North Texas has won its last two home matches, and looks forward to returning to the friendly confines of the Mean Green Volleyball Center for outings against ULM and Louisiana-Lafayette. The Mean Green has fallen in each of its last five road matches, and will need to make up ground in the Sun Belt standings against the Warhawks and Ragin' Cajuns.

Last time against the Warhawks, ULM knocked off the Mean Green for the first time since 1991 with a five-set win over North Texas in Monroe. North Texas got 18 kills and 16 digs from Eboni Godfrey, but it wasn't enough against a Warhawks team that hit .208 on the evening. Zuzana Markova led ULM with 16 kills. ULM hasn't won in Denton since 1990.

Down two sets to **Louisiana-Lafayette**, the North Texas volleyball team's furious comeback fell just short in 3-1 loss to the Ragin' Cajuns on Oct. 2. ULL hit .291 against the Mean Green, which committed 27 attack errors. Morton led four NT players in double figures with 14 kills, while Hallie McDonald posted 11 and Godfrey and Melanie Boykins both added 10.

Home Cooking

North Texas has been on the road for five of its last six matches, and looks forward getting back on track in Denton. The Mean Green is 6-3 (.667) at home this year against teams not from BCS automatic qualifying conferences, and the stats are pretty impressive in those nine matches.

Salty Morton

Shelley Morton has been nearly unstoppable in Sun Belt play. The senior ranks 8th in league-only matches with 3.29 kills per set, and she is also averaging 2.79 digs per set, which is second on the team. Morton has posted a double-double in four of the seven SBC matches this year.

They Like Louisiana

Lacy Reasons and Hallie McDonald took full advantage of their opportunities against the Louisiana schools two weeks ago. Reasons posted 2.7 kills per set on .304 hitting in the two matches, and was just three digs shy of her first career double-double against ULM with 15 kills and seven digs. McDonald wasn't far behind with 2.44 kills per set on .275 hitting to go with a team-high five blocks.

Eboni In Good Company

Eboni Godfrey is making an assault on the Mean Green statistics, leading NT with 3.01 kills per set in 2011. The last freshman to lead the Mean Green in kills for an entire season was Corina Marginas in 2000 (4.41 kps). Marginas went on to earn All-America honors in 2003 and set the school record for career kills with 2,211.

Leading The League Again

Thanks to top notch volleyball, a rocking atmosphere and the Mean Green Volleyball Band, North Texas is once again leading the Sun Belt in attendance. NT is averaging 481 fans in the 600 seat Mean Green Volleyball Center,

up from last year's SBC-high average of 452.

Marked For A Repeat

North Texas was picked to repeat as SBC West Division champions on the pre-season poll. NT, coming off the program's first 20-win campaign and West Division title since 2006, garnered a division-high 65 points and seven first-place votes. Arkansas State picked up 60 points and four first-place votes.

Mean Green Turnaround

North Texas won 12 matches in 2009, followed by a 20 win campaign last season. That eight-match turnaround is the largest in the Sun Belt, and ranks 24th in the NCAA. Only Houston (+10) and UTSA (+9) showed bigger improvement among Texas' 21 Division I programs.

West Division Co-Champs

North Texas claimed a share of the Sun Belt West Division title in 2010, the program's second SBC Division championship. NT was tabbed to finish 4th in the 2010 Pre-season Sun Belt Coaches Poll, but finished 20-13 overall and 11-5 in league play.

Magic Mark

A hitting percentage of .200 is usually the magic mark for North Texas. NT is now 83-17 since 2004 (including 7-1 in 2011) when it hits above .200, but that record dips to 20-129 when the Mean Green hits under .200.

Stellar Starters

Setting the tone early is important for the Mean Green. North Texas is 66-19 since 2006 (including 10-3 in 2011) when it wins the first set of a match. However, that record falls to 16-85 when its opponent takes set one.

Ken Murczek was handed the reigns of the North Texas volleyball program in January of 2010, and wasted no time in making the Mean Green a force in the Sun Belt Conference. In his first season at the helm, Murczek guided the Mean Green to just its second Sun Belt West Division title.

The former Kansas and Virginia assistant led the Mean Green to just the fifth 20-win season in program history after being picked fourth of six teams in the SBC West's Preseason Poll.

"Ken is a coach that is well versed in his sport, has an excellent track record in recruiting and great recommendations from not only the coaches that he worked with, but also those he coached against," said North Texas athletics director Rick Villarreal. "His energy, preparation and his connections to the Texas volleyball recruiting process make him a great fit."

Academics are at the heart of Murczek's vision for the Mean Green, and after his first season at the helm NT was presented with the AVCA Team Academic Award for the first time in school history. The award was given to teams nationally who maintained a 3.30 cumulative GPA for the 2010-11 academic year.

Murczek spent two seasons at Kansas, and despite playing 10 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, the Jayhawks enjoyed their winningest campaign since 2004 (16-14), and even knocked off No. 21 Baylor. Their two-match sweep of in-state rival Kansas State was the program's first since 1993.

While with the Jayhawks, Murczek had two players named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District squad and a league-best eight Academic All-Big XII honorees in 2009 alone.

Prior to his arrival at Kansas, Murczek spent a year at Virginia where he helped the Cavaliers pile up 18 wins and a fourth place finish in the ACC. On top of his administrative and recruiting duties, he was responsible for training the outside hitters, and helped develop Sarah Kirkwood into a two-time AVCA All-American - a first in Virginia volleyball history.

Murczek also spent time at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.,

where he assisted with skill development and on-court training of the United States Women's National Volleyball Team.

From 2005-06, Murczek served as an assistant at Western Michigan, and was a volunteer assistant at Purdue in 2004. Over the two-year span at Western Michigan, Murczek helped guide six all-conference players and aided in the Broncos receiving the highest honorable mention award for the 2006 recruiting class according to prepvolleyball.com. In addition, Murczek was integral in the development of senior setter Jenifer Sulewski, who broke the school record for single-season assists.



In his stint at Purdue, he helped the Boilermakers to their first NCAA Tournament berth since 1990 and first-round upset over nationally-ranked host Colorado State.

A successful player at all levels, Murczek began his volleyball career at Marist High School in Chicago where he became an all-state selection in 1993. Murczek played collegiately at San Diego State, where he led his team

to a top 15 ranking, and finished fifth in the country in digs per game. He then went on to the University of Arizona where his club volleyball team won back-to-back national championships.

After college, Murczek played four seasons of professional indoor volleyball in Gelterkinden, Switzerland; Biendekopf, Germany; Niort, France and Bandung, Indonesia. He continues competed in several beach volleyball tournaments during the summer months throughout the United States, and recently played in the 2011 Aduld Open Nationals.

Murczek is currently seeking his CAP III certification from USA Volleyball's Coaching Accreditation Program.

Murczek earned his B.S. in kinesiology from San Diego State University in 1998 before going on to earn a master's in teaching and teacher education from the University of Arizona in 2000. Murczek also holds a secondary education teaching credential in physical education and science from the state of Indiana, and an M.S. in sport management from Western Michigan University (2007). Murczek and his wife, Jennifer, married in August 2007.
