

Guide Specifications

New Orleans District Guide Specifications (MVNGS) shall be utilized to the maximum extent practicable in the preparation of the Technical Specifications for the project. MVNGS shall serve as the primary Master. The COE Unified Facilities Guide Specifications (UFGS) shall be the secondary Master. When a primary Master is not available, the A-E shall use the secondary Master (UFGS) for acquiring a guide specification. In adapting these guide specifications to specific projects, modifications shall be made as necessary to provide for local conditions, special project requirements, and new developments and improvements in design or construction techniques. For work not covered by guide specifications, recently approved project specifications or sections thereof may be used as guides to the extent that they are applicable provided they are first converted to a SpecsIntact document prior to editing. Microsoft Word front end documents and the MVNGS Masters can be obtained by sending a request to the MVN Specifications Engineer at e-mail spec-matmvn@usace.army.mil or ulysses.d.hester@usace.army.mil. All correspondence with the MVN Specifications Engineer shall be copy furnished to the Corps' Technical Manager.
