RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT, PRODUCTION, PROCUREMENT,

AND LOGISTICS SUPPORT OF DEFENSE CAPABILITY

(SHORT TITLE: AMENDMENT ONE TO THE

US/UK RECIPROCAL DEFENSE PROCUREMENT MOU)

SECTION I

PREAMBLE

The Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland entered into the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland Relating to the Principles Governing Cooperation in Research and Development, Production, Procurement and Logistics Support of Defense Capability, signed on December 13 and 16, 2004, and is hereinafter referred to as "the RDP MOU."

The Agreement Concerning Defense Cooperation Arrangements between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (Chapeau Agreement), of May 27, 1993, as amended June 1, 2007, applies to the RDP MOU, as amended, and all annexes.

SECTION II

AMENDMENT

- 2.1. In accordance with Section 7 (Amendments and Implementing Arrangements) of the RDP MOU, the Governments mutually consent to the following changes to the RDP MOU:
 - 2.1.1. In Section 6, paragraph 6.1, delete "1 January 2015" and insert in its place "January 1, 2018".
 - 2.1.2. In Section 6, paragraph 6.2, delete "1 January 2015" and insert in its place "January 1, 2018".
- 2.2. All other provisions of the RDP MOU remain unchanged.

SECTION III

ENTRY INTO FORCE

3.1. This Amendment One to the RDP MOU will enter into force upon signature by the Governments.
