



As the Senior Procurement Executives for the Department of Energy (DOE) and the National Nuclear Security Administration, we are providing DOE's annual certification as required by Public Law 110-181, Section 801, as amended (10 U.S.C. 2304 Note) and FAR 17.7. DOE certifies that all reimbursable work conducted on behalf of the Department of Defense (DoD) by the Department's contractors through Strategic Partnership Projects (SPP) formerly Work for Others (WFO) program in Fiscal Year 2017 will comply with the Federal Acquisition Regulation, the Department of Energy Acquisition Regulation, pertinent interagency agreements, mutually signed memoranda of agreement/understanding between DoD and DOE as well as DoD and DOE policies related to SPP. Pursuant of FAR 17.703(d), DoD activities requesting work through SPP shall provide all DoD unique terms, conditions and other related requirements for incorporation into each SPP action or notification where none exist. Under our full-cost recovery requirements for work performed on behalf of other Departments and Agencies, DoD shall reimburse all costs associated with meeting any DoD unique requirements.
