Summary:

On Wednesday, April 13, 2016 the House Appropriations Committee passed its version of the FY17 Military Construction and Veterans Affairs Appropriations Bill. In total, the legislation provides \$81.6 billion in discretionary funding – \$1.8 billion above the fiscal year 2016 level.

The bill includes \$673 million for construction or alteration of Guard and Reserve facilities in 21 states, an increase of \$122 million above the fiscal year 2016 enacted level. Of this, \$232.9 million is provided for Army National Guard military construction and \$143.9 million for Air National Guard military construction – both at requested levels.

House Provisions of Interest

Military Construction, Army National Guard

For construction, acquisition, expansion, rehabilitation, and conversion of facilities for the training and administration of the Army National Guard, and contributions therefor, as authorized by chapter 1803 of title 10, United States Code, and Military Construction Authorization Acts, \$232,930,000, to remain available until September 30, 2021:

Provided, That, of the amount appropriated, not to exceed \$8,729,000 shall be available for study, planning, design, and architect and engineer services, as authorized by law, unless the Director of the Army National Guard determines that additional obligations are necessary for such purposes and notifies the Committees on Appropriations of both Houses of Congress of the determination and the reasons therefor.

Military Construction, Air National Guard

For construction, acquisition, expansion, rehabilitation, and conversion of facilities for the training and administration of the Air National Guard, and contributions therefor, as authorized by chapter 1803 of title 10, United States Code, and Military Construction Authorization Acts, \$143,957,000, to remain available until September 30, 2021:

Provided, That, of the amount appropriated, not to exceed \$10,462,000 shall be available for study, planning, design, and architect and engineer services, as authorized by law, unless the Director of the Air National 6 Guard determines that additional obligations are necessary for such purposes and notifies the Committees on Appropriations of both Houses of Congress of the determination and the reasons therefor.

SEC. 130. For an additional amount for “Military Construction, Army National Guard”, \$67,500,000, to remain available until September 30, 2021 *Provided*, That such funds may only be obligated to carry out construction projects, in priority order, identified in the Department of the Army’s Unfunded Priority List for Fiscal Year 2017 submitted by the Secretary of Defense to Congress: *Provided further*, That such funding is subject to authorization prior to obligation and expenditure of funds: *Provided further*, That, not later than 30 days after enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall submit to the Committees on Appropriations of both Houses of Congress an expenditure plan for funds provided under this section.

House Report Language of Interest

Enforcement of border security:

Recognizing the need to bolster resources for the enforcement of border security, the Committee instructs the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard to explore public-private partnerships with state and local governments, to design, and construct facilities adjacent to our southwestern border that will support National Guard activities and house and support assets used by Customs and Border Protection and other law enforcement agencies for the terrestrial, maritime, and aerial surveillance of those borders, to include aircraft hangars suitable for unmanned aerial systems, and report back to the Committee not later than 180 days after the enactment of this Act.
