the SBC and set a new school record with an average of 452 fans in attendance in 2010. The standing-room only senior night crowd of 697 (seating capacity 600) was the largest to ever see an NT team play.

Magic Mark

A hitting percentage of .200 is usually the magic mark for North Texas. NT is now 79-17 since 2004 (including 3-1 in 2011) when it hits above .200, but that record dips to 17-121 when the Mean Green hits under .200.

Stellar Starters

Setting the tone early is important for the Mean Green. North Texas is 60-17 since 2006 (including 4-1 in 2011) when it wins the first game of a match. However, that record falls to 15-79 when its opponent takes set one.

Ken Murczek was handed the reigns of the North Texas volleyball program in January of 2010, and wasted no time in making the Mean Green a force in the Sun Belt Conference. In his first season at the helm, Murczek guided the Mean Green to just its second Sun Belt West Division title.

The former Kansas and Virginia assistant led the Mean Green to just the fifth 20-win season in program history after being picked fourth of six teams in the SBC West's Preseason Poll.

"Ken is a coach that is well versed in his sport, has an excellent track record in recruiting and great recommendations from not only the coaches that he worked with, but also those he coached against," said North Texas athletics director Rick Villarreal. "His energy, preparation and his connections to the Texas volleyball recruiting process make him a great fit."

Academics are at the heart of Murczek's vision for the Mean Green, and after his first season at the helm NT was presented with the AVCA Team Academic Award for the first time in school history. The award was given to teams nationally who maintained a 3.30 cumulative GPA for the 2010-11 academic year.

Murczek spent two seasons at Kansas, and despite playing 10 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, the Jayhawks enjoyed their winningest campaign since 2004 (16-14), and even knocked off No. 21 Baylor. Their two-match sweep of in-state rival Kansas State was the program's first since 1993.

While with the Jayhawks, Murczek had two players named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District squad and a league-best eight Academic All-Big XII honorees in 2009 alone.

Prior to his arrival at Kansas, Murczek spent a year at Virginia where he helped the Cavaliers pile up 18 wins and a fourth place finish in the ACC. On top of his administrative and recruiting duties, he was responsible for training the outside hitters, and helped develop Sarah Kirkwood into a two-time AVCA All-American - a first in Virginia volleyball history.

Murczek also spent time at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.,

where he assisted with skill development and on-court training of the United States Women's National Volleyball Team.

From 2005-06, Murczek served as an assistant at Western Michigan, and was a volunteer assistant at Purdue in 2004. Over the two-year span at Western Michigan, Murczek helped guide six all-conference players and aided in the Broncos receiving the highest honorable mention award for the 2006 recruiting class according to prepvolleyball.com. In addition, Murczek was integral in the development of senior setter Jenifer Sulewski, who broke the school record for single-season assists.



In his stint at Purdue, he helped the Boilermakers to their first NCAA Tournament berth since 1990 and first-round upset over nationally-ranked host Colorado State.

A successful player at all levels, Murczek began his volleyball career at Marist High School in Chicago where he became an all-state selection in 1993. Murczek played collegiately at San Diego State, where he led his team

to a top 15 ranking, and finished fifth in the country in digs per game. He then went on to the University of Arizona where his club volleyball team won back-to-back national championships.

After college, Murczek played four seasons of professional indoor volleyball in Gelterkinden, Switzerland; Biendekopf, Germany; Niort, France and Bandung, Indonesia. He continues competed in several beach volleyball tournaments during the summer months throughout the United States, and recently played in the 2011 Aduld Open Nationals.

Murczek is currently seeking his CAP III certification from USA Volleyball's Coaching Accreditation Program.

Murczek earned his B.S. in kinesiology from San Diego State University in 1998 before going on to earn a master's in teaching and teacher education from the University of Arizona in 2000. Murczek also holds a secondary education teaching credential in physical education and science from the state of Indiana, and an M.S. in sport management from Western Michigan University (2007). Murczek and his wife, Jennifer, married in August 2007.

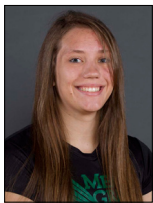

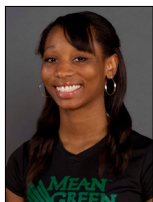

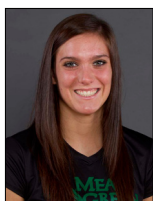
