SUBJECT: ECC-A PARC Bulletin 16-01, United States (U.S.) and Islamic Republic of Afghanistan Security and Defense Cooperation Agreement (also known as the Bilateral Security Agreement (BSA)) Updated Contractor Information Sheet Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- 1. The U.S. Afghanistan Security Defense and Cooperation Agreement (also known as the Bilateral Security Agreement) was entered into force on 1 January 2015. The enclosed FAQ applies ONLY to BSA and NATO contractors and the non-Afghan employees working under those contracts and subcontracts. It does NOT apply to other companies, or to non-Afghan employees working under other contracts or subcontracts.
- 2. The information contained herein is the latest information regarding the BSA. It is not all inclusive and information is subject to change at any time; therefore, there is NO guarantee of its accuracy. It is incumbent upon the contractor to research the Afghanistan Embassy web site and seek advice from sources knowledgeable in Afghan Government affairs.
