



## **Making Your Course Available**

By default, your course is unavailable to your students enrolled. The word *unavailable* will appear next to your course title. Students cannot access unavailable courses regardless of the term's start date and end date. In order for your students to see the course on their course list on the first day of the semester, you'll need to change the course's availability.

- 1. From the **Control Panel**, expand the **Customization section**, and select **Properties**.
