1. Requirements

*** You must submit all required documents IAW the Application Procedures/FAQs located on the website. These procedure/FAQs can change at any time-you MUST follow the most current procedures. All applicants are strongly encouraged to thoroughly review all application procedures and FAQs prior to contacting NGB/HR and especially prior to submitting your application**

Must hold rank/grade, AFSC requirement, and be current/passing within fitness standards as established by AFI 36-2905, by and through announcement closeout date. All information must be accurately indicated on the vMPF RIP at the time of application.

Must have a Secret security clearance.

All applicants must submit last 5 OPRs with no gaps in time (includes AF Form 77s, AF Form 475s, & AF Form 707s, if applicable).

2. Position Description

This Position is an API 0.

This staff officer serves as the Air National Guard single focal point for the assigned weapons systems for sustainment, funding, manpower, and policy issues.

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Participates in Crisis Action Teams.
- Monitors weapons systems readiness status and develop a plan to correct negative trends. Monitors and reports on health of the fleet.
- Analyzes war plans citing areas that need work in order to support the Combatant Commander with required capability.
- Aircraft Maintenance focal point for Air Expeditionary Force (AEF) issues including equipment, manpower, and Deployments Requirements Manning Documents (DRMDs).
- Participates in Air National Guard weapons systems integrated process teams and meetings affecting force structure decisions.
- Coordinates/Plans/Executes programmed Air National Guard force structure; develops iron flow, coordinates aircraft movement, and Air National Guard retirement to Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group (AMARG).
- Focal point for logistical issues resulting from unit conversions and member of Site Activation Task Force (SATAF) teams.
- Coordinates on aircraft maintenance manpower requirements (civilian and military). Composes documents to achieve funding of logistic requirements for assigned weapons systems.

- Prepares budget estimates/inputs for Program Objective Memorandum (POM), National Guard Reserve Equipment Appropriation (NGREA), National Guard Association of the United States (NGAUS). Programs and budgets for 3400 appropriation requirements.
- Sustaining Engineering (SE EEIC 583)
- Depot Programmed Equipment Maintenance (DPEM EEIC 541)
- Contractor Logistics Support (CLS EEIC 578)
- Assists A5 to develop, plan, and execute aircraft modification program to ensure Air National Guard assets remain in flyable condition to meet wartime requirements. Establishes, reviews, and coordinates qualitative/quantitative requirements for modification of the aircraft.
- Primary Air National Guard Point of Contact for routing Temporary Modification proposals (AF Form 1067) for review.
- Interfaces with Air Staff, Major Commands, Air Logistics Center, Air National Guard Units, and Systems Program Office (SPO), on policy issues affecting the assigned weapons systems; Staffs correspondence on Air National Guard position relative to Weapons systems proposals.
- Coordinates for staff waivers to Air Force or Air National Guard policy on assigned weapons system.
- Authors and coordinates on Air National Guard instructions. Reviews USAF programs for possible incorporation into the Air National Guard. Serves as the Air National Guard logistics functional manager for the development and implementation of Lead Command policies, programs, and procedures for assigned weapons system. Develop maintenance programs and guidance for assigned weapons system.
- Issues Major Command-directed One-Time Inspections.
- Keeps Air National Guard leadership informed on all issues.
- Supports/Attends various meetings and conferences to include but not limited to:
 - System Supportability Review (SSR)
 - Logistics Supportability Review (LSR)/GO-79 Review

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF RIP is accurate/in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying duty history, AFSC, service dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their state/territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director's approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within four duty-days of receipt.
