A primary level field activity of the Defense Logistics Agency, DLA Aviation is the aviation demand and supply chain manager for DLA and much of the Defense Department. Employing more than 3,500 civilian and military personnel in 18 locations across the United States, it provides aviation weapons systems and environmental logistics support to the defense aviation community and other governmental customers.

DLA Aviation supports more than 1,340 weapon systems, with focused support to 130 major weapon systems and is the U.S. military's integrated material manager for more than 1.2 million national stock number items, industrial retail supply and depot-level repairable acquisitions.

DLA Aviation directly supports the Warfighter through weapons systems management, industrial retail supply and strategic acquisition support operations. Using a comprehensive demand planning process and tailored logistics solutions, its priorities align with customer priorities.

DLA Aviation also operates the federal government's only industrial plant equipment facility at Mechanicsburg, Pa.

A proven performer, DLA Aviation had \$4.2 billion in sales during fiscal year 2015; processed 2.5 million customer orders during the year; and conducted business with more than 4,543 suppliers as part of its support to its 14,082 customers.
