All applicants must submit last 5 OPRs with no gaps in time (includes AF Form 77s, AF Form 475s, & AF Form 707s, if applicable).

## 2. Position Description

Should understand the Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE) process. Understanding of Air National Guard (ANG) and Army National Guard (ARNG) budget processes and systems is highly desired. Should understand limits of use of appropriations for domestic operations, and understand reimbursable processes under the Economy Act and Stafford Act. Skilled analyst and user of financial databases. The position requires expertise in areas of contracts, travel, and government purchase card. Will assess Secret plans/strategies/capabilities in order to evaluate funding implications. Provide reporting on the status of resources available to the National Guard along with conducting analyses and developing reports that allow for assessment of trends and funds execution for both the Air and Army National Guard. This includes analysis of legislation policy, domestic operations, and over 20 different Department of Defense (DoD) appropriations. Duties require routine access to secret materials, briefings, and special programs. Position also requires access to NGB adaptive battle staff (ABS) during national-level exercises, operations, and contingencies. The position requires access to classified Concept and Operational plans, along with other classified DoD Information. Also, may be required to take part in readiness exercises, such as Continuity of Operations (COOP), review plans and detains concerning critical infrastructure, and support to the National Guard Bureau (NGB) Joint Operations Command Center (JoCC), as well as interagency, Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), Joint Staff, Combat Commander (COCOM) and Service components.

# 4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director's approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.
