North Texas earned a split in its opening weekend of Sun Belt action and picked up its 10th win of the season with a five-set victory over Florida Atlantic - the club's third straight five-set win. It took Shelley Morton a few matches to return to game pace after injuring her hand, but she bounced back in a big way last weekend. The senior tallied 13 kills & 13 digs against FIU and 16 kills & 16 digs versus FAU. Her performance helped Ken Murczek pick up his 30th career coaching win in his 50th match at NT, which gives him the second best 50-match win percentage in school history.

ULM made headlines on Tuesday night by finally snapping its 83 match Sun Belt losing streak with a 3-1 win over rival Louisiana-Lafayette, who NT plays on Sunday. The Warhawks got a matchhigh 14 kills from Blanca Ocana and 18 digs from Marcela Urbina in the victory. ULM held ULL to .071 hitting on the night.

Louisiana-Lafayette presents a serve-receive challenge as one of the Sun Belt's top serving squads. The Ragin' Cajuns, who are 4-1 at home, rank second in the Sun Belt with 1.59 service aces per set thanks to Taylor Meade. The sophomore leads the conference with .52 aces per set for a total of 31 on the year.



North Texas is 2-0 in five-set matches this year, and has won three straight since '10.

Sarah Willey is now 1 of 2 NT players to reach the 1,500 career dig plateu.

Shelley Morton's 29 digs through 2 SBC matches ranks 3rd in the league.

Sunday's win over FAU was the 30th in Ken Murczek's 50-match career at NT.

On Sunday North Texas' Ken Murczek coached his 50th game and picked up his 30th career win as the Mean Green knocked off Florida Atlantic in five sets. As a matter of fact, only one NT coach has ever gotten off to a better 50-match start, and that came with the founding of the program in 1976.

Give Her A Hand

Now that Shelley Morton has sufficiently "recovered" from her hand injury, the senior has returned to her consistent form. Morton put up 13 kills and 13 digs in the SBC opener against FIU and followed that outing with 16 kills and 16 digs versus Florida Atlantic. For her career, Morton is averaging exactly 1.99 kills and 1.99 digs per set.

Where There's A Willey There's A Way

Sarah Willey became just the second North Texas player to ever cross the 1,500 dig plateau against Florida Atlantic on Sunday. The senior now has 1,512 career digs, which ranks second in school history behind her former assistant coach Jessica Hulsebosch (2,212 from 2004-07). Willey is only 359 digs shy of the Sun Belt's all-time top five list.

Leading The League Again

Thanks to top notch volleyball, a rocking atmosphere and the Mean Green Volleyball Band, North Texas is once again leading the Sun Belt in attendance. NT is averaging 481 fans in the 600 seat Mean Green Volleyball Center, up from last year's SBC-high average of 452.

Eboni In Good Company

Eboni Godfrey is making an assault on the Mean Green statistics, leading NT with 3.17 kills per set in 2011. The last freshman to lead the Mean Green in kills for an entire season was Corina Marginas in 2000 (4.41 kps). Marginas went on to earn All-America honors in 2003 and set the school record for career kills with 2,211.

Marked For A Repeat

North Texas was picked to repeat as Sun Belt West Division champions on the annual preseason poll. The Mean Green, coming off the program's first 20-win campaign and West Division title since 2006, garnered a division-high 65 points and seven first-place votes. Arkansas State picked up 60 points and four first-place votes.

Mean Green Turnaround

North Texas won 12 matches in 2009, followed by a 20 win campaign last season. That eight-match turnaround is the largest in the Sun Belt, and ranks 24th in the NCAA. Only Houston (+10) and UTSA (+9) showed bigger improvement among Texas' 21 Division I programs.

West Division Co-Champs

North Texas claimed a share of the Sun Belt West Division title in 2010, the program's second SBC Division championship. NT was tabbed to finish 4th in the 2010 Preseason Sun Belt Coaches Poll, but finished 20-13 overall and 11-5 in league play.

Magic Mark

A hitting percentage of .200 is usually the magic mark for North Texas. NT is now 83-17 since 2004 (including 7-1 in 2011) when it hits above .200, but that record dips to 19-124 when the Mean Green hits under .200.

Stellar Starters

Setting the tone early is important for the Mean Green. North Texas is 65-18 since 2006 (including 9-2 in 2011) when it wins the first set of a match. However, that record falls to 16-81 when its opponent takes set one.

Ken Murczek was handed the reigns of the North Texas volleyball program in January of 2010, and wasted no time in making the Mean Green a force in the Sun Belt Conference. In his first season at the helm, Murczek guided the Mean Green to just its second Sun Belt West Division title.

The former Kansas and Virginia assistant led the Mean Green to just the fifth 20-win season in program history after being picked fourth of six teams in the SBC West's Preseason Poll.

"Ken is a coach that is well versed in his sport, has an excellent track record

in recruiting and great recommendations from not only the coaches that he worked with, but also those he coached against," said North Texas athletics director Rick Villarreal. "His energy, preparation and his connections to the Texas volleyball recruiting process make him a great fit."

Academics are at the heart of Murczek's vision for the Mean Green, and after his first season at the helm NT was presented with the AVCA Team Academic

Award for the first time in school history. The award was given to teams nationally who maintained a 3.30 cumulative GPA for the 2010-11 academic year.

Murczek spent two seasons at Kansas, and despite playing 10 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, the Jayhawks enjoyed their winningest campaign since 2004 (16-14), and even knocked off No. 21 Baylor. Their two-match sweep of in-state rival Kansas State was the program's first since 1993.

While with the Jayhawks, Murczek had two players named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District squad and a league-best eight Academic All-Big XII honorees in 2009 alone.

Prior to his arrival at Kansas, Murczek spent a year at Virginia where he helped the Cavaliers pile up 18 wins and a fourth place finish in the ACC. On top of his administrative and recruiting duties, he was responsible for training the outside hitters, and helped develop Sarah Kirkwood into a two-time AVCA All-American - a first in Virginia volleyball history.

Murczek also spent time at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.,

where he assisted with skill development and on-court training of the United States Women's National Volleyball Team.

From 2005-06, Murczek served as an assistant at Western Michigan, and was a volunteer assistant at Purdue in 2004. Over the two-year span at Western Michigan, Murczek helped guide six all-conference players and aided in the Broncos receiving the highest honorable mention award for the 2006 recruiting class according to prepvolleyball.com. In addition, Murczek was integral in the development of senior setter Jenifer Sulewski, who broke the

school record for singleseason assists.

In his stint at Purdue, he helped the Boilermakers to their first NCAA Tournament berth since 1990 and first-round upset over nationally-ranked host Colorado State.

A successful player at all levels, Murczek began his volleyball career at Marist High School in Chicago where he became an all-state selection in 1993. Murczek played collegiately at San Diego State, where he led his team

to a top 15 ranking, and finished fifth in the country in digs per game. He then went on to the University of Arizona where his club volleyball team won back-to-back national championships.

After college, Murczek played four seasons of professional indoor volleyball in Gelterkinden, Switzerland; Biendenkopf, Germany; Niort, France and Bandung, Indonesia. He continues competed in several beach volleyball tournaments during the summer months throughout the United States, and recently played in the 2011 Aduld Open Nationals.

Murczek is currently seeking his CAP III certification from USA Volleyball's Coaching Accreditation Program.
