### Bachelor of Science – Logistics and Supply Chain Management (2011-2012)

Requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Logistics & Supply Chain Management include the following.

- Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be at the 3000 level or above (advanced), and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Business Administration degree.
- Pre-Business Requirements:** Students must have completed at least 45 credit hours of the pre-business program to be admitted into the major. Enrollment in upper-division courses is restricted until the following courses are complete with a C or above and a cumulative 2.7 UNT GPA.
  - ENGL 1313D- Computer Assisted Writing I
  - ENGL 1323D- Computer Assisted Writing II
  - ECON 1100D- Microeconomics
  - ECON 1110D- Macroeconomics
  - MATH 1190D- Business Calculus
  - COMM 1010D- Intro to Communications (exempt from grade of C or higher rule)
  - BCIS 2610D- Intro to Computers in Business
  - ACCT 2010D- Accounting Principles I
  - ACCT 2020D- Accounting Principles II
  - DSCI 2710D- Data Description & Analysis with Spreadsheets
- Internship Requirement:** A paid internship is required for the LSCM degree. Eligibility is based on approval from the LSCM department and fulfilling GPA and major course requirements. Credit is not given for past or current experience. See advisor for more information.
- Other Requirements:** Students who have courses that “double-dip,” which count for both core and major, may be required to take additional electives to meet the 120 semester hour requirement.

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### What does it mean to have a Bachelor of Science degree?

A Bachelor of Science degree and Bachelor of Art degree are very similar and are typically viewed as equal in status. Some degrees may be designated as a Bachelor of Science to signify a more increased focus on the major area.

#### Does UNT Dallas have any online degree programs?

There are no Business degrees that are 100% online. While some programs may have a few courses that are offered online, the majority of Business courses are in a classroom setting.

#### Is a minor required for a Business degree?

A minor is not required for Business students. However, a student can choose to pursue a minor, if desired, which would add between 12-21 credit hours to the degree program.

#### Can I get experiential credit towards my degree program based on current or previous employment?

Experiential credit is not granted or applicable to Business programs. However, a student may seek to get internship credit for a new job, position, or project that is gained while the student is taking courses at UNT Dallas.

#### Is an internship required for the Logistics and Supply Chain Management degree?

A paid internship is required for the Logistics and Supply Chain Management degree. The internship is only applicable after the junior year as there are specific criteria that a student must meet. Advisor and department approval required. Credit for a current or previous Logistics related experience is not applicable. See advisor for more details.

#### Will UNT Dallas find an internship for me?

No. UNT Dallas can assist finding a position but the ultimate responsibility to find a position is up to the student. Please see your advisor with questions.

#### What happens if I do not find an internship?

There is no substitution for the internship course. Graduation will be postponed until this requirement is fulfilled.

#### I already have a job; can I use it to fulfill the internship requirement?

This is acceptable only if you can prove that you are starting a new job or set of tasks that are different from your regular tasks such as special project or task force. Burden of proof is on the student. Simply fulfilling your regular duties or getting credit for previous experience does not qualify.

#### How long does my internship have to last?

A minimum of 240 hours is required.
