- 1.) **Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be at the 3000 level or above (advanced), and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree.
- 2.) **Pre-Business Requirements:** Students must have completed at least 45 credit hours of the pre-business program to be admitted into the major. Enrollment in upper-division courses is restricted until the following courses are complete with a C or above and a cumulative 2.7 UNT GPA.
- 3.) **Accounting Duplication Policy:** Accounting courses may not be taken more than twice whether at UNT or at another college or university. If the required grade is not made by the second attempt, the student cannot be an Accounting major. Students may not retake certain Accounting courses once they have completed (with a grade of C or better) a course for which it is a prerequisite.
- 4.) **Advanced Accounting GPA Policy:** Accounting majors must have a 2.5 GPA in all ACCT 3000D and ACCT 4000D level courses taken at UNT or their equivalent taken at other colleges and universities. If this GPA is not met, the student will be required to retake the most recent Accounting course.
