1. Requirements

*** You must submit all required documents IAW the Application Procedures/FAQs located on the website. These procedure/FAQs can change at any time-you MUST follow the most current procedures. All applicants are strongly encouraged to thoroughly review all application procedures and FAQs prior to contacting NGB/HR and especially prior to submitting your application**

Must hold rank/grade, AFSC requirement, and be current/passing within fitness standards as established by AFI 36-2905, by and through announcement closeout date. All information must be accurately indicated on the vMPF RIP at the time of application.

Must have or be able to obtain a Top Secret security clearance.

All applicants must submit last 5 OPRs with no gaps in time (includes AF Form 77s, AF Form 475s, & AF Form 707s, if applicable).

2. Position Description

This Position is an API 8.

- The SEF Division Chief acts as the ANG focal point on all matters pertaining to flight safety, preparing aviation mishap historical and statistical analysis for NGB and ANG staff, and is responsible for providing assistance and coordination on the development of active Air Force flight safety policy as it affects the ANG. The incumbent to this position will develop and implement ANG-specific instructions and policies, identify new aviation mishap trends, and implement changes to mishap prevention programs to protect people and resources. Scope of responsibility also includes maintaining oversight of the ANG unit Bird/Wildlife Aircraft Strike Hazard (BASH) program, assisting in planning and executing annual ANG Executive Safety Summit (conference) for approximately 300 ANG unit safety professionals, and for overseeing implementation and sustainment of the ANG's risk management (RM) program.
- This position is responsible for forming and administering Safety Investigation Boards (SIBs), SIB final reports; including coordination with the Director, ANG (DANG), and other major command (MAJCOMs) for review, release, and additional comments, and provides immediate technical and general advisory support to the Director of Safety and ANG A- staff. Excellent organizational skills are strongly desired, as this position develops curriculum, courseware, and instruction at the Air Reserve Component (ARC) Chief of Safety (ARCCOS) course, interfaces with USAF and MAJCOM flight safety officers concerning issues of policies and procedures.
- Highly desired to have completed Aircraft Mishap Investigation Course (AMIC) and Board President Course (BPC) courses, and have served as a wing Chief of Safety. Experience with National Guard policies and program compliance, as well as, USAF safety policies and program compliance is also highly desired.
- Should possess excellent administrative computer skills and working knowledge of internet-based information sharing. Should also possess exceptional communicative skills, both oral and written.
- Staff experience at the Numbered Air Forces (NAF), MAJCOM, or Headquarters (HQ) level is desired.

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF RIP is accurate/in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying duty history, AFSC, service dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their state/territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director's approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within four duty-days of receipt.
