What is the Texas Success Initiative (TSI)?

TSI is a program which requires testing in reading, mathematics and writing designed to ensure that all students attending public colleges and universities in Texas have the skills necessary to perform effectively in college-level coursework.

Who Must Test?

ALL undergraduate students who enter a Texas public institution of higher education MUST take the TSI Assessment prior to enrolling in any collegiate-level coursework unless they meet an exemption in accordance with Texas law.

When Should I Test?
Take the TSI Assessment PRIOR to attending ORIENTATION.

EXEMPTION IS NOT AUTOMATIC

Students who are exempt must provide UNT Dallas Academic Support Services with a high school transcript, college transcript, or score report showing score and date taken before registration can take place. Military personnel will need a copy of their DD214.
